

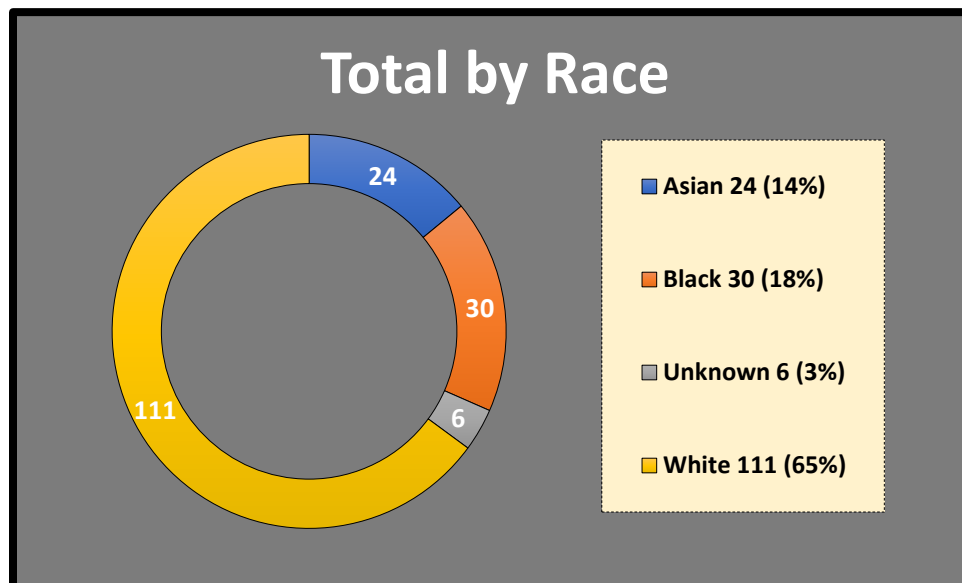

Aug. 1 – Aug. 31, 2023



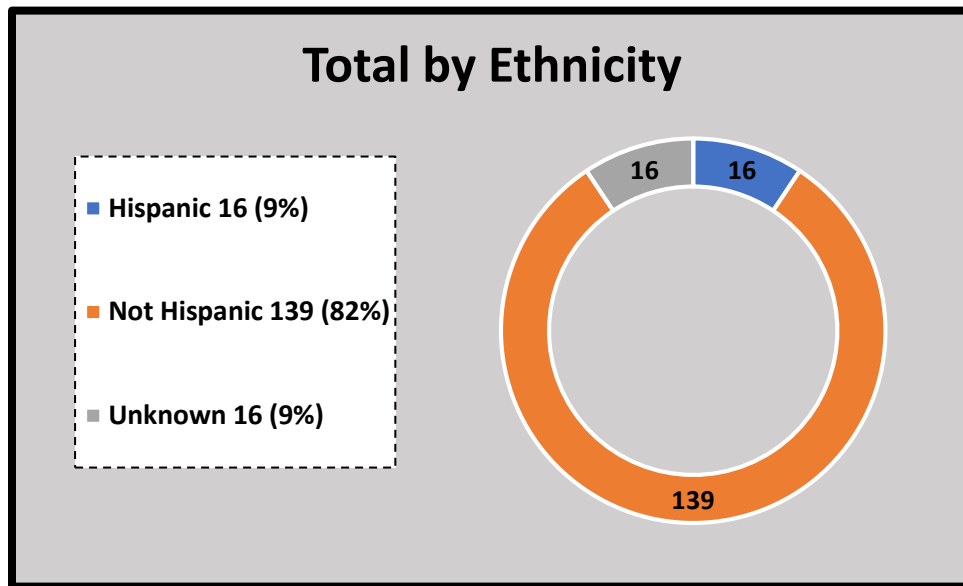
As per the mandate initiated on July 1, 2020 by Governor Northam, as well as the Virginia General Assembly, the information encapsulated in this report pertains to traffic stops initiated by sworn officers of the George Mason University Police Department. Data shows information regarding traffic stops Aug. 1 – Aug. 31, 2023. The data used to formulate the following charts/graphs was submitted to the Virginia State Police on September 13, 2023. The next data collection will cover the timeframe of September 1 – September 30, 2023 and is due by Oct. 15, 2023.

There were a total of 171 traffic stops from Aug. 1 – Aug. 31, 2023.

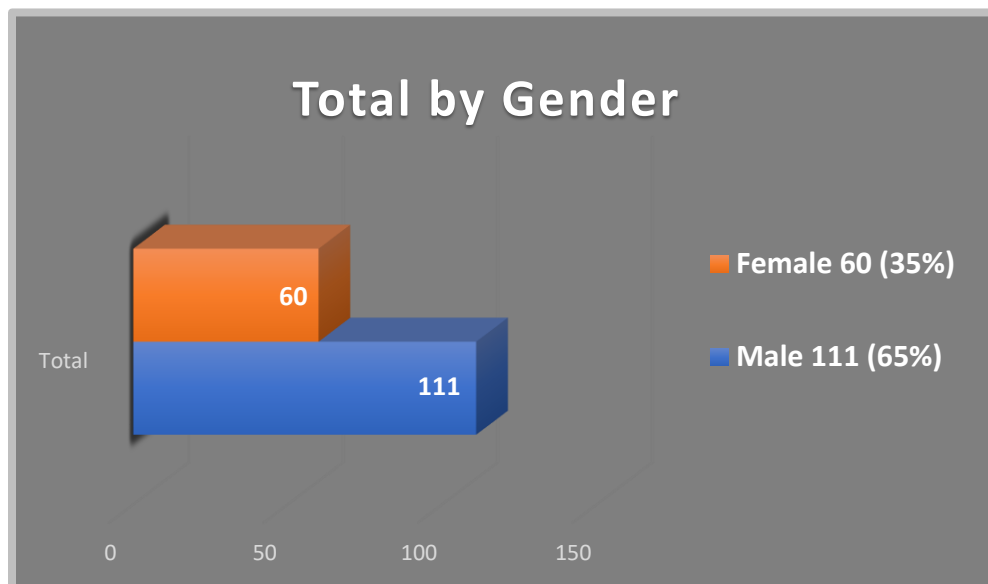
Of the 171 traffic stops, the following chart depicts the race of drivers upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.



