

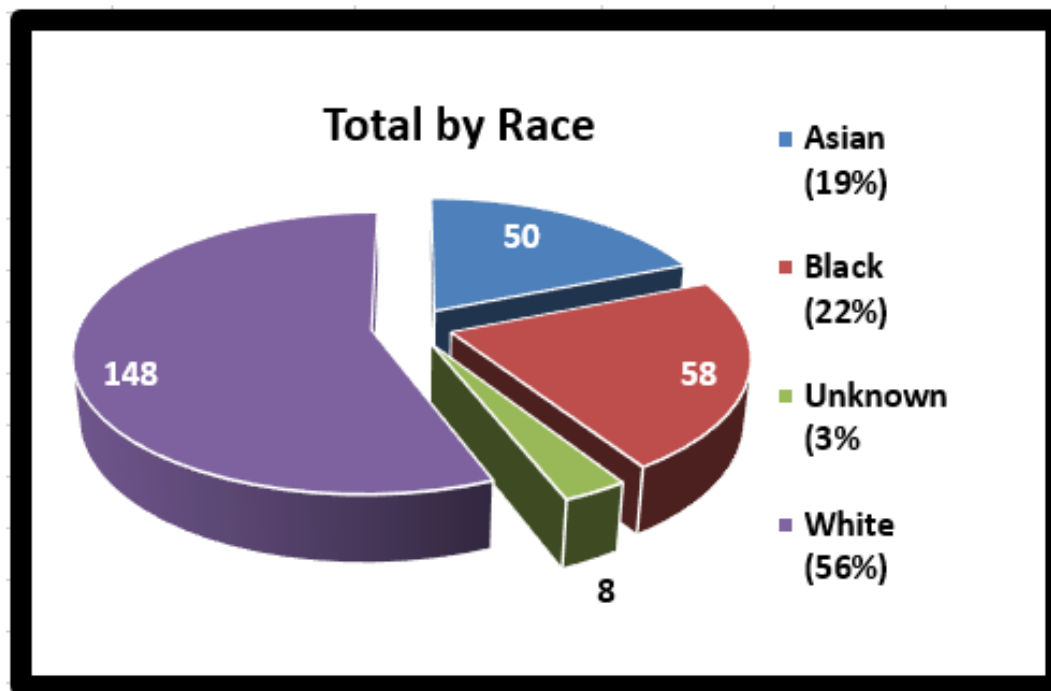

July 1, 2022 – Sept. 30, 2022



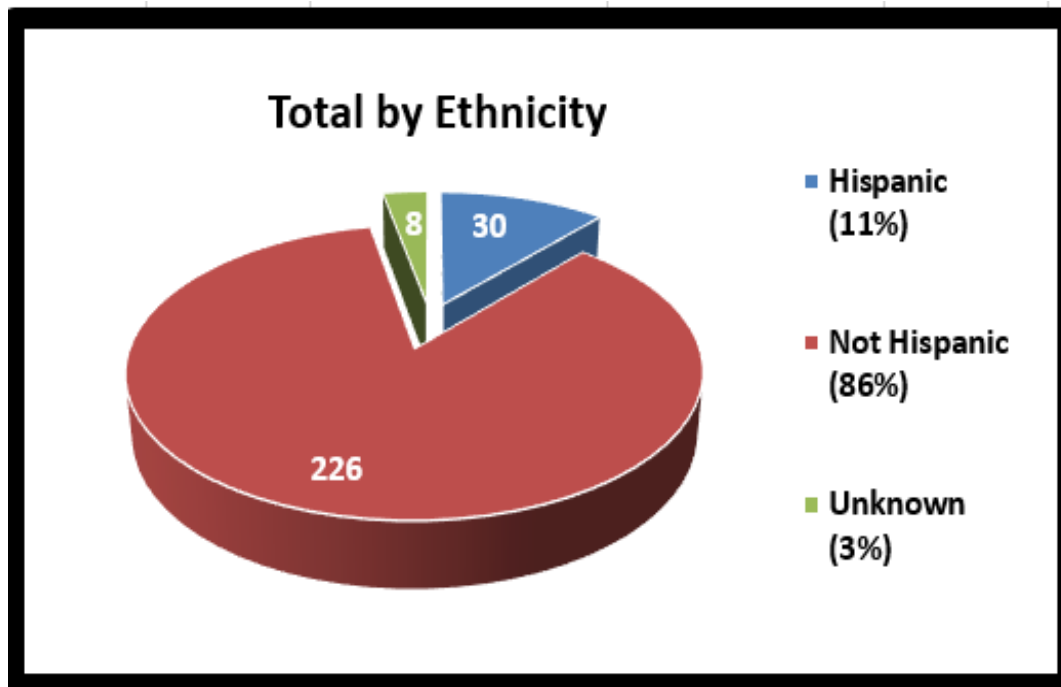

There were a total of 264 traffic stops from July 1, 2022 – Sept. 30, 2022.

