Mason Police arrested two suspects in two separate past-occurred sexual assault cases. See below for updates to the previously issued Timely Warning Notifications:

- On May 3, 2015, Mason Police issued a Timely Warning Notification for an incident at Potomac Heights involving a female victim (GMU student) who may have unknowingly ingested an unidentified drug prior to being sexually assaulted by a male suspect (former GMU student) known to the victim. The suspect was arrested by Mason Police on June 1, 2016 and transported to Fairfax County Adult Detention Center and therefore no longer poses a criminal threat to the campus community.
- On March 21, 2016, Mason Police issued a Timely Warning Notification for an incident at Potomac Heights involving a female victim (GMU student) who was sexually assaulted by a male suspect (non-GMU) whom the victim met through an online dating application. The suspect was arrested by Mason Police on June 1, 2016 and transported to Fairfax County Adult Detention Center and therefore no longer poses a criminal threat to the campus community.
