

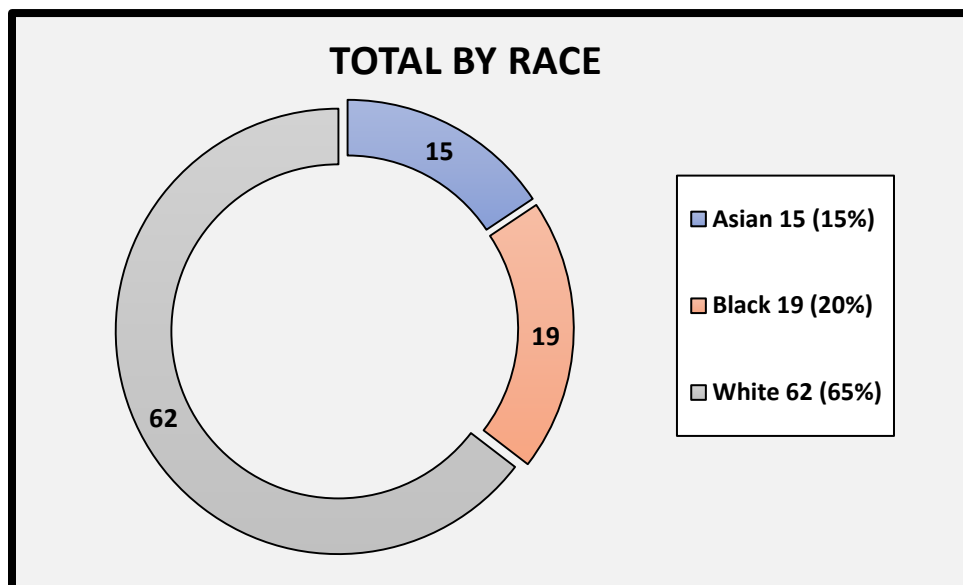

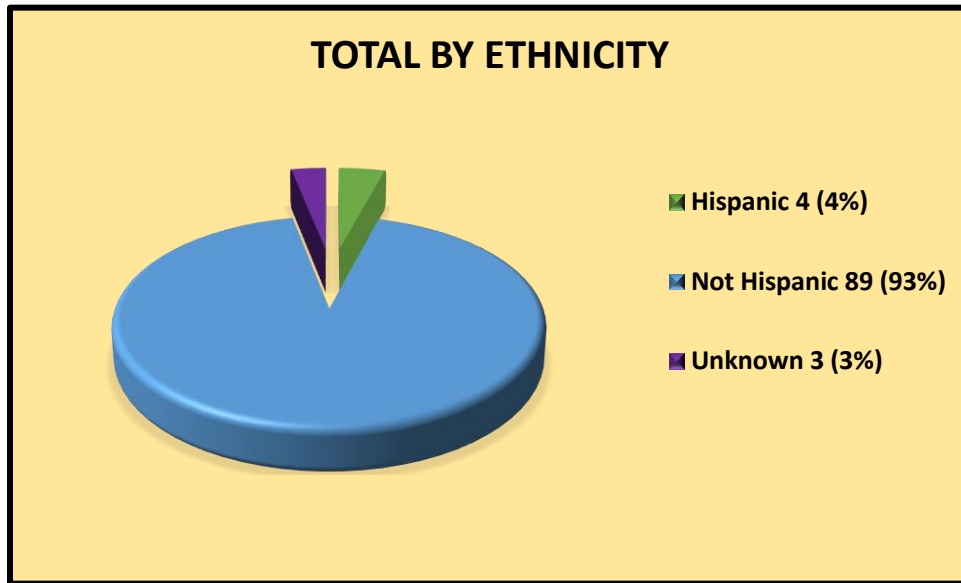

There were a total of 96 traffic stops from Jan. 1, 2024 – Jan. 31, 2024.