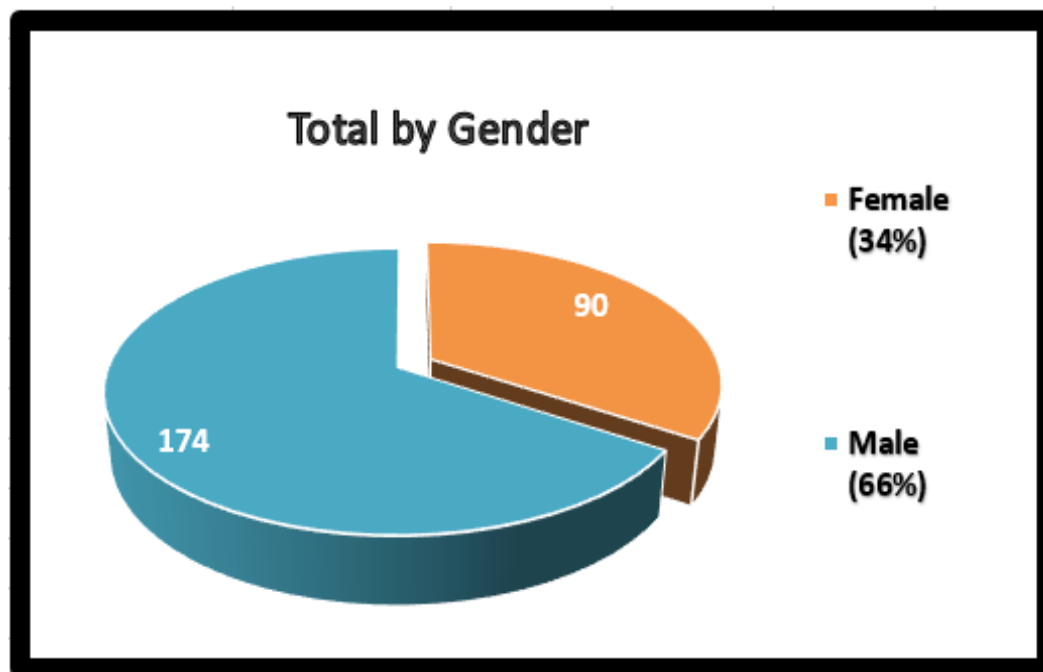
Of the 264 traffic stops, the following chart depicts the race of drivers upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.



