

To the George Mason University Community,

The Mason Police are giving notice of a recently reported sexual assault (fondling) that may pose a serious or continuing threat to campus safety:

A female student reported that at approximately 11:00 PM on Thursday, February 28, 2019, an unknown male subject came up to her in the Rappahannock Parking Deck and groped her buttocks, put his arms around her, and then ran away.

A description of the male subject is as follows: Hispanic male, early 20's. Approximately 5' 9" tall. Short, dark brown hair. Dark brown eyes, Light brown mustache, with a patchy beard. Last seen wearing a red zip up hooded sweatshirt, light undershirt, and black or navy blue pants.