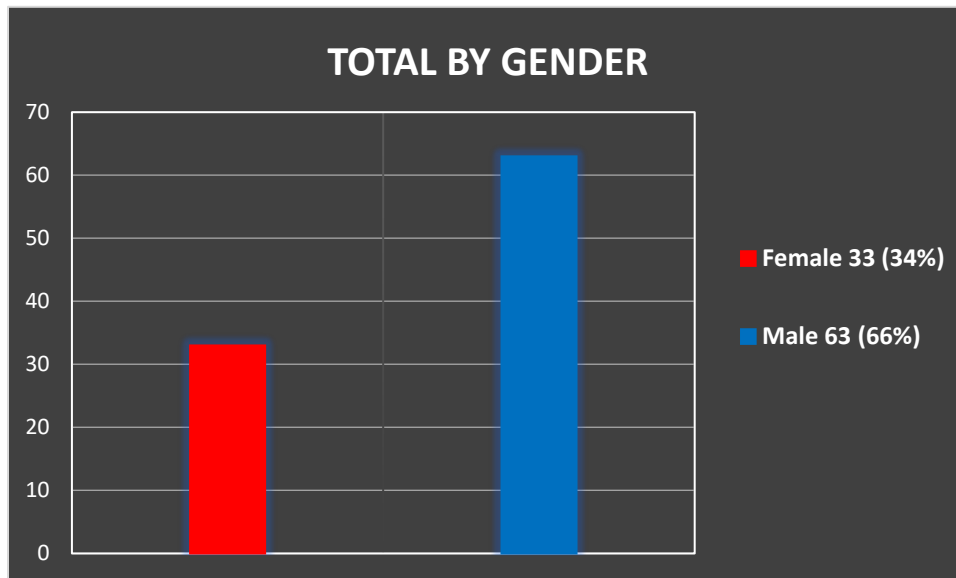

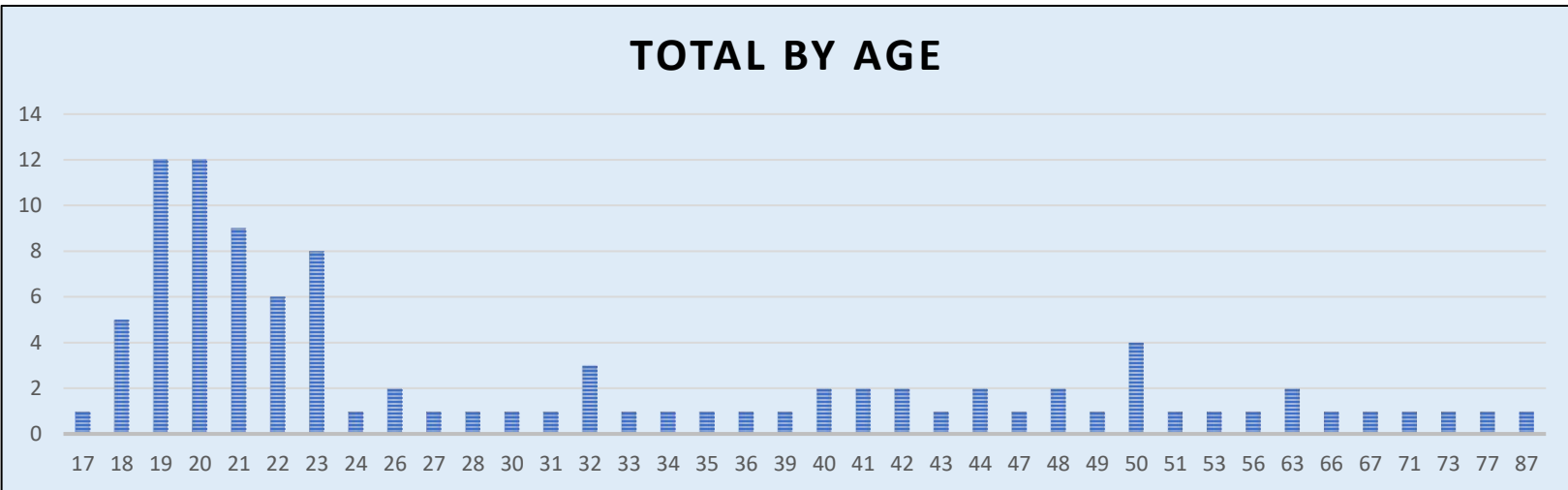
Of the 96 traffic stops, the following chart depicts the ethnicity of drivers upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.



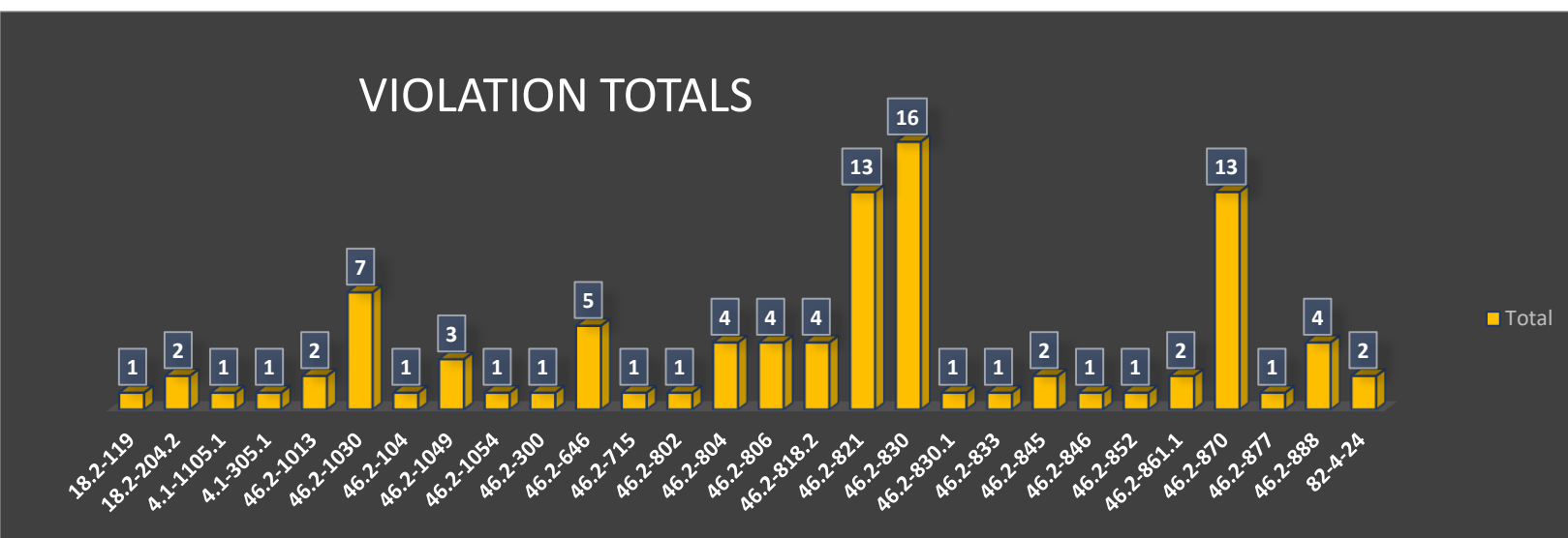
Of the 96 traffic stops, the following chart depicts the gender of drivers upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.

