

To the George Mason University Community,

Mason Police arrested the suspect in a past-occurred sexual assault case that triggered a Timely Warning Notification. See below for an update to the previously issued Timely Warning Notification:

- On September 5th, 2016, Mason Police issued a Timely Warning Notification for an incident at Piedmont Hall involving a female victim (Mason student) who was sexually assaulted by a male suspect (Mason student) whom the victim had recently met on campus (see original notification at <http://police.gmu.edu/wp-content/uploads/2016/09/Sexual-Assault-September-5-2016.pdf>). The suspect was arrested by Mason Police on Monday, October 17th, 2016 and transported to Fairfax County Adult Detention Center and therefore no longer poses a serious criminal threat to the campus community.

As a reminder, members of the Mason community are encouraged to report all crimes and suspicious persons or incidents, however minor, to Mason Police immediately at (703) 993-2810 or 9-1-1 (for Mason Korea, call 1-1-9).