Of the 171 traffic stops, the following chart depicts the ethnicity of drivers upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.

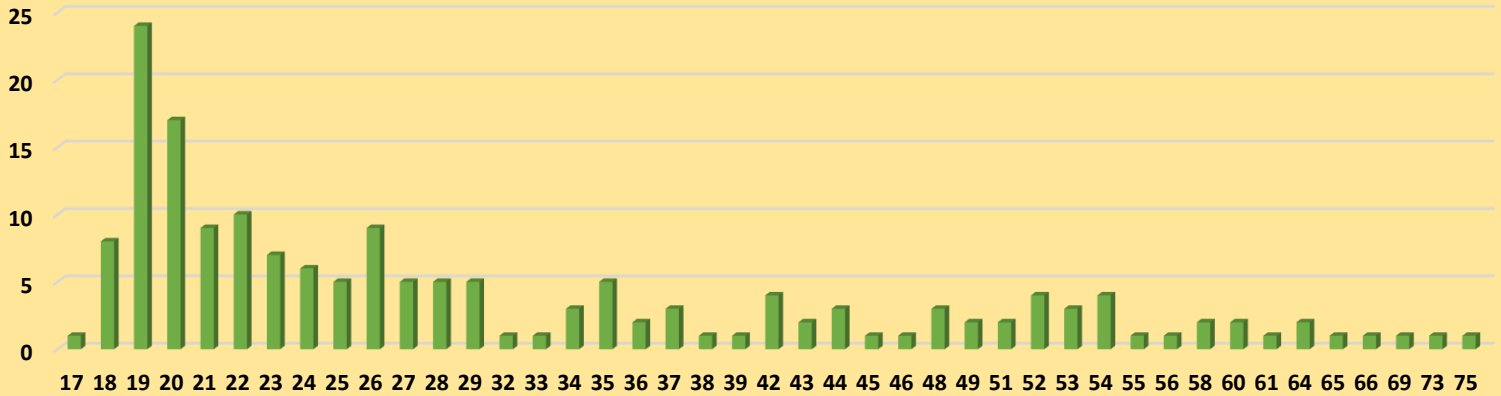


Of the 171 traffic stops, the following chart depicts the gender of drivers upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.



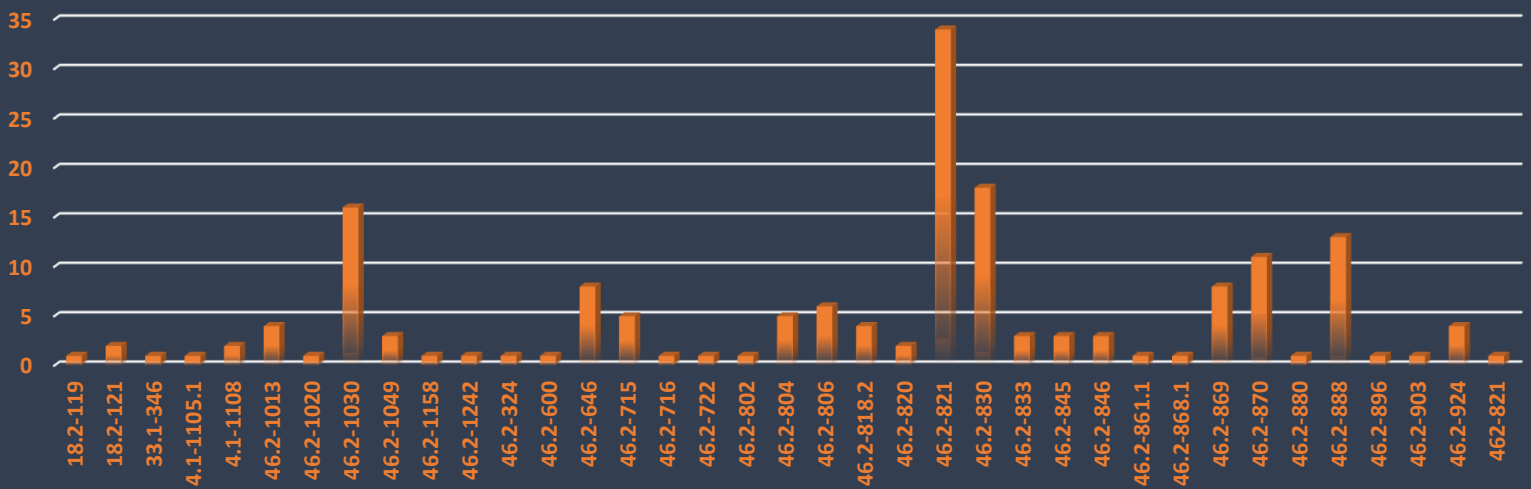
Of the 171 traffic stops, the following graph depicts the age of drivers upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.