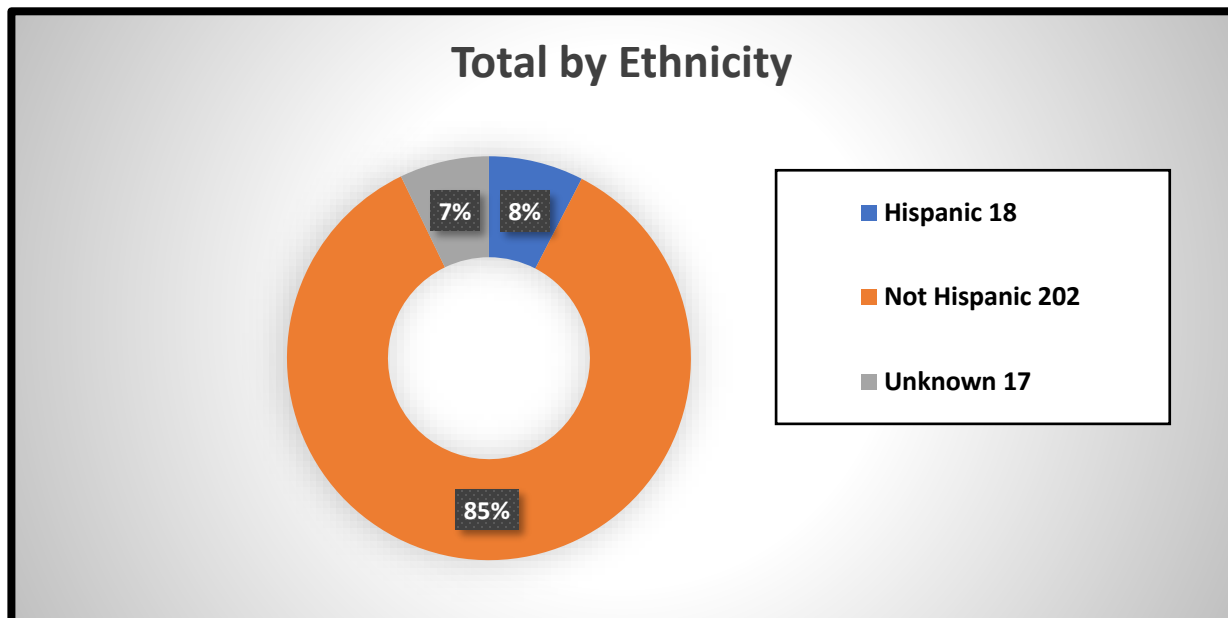

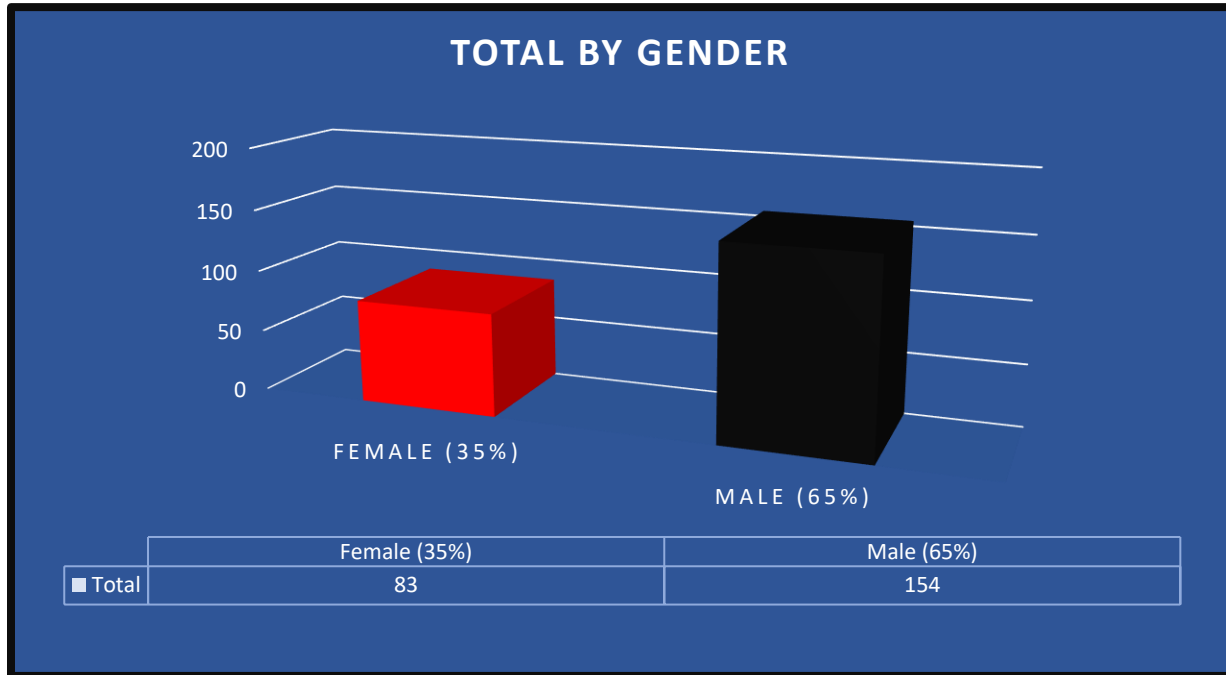

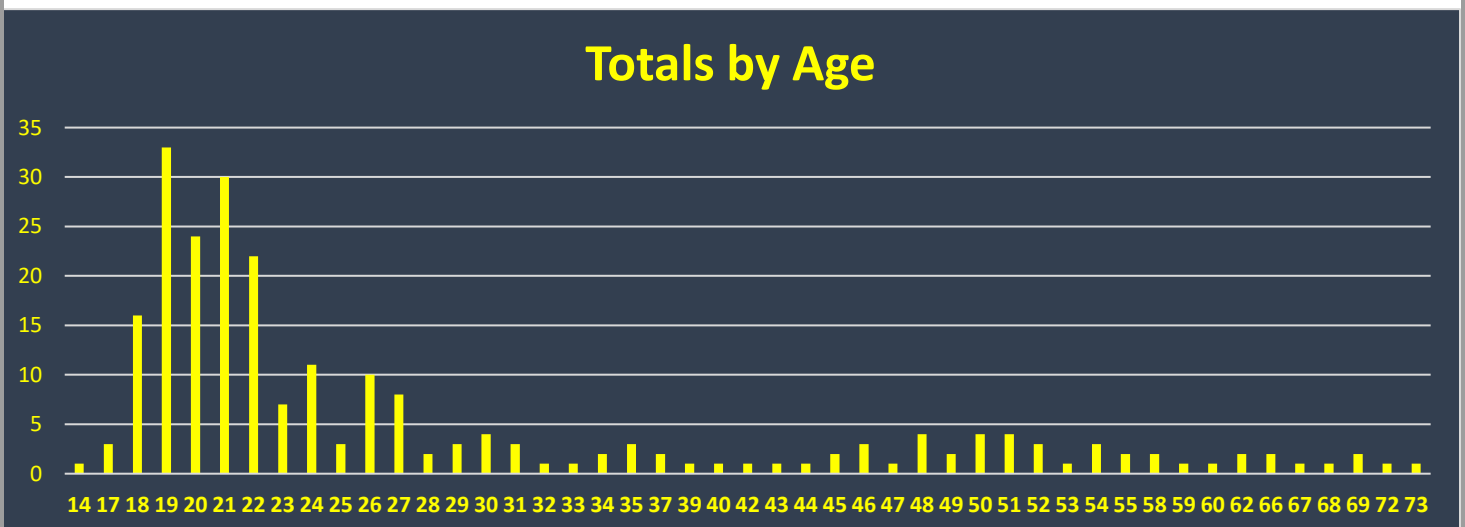

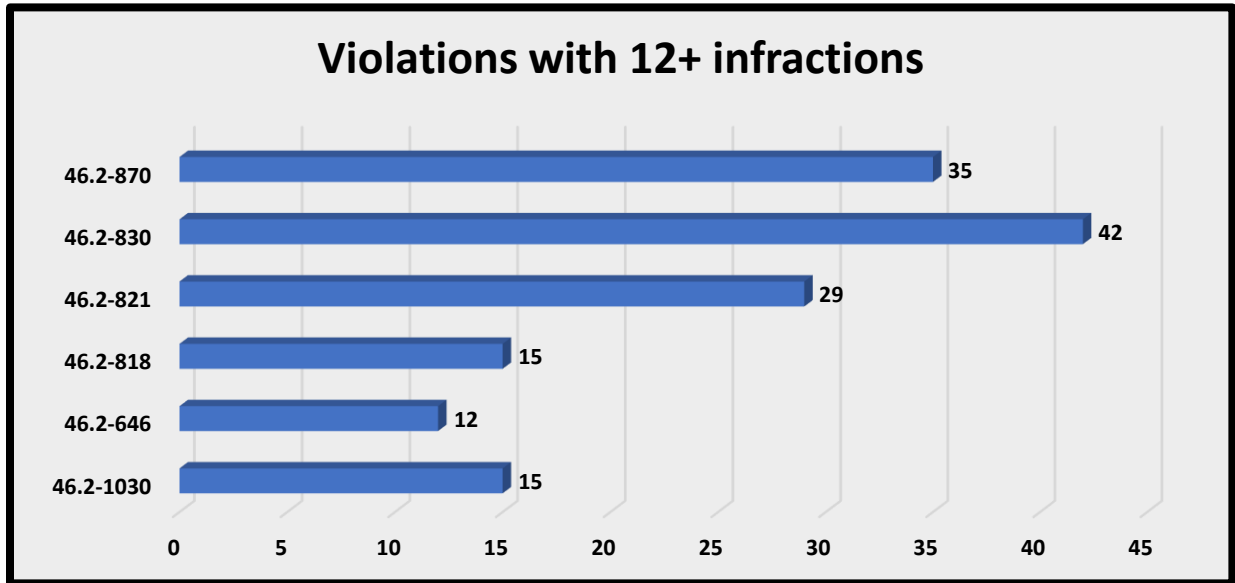

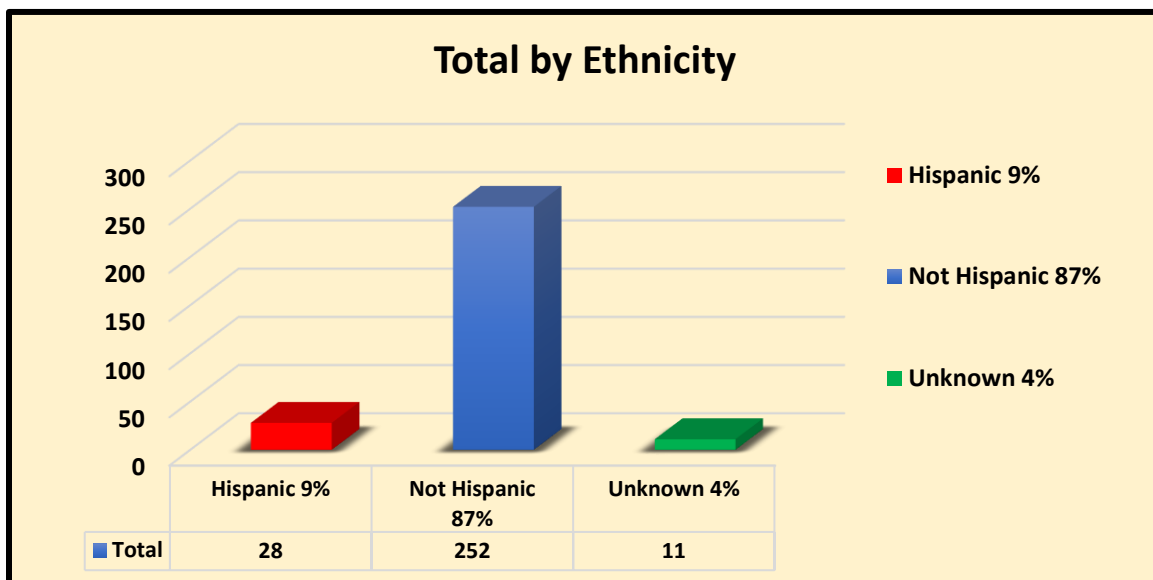

