### Community Policing Act Data

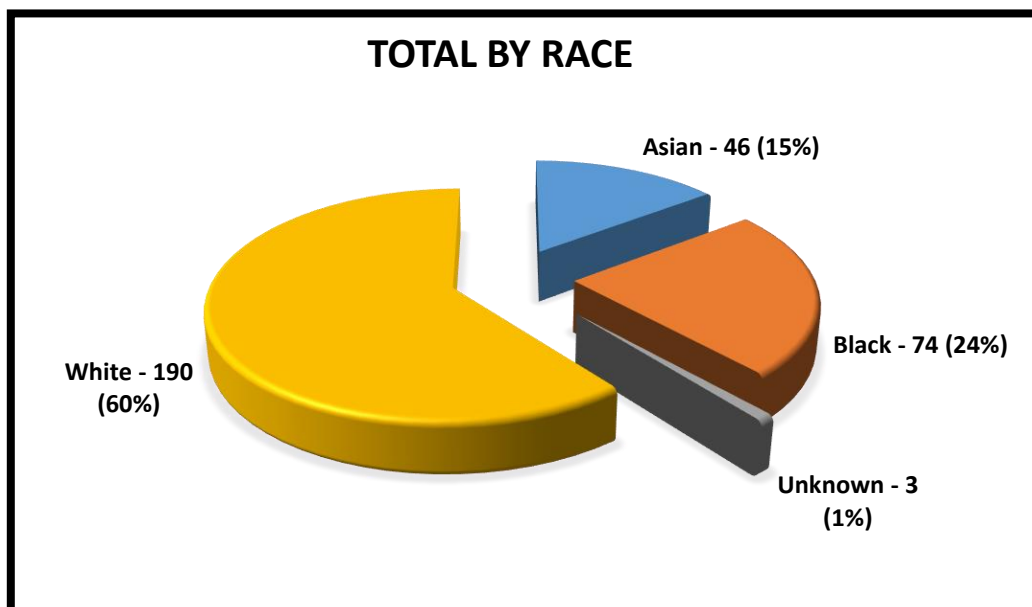

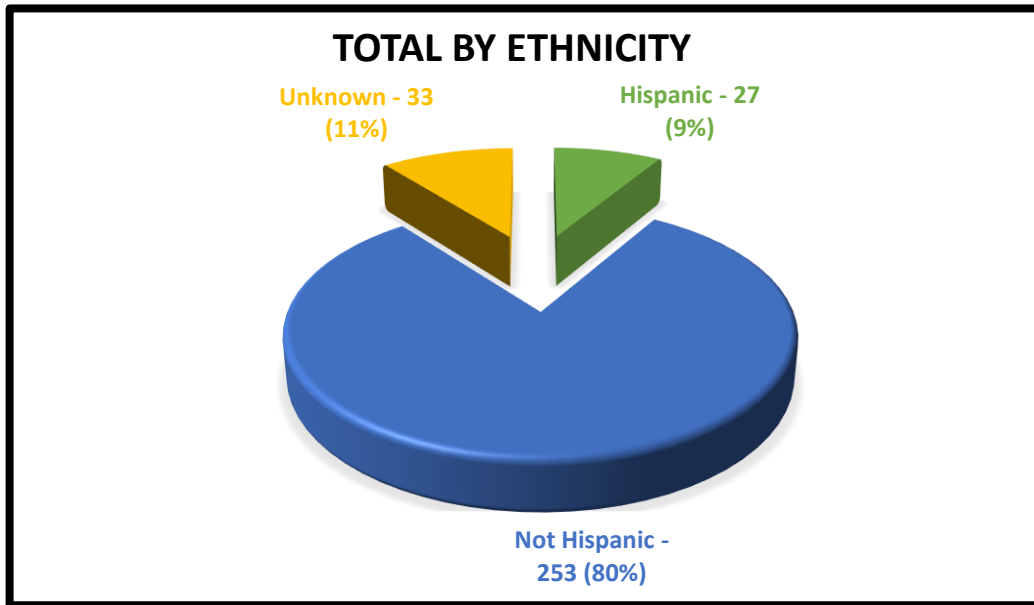
As per the mandate initiated on July 1, 2020 by Governor Northam, as well as the Virginia General Assembly, the information encapsulated in this report pertains to traffic stops initiated by sworn officers of the George Mason University Police Department. Data shows information regarding traffic stops from April 1, 2023 – June 30, 2023. The data used to formulate the following charts/graphs was submitted to the Virginia State Police on July 14<sup>th</sup>. Data will now be submitted on a monthly basis. The next data collection will cover the timeframe of July. 1, 2023 – July 31, 2023 and will be due by Aug. 15, 2023.