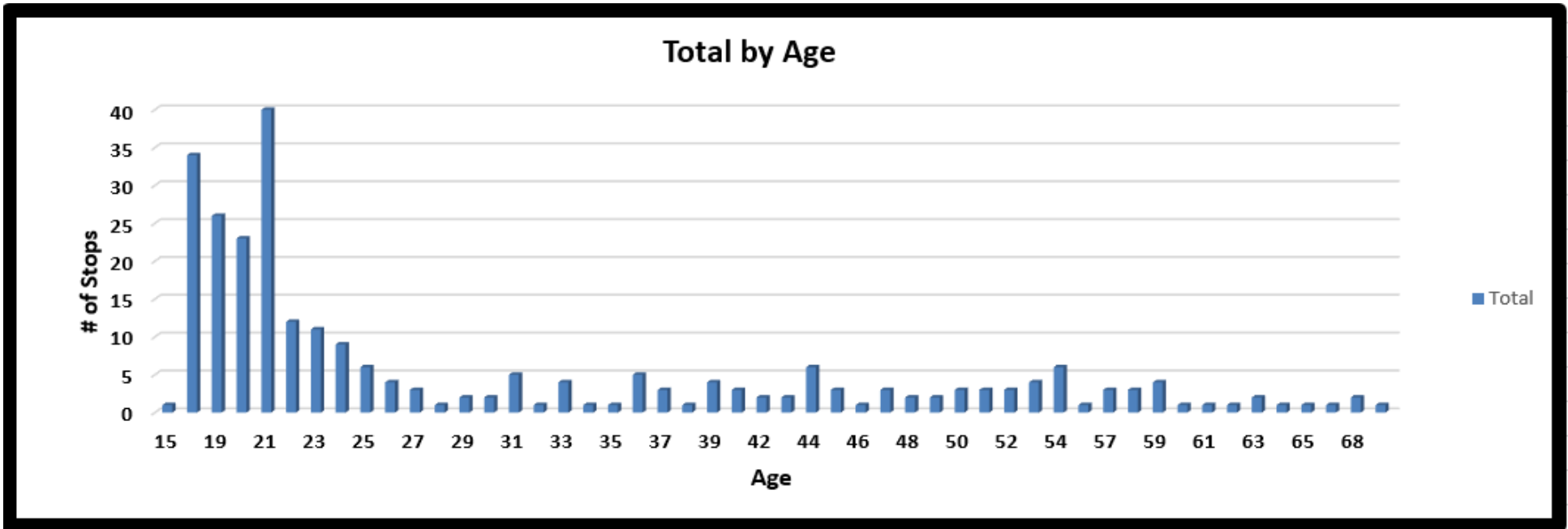
Of the 264 traffic stops, the following chart depicts the ethnicity of drivers upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.



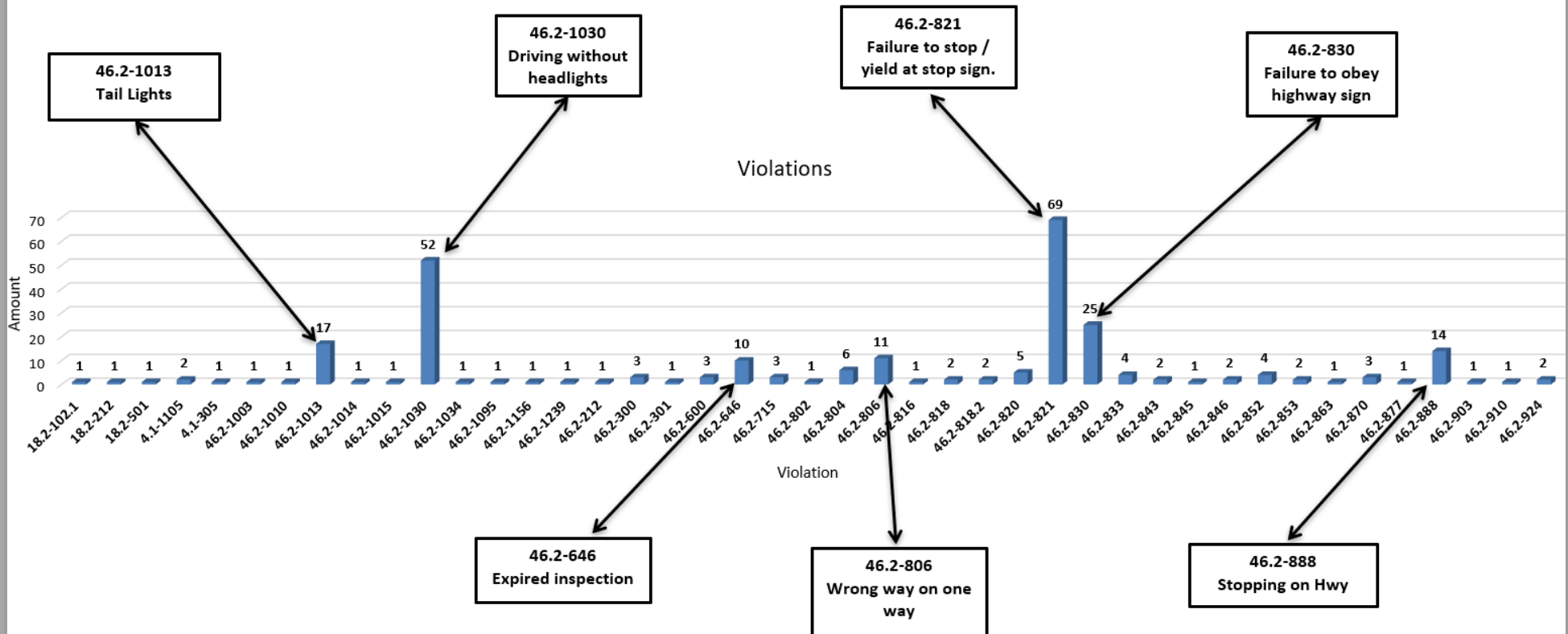
Of the 264 traffic stops, the following chart depicts the gender of drivers upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.