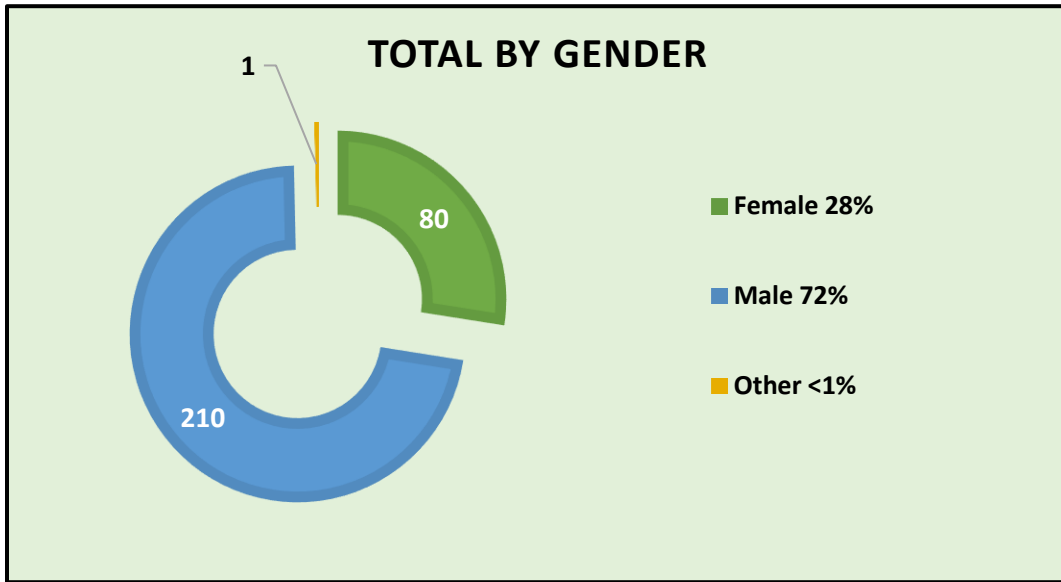

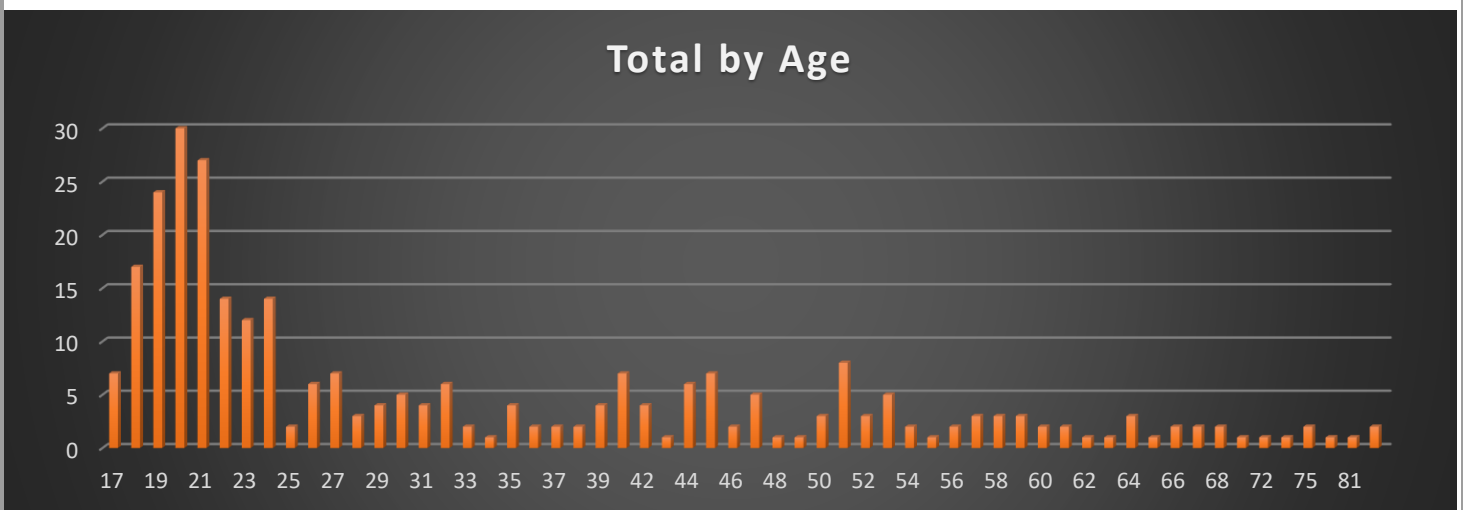

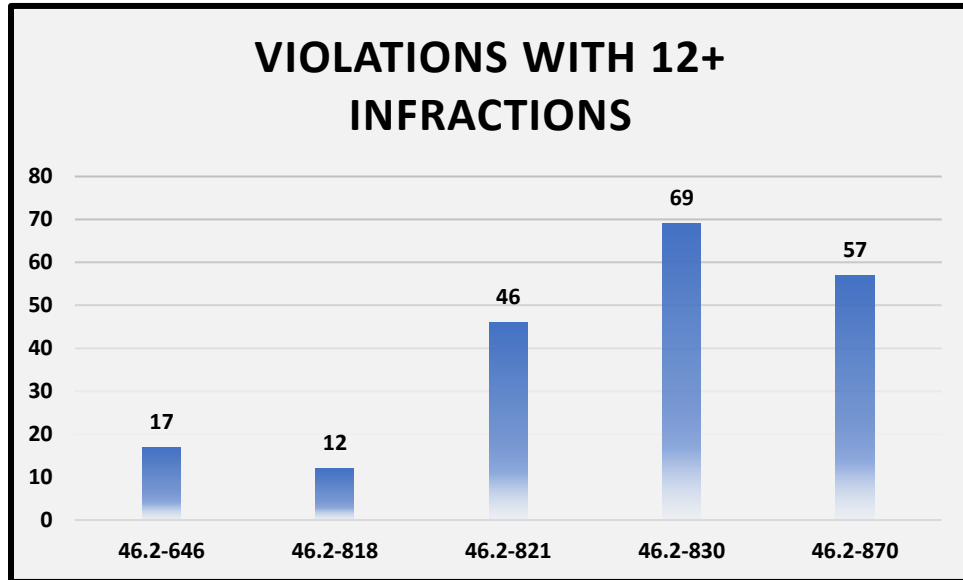

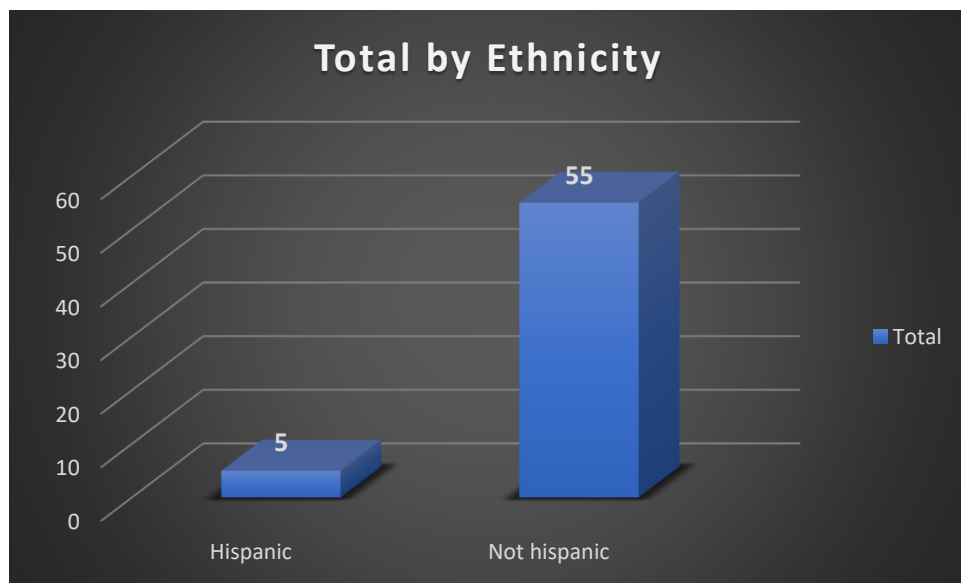