There were a total of 313 traffic stops from April 1, 2023 – June 30, 2023.

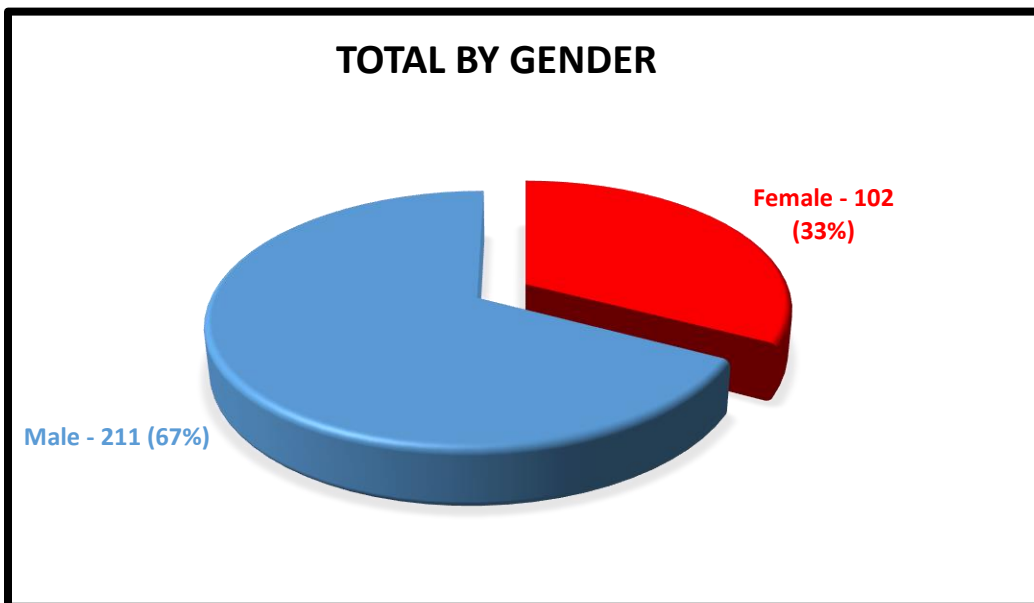
Of the 313 traffic stops, the following chart depicts the race of drivers upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.



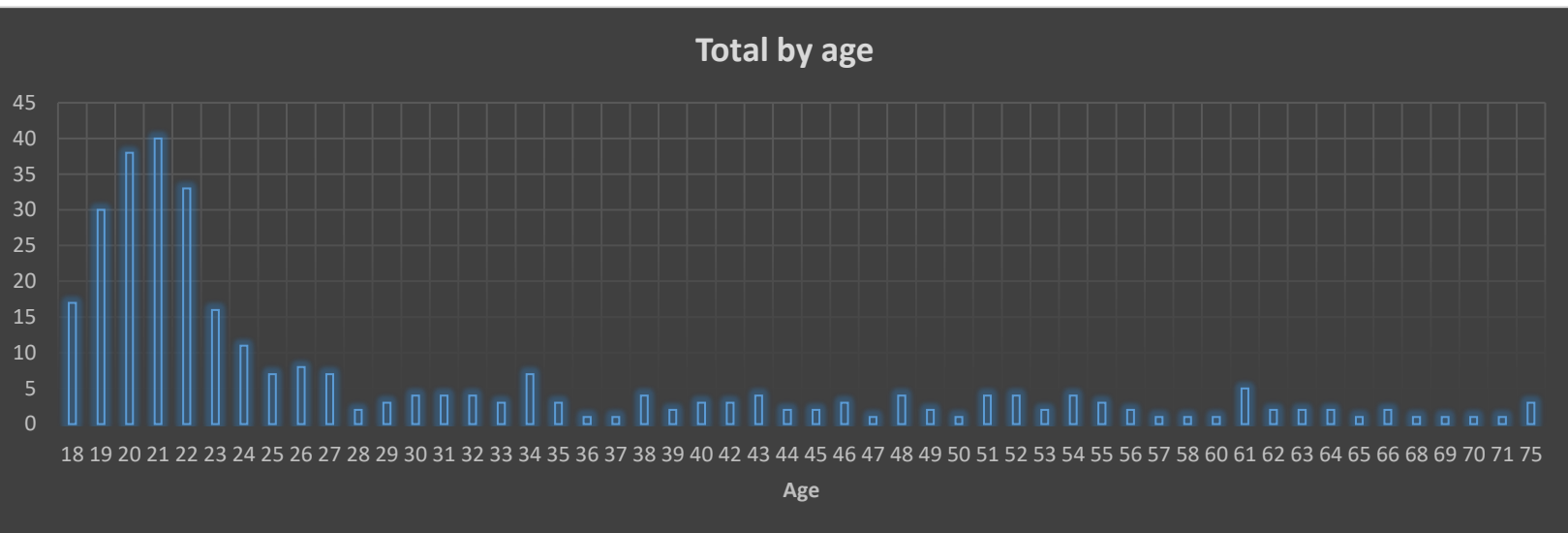
Of the 313 traffic stops, the following chart depicts the ethnicity of drivers upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.