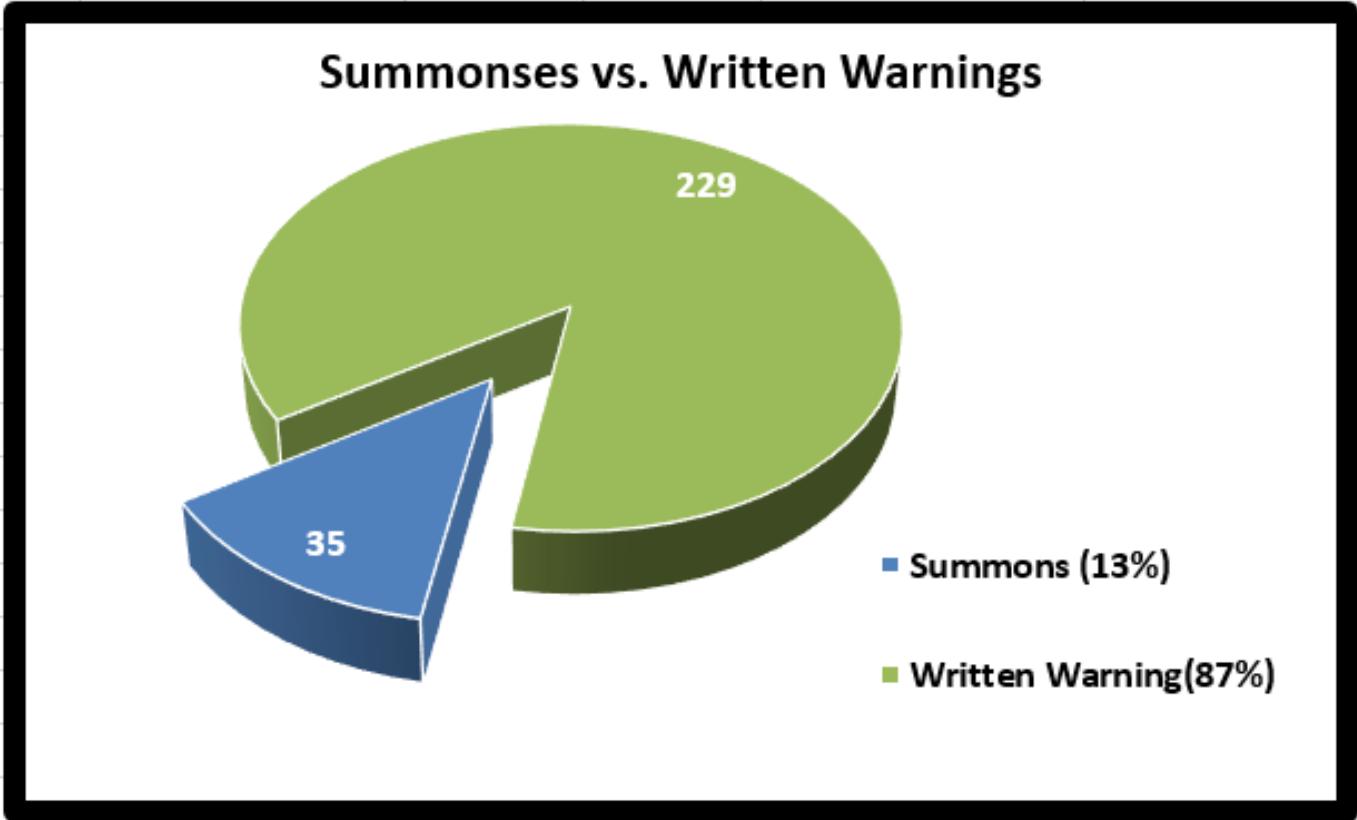


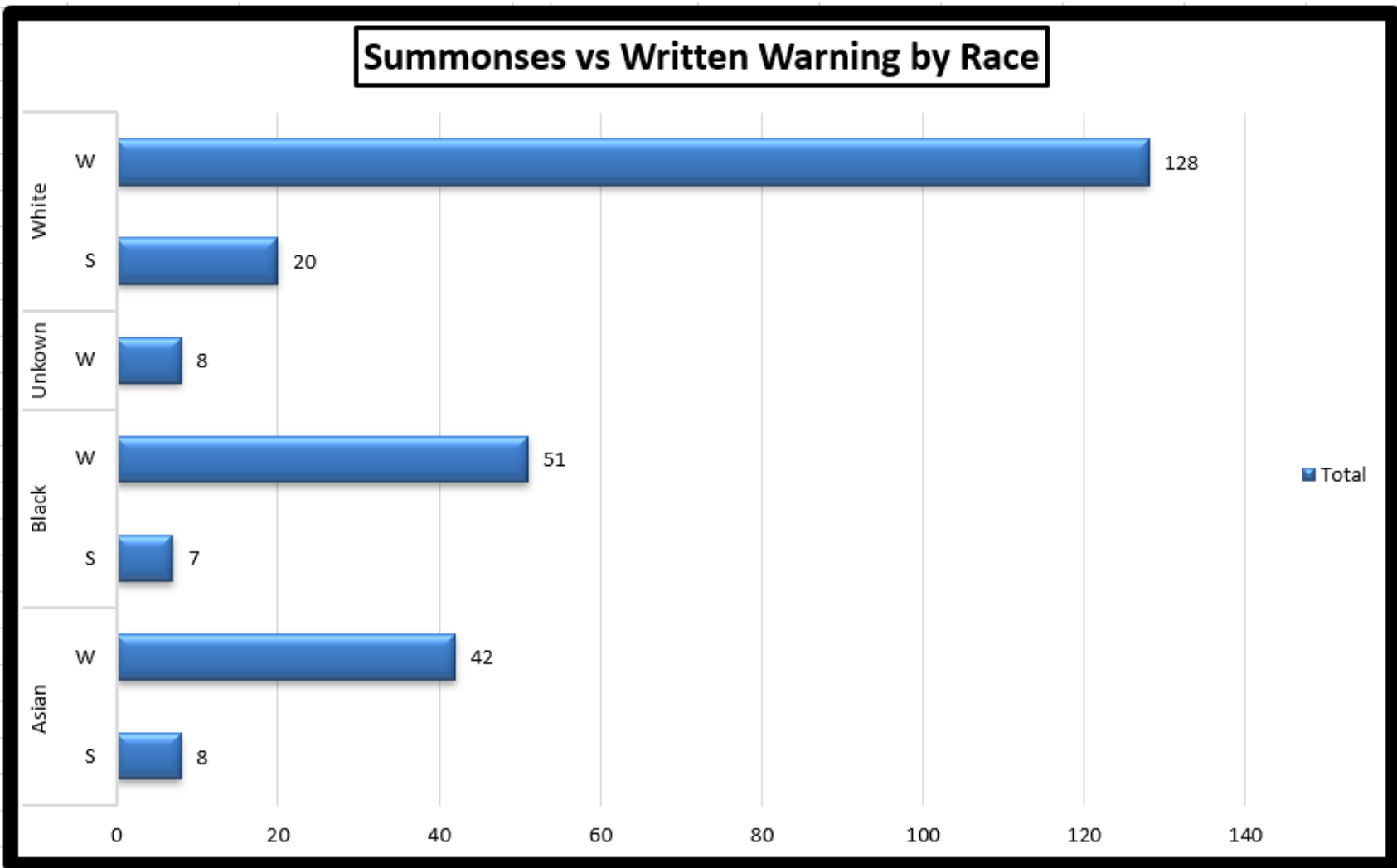
Of the 264 traffic stops, the following graph depicts the age of drivers upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.