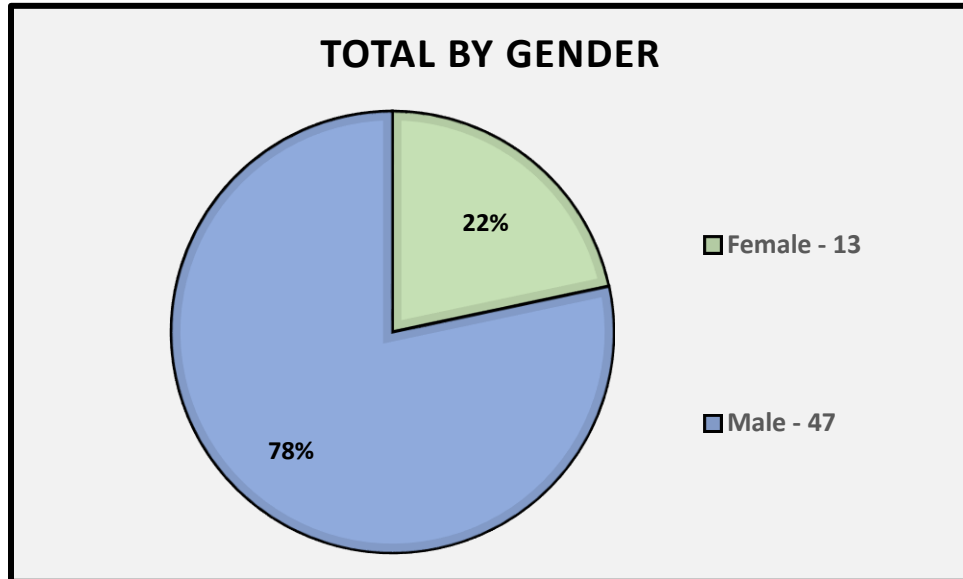

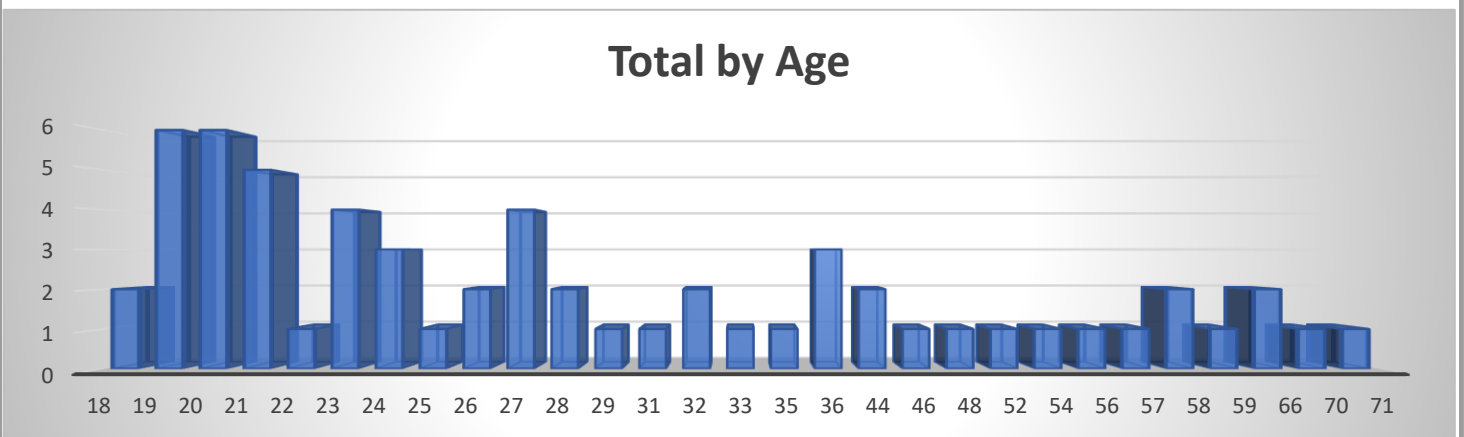

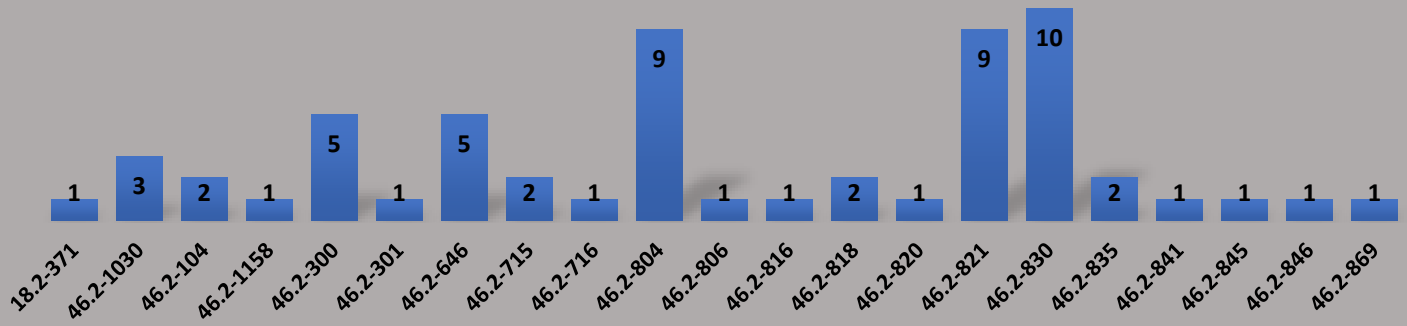
Of the 60 traffic stops, the following chart depicts the gender of drivers upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.



Of the 60 traffic stops, the following graph depicts the age of drivers upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.

