

CLERY ACT 101: Campus Safety is Everyone's Responsibility

The Clery Act is a federal consumer protection law requiring institutions of higher education to comply with certain campus safety- and security-related requirements as a condition of participating in the Federal student financial aid programs authorized by Title IV of the Higher Education Act.¹

Overview of "Major Players" and *Some* of their Responsibilities:

Mason Police

- Collects crime reports from Campus Security Authorities (CSAs) and local law enforcement agencies with jurisdiction over Mason's properties.
- Prepares and disseminates required campus safety-related information for public viewing, including:
 - [Annual Security & Fire Safety Report](#);
 - [Daily Crime & Fire Log](#);
 - [Timely Warning Notifications](#); and
 - [Emergency Notifications](#).
- Maintains [programs](#) designed to inform students and employees about campus security procedures and practices and the prevention of crimes.

Environmental Health & Safety (EHS)

- Collects fire statistics relative to each on-campus student housing facility.
- Assists in the preparation and dissemination of campus fire safety-related information for public viewing, including:
 - [Annual Security & Fire Safety Report](#);
 - [Daily Fire Log](#); and
 - [Emergency Notifications](#).

University Life

- Maintains educational programs and campaigns related to the prevention of sexual violence and drug and alcohol abuse.
- Offers confidential and non-confidential support resources for students and employees.

Campus Security Authorities (CSAs) – All employees and students with significant responsibility for student and campus activities*

- Immediately report Clery Act Crimes to Mason Police in one of three ways:
 - Calling Mason Police directly at 703-993-2810 (**911** for emergencies);
 - Completing the CSA Crime Statistics Reporting Form available at <http://police.gmu.edu/clery-act-reporting/csa-form/>; or
 - Emailing Mason's Clery Compliance Coordinator directly at cleryact@gmu.edu.
**Some exemptions apply.*

Clery Compliance Coordinator

- Ensures Mason's compliance with the Clery Act.
- Submits crime and fire statistics to the [U.S. Department of Education](#).
- [Maintains and publishes policies and procedures addressing campus security and safety](#).
- [Oversees training of all CSAs](#).

¹ The Clery Act is named in memory of Jeanne Clery, a Lehigh University student who was sexually assaulted and murdered in her on-campus dorm room in 1986. The U.S. Department of Education enforces the Clery Act. Each violation of the Clery Act is subject to a civil penalty of \$35,000.