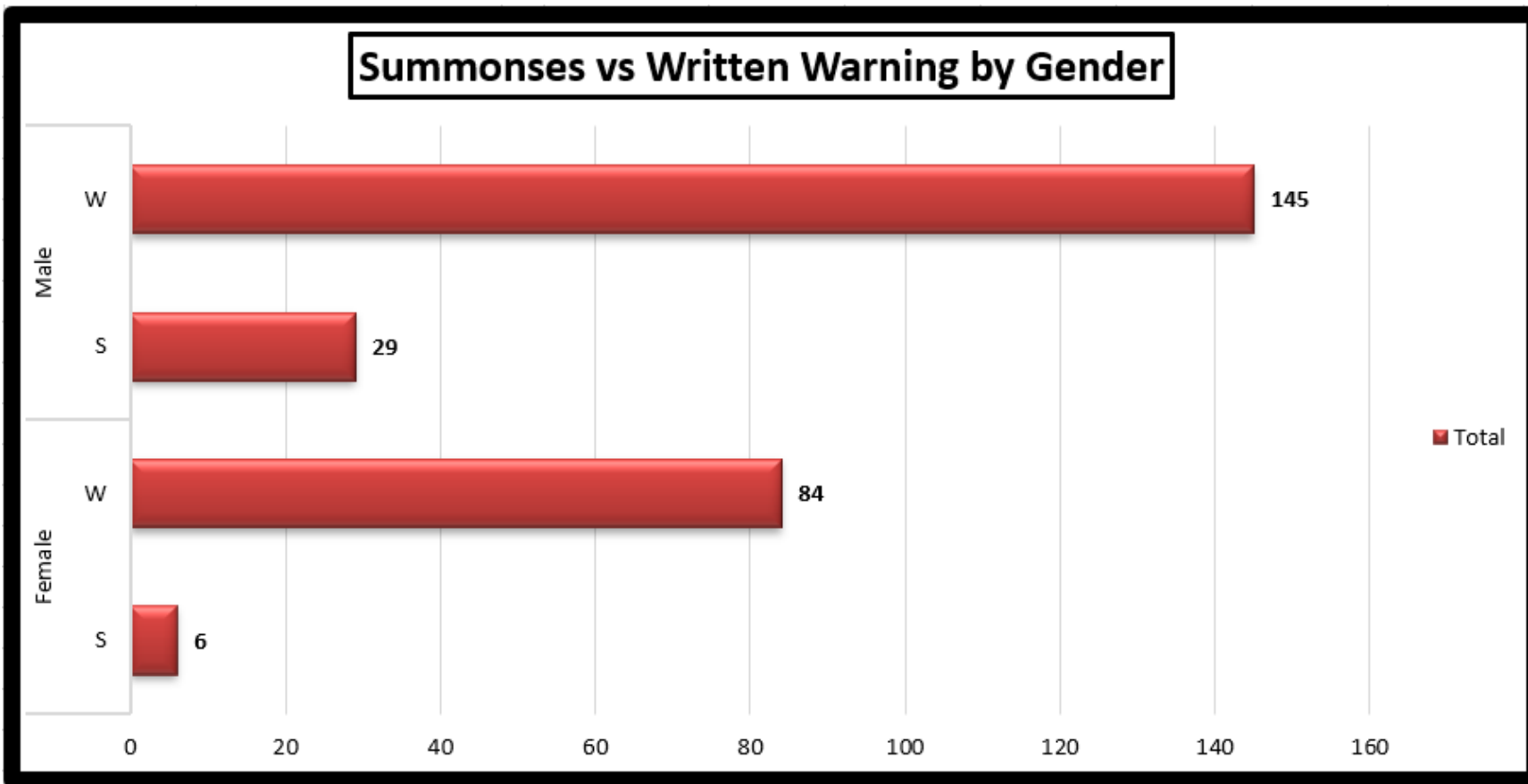