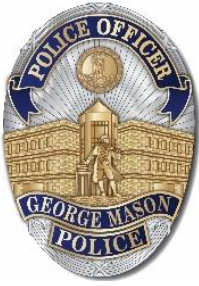

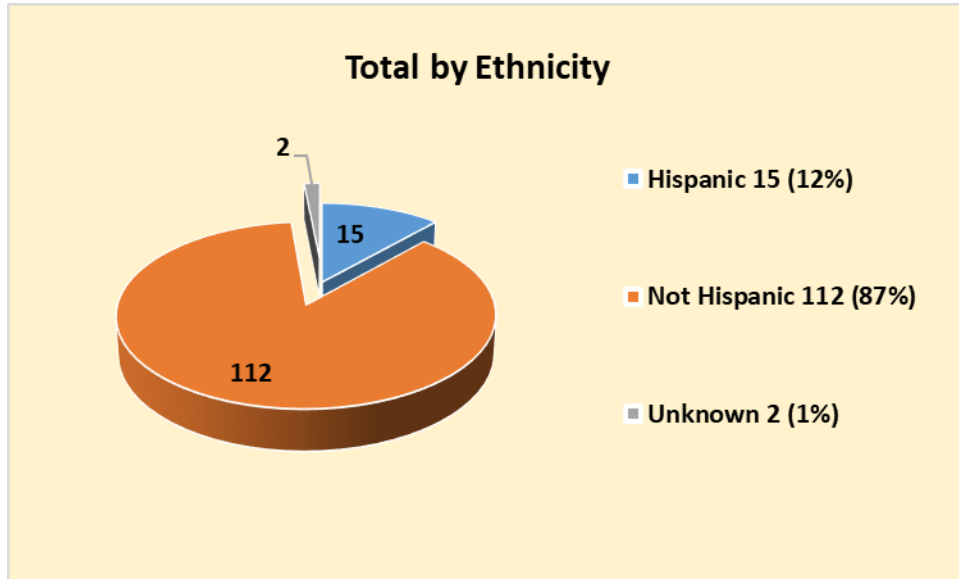

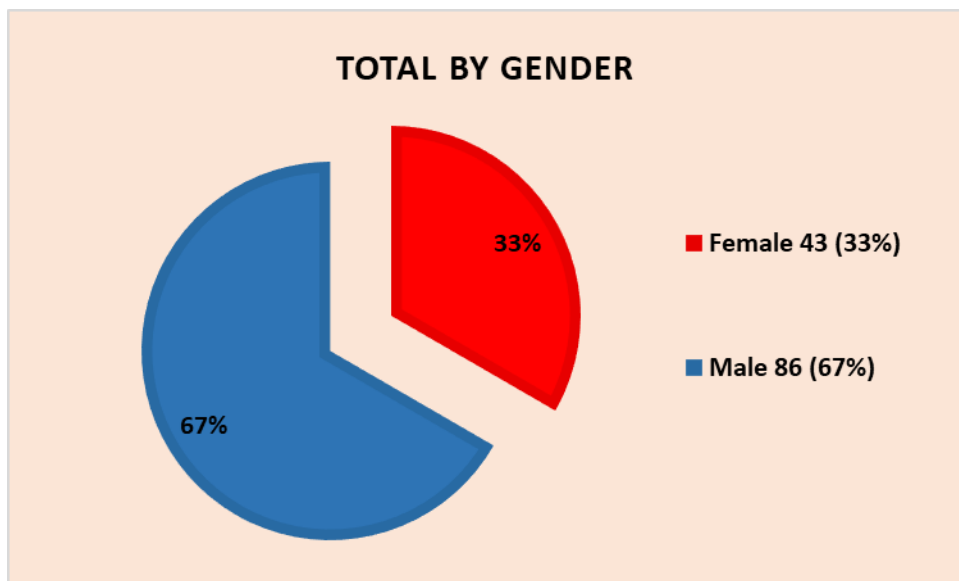

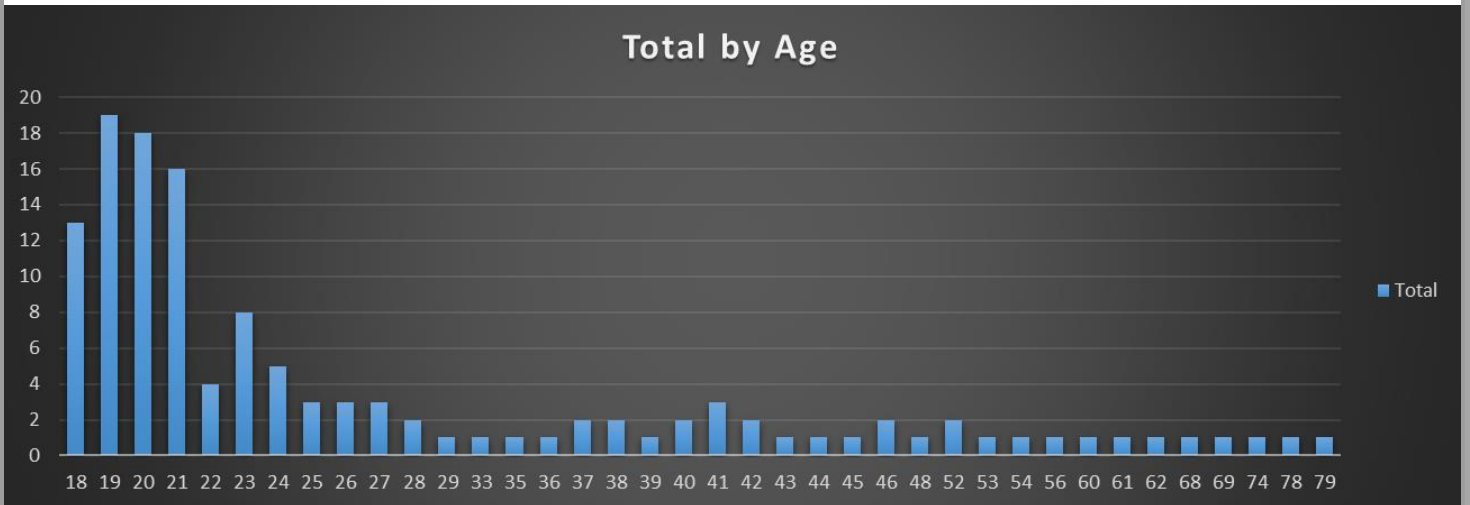