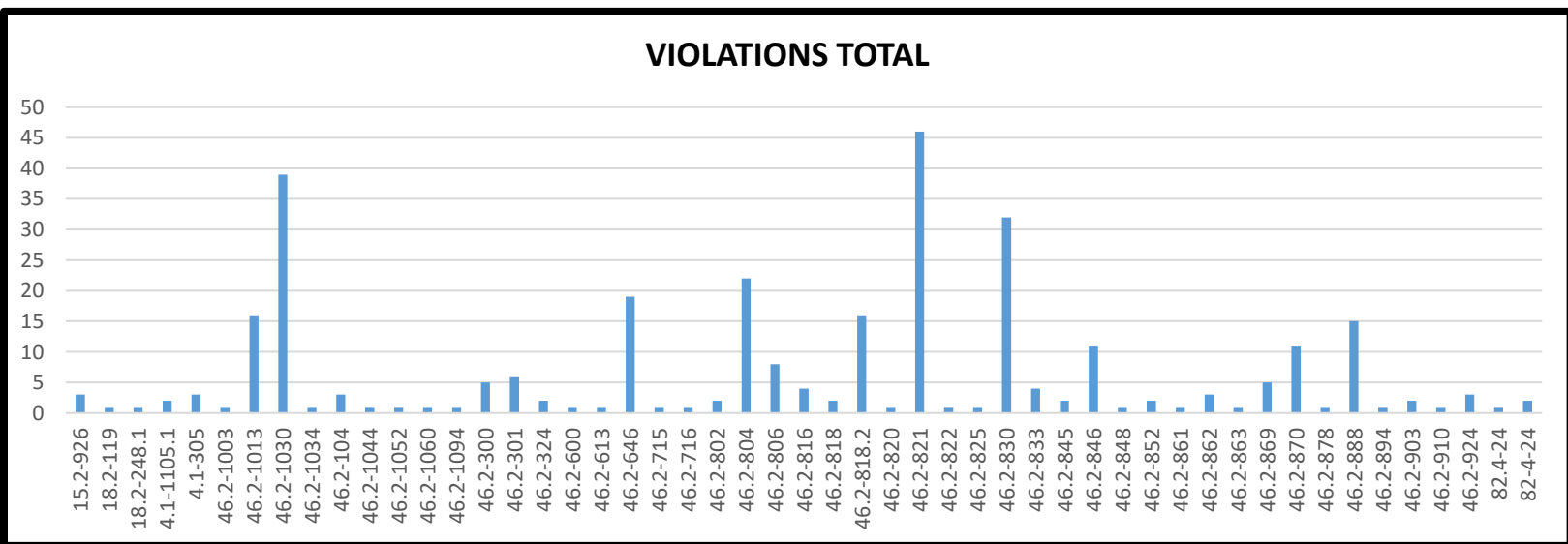
Of the 313 traffic stops, the following chart depicts the gender of drivers upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.