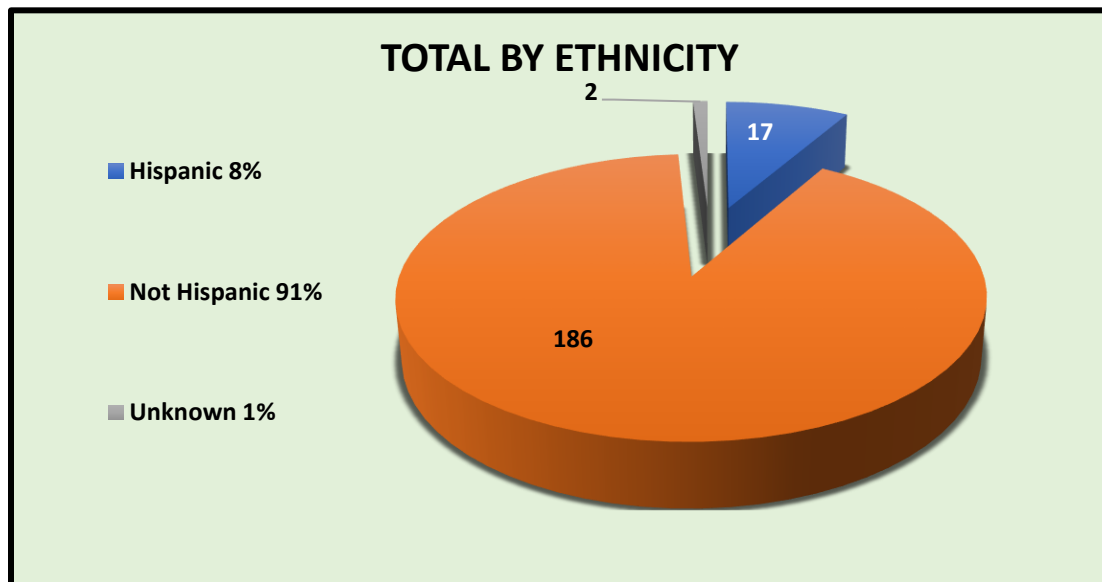

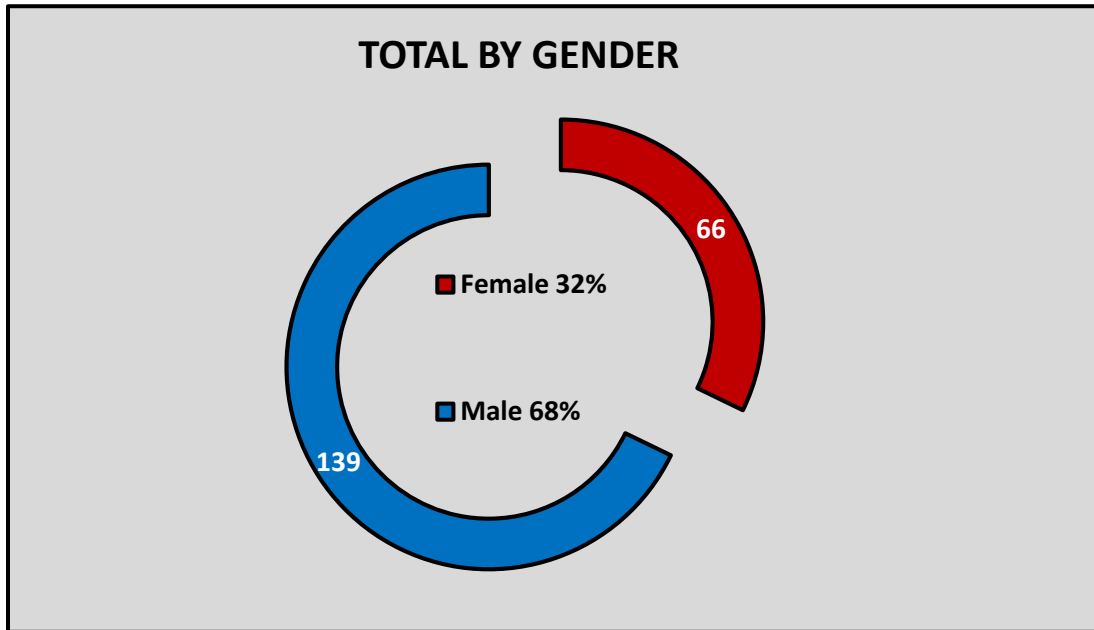

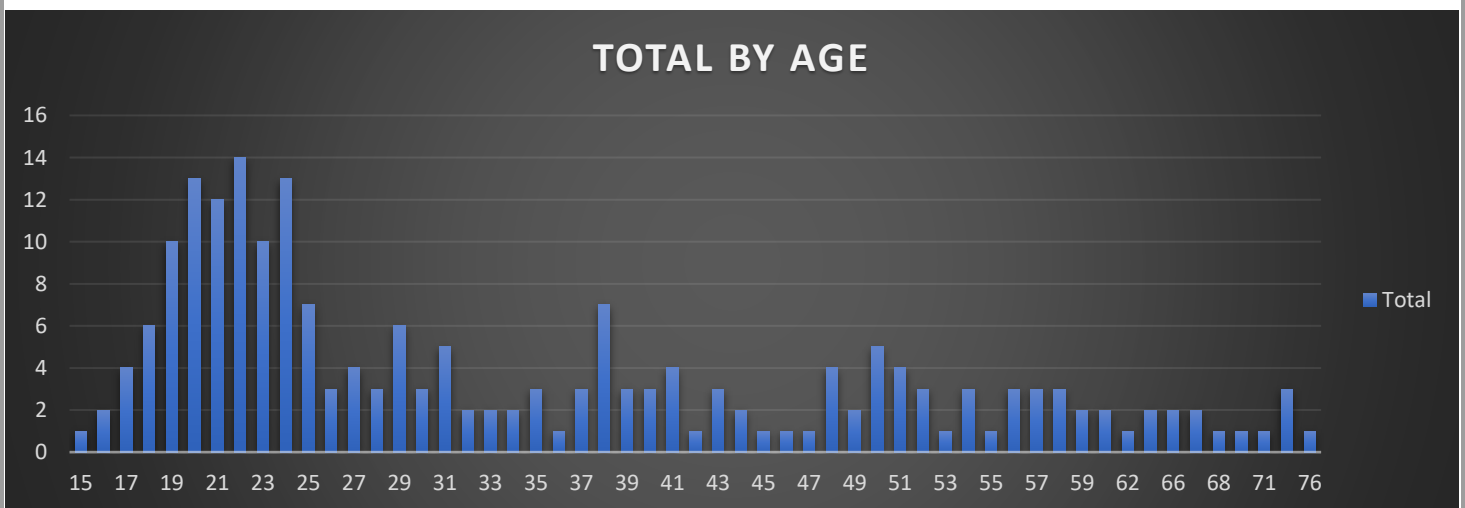

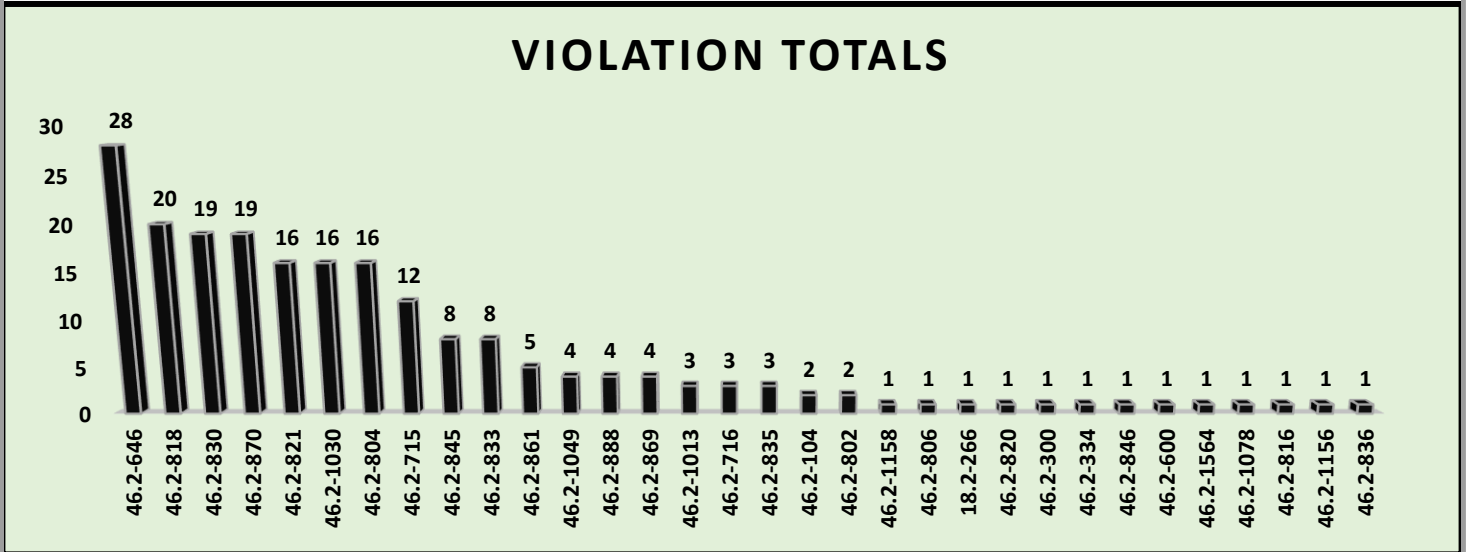

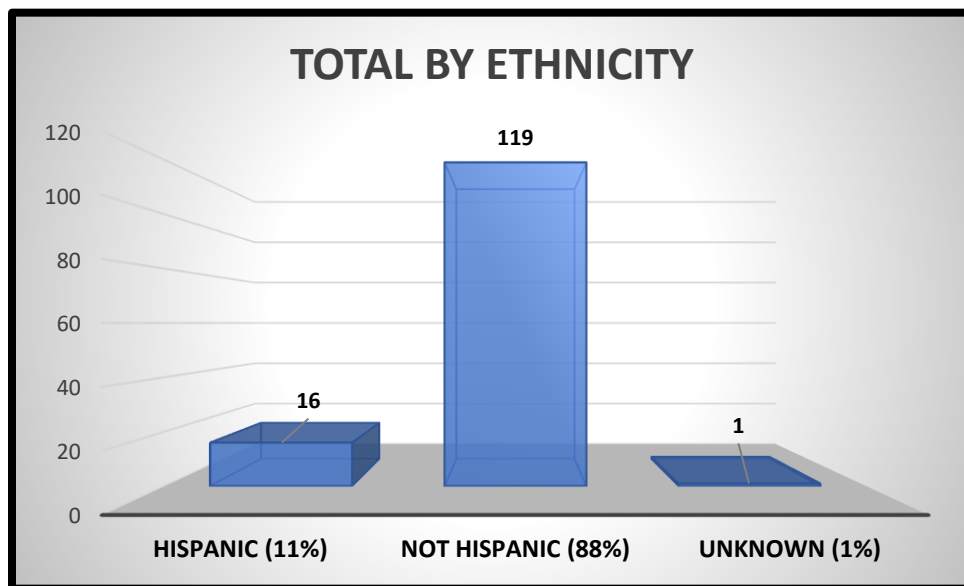

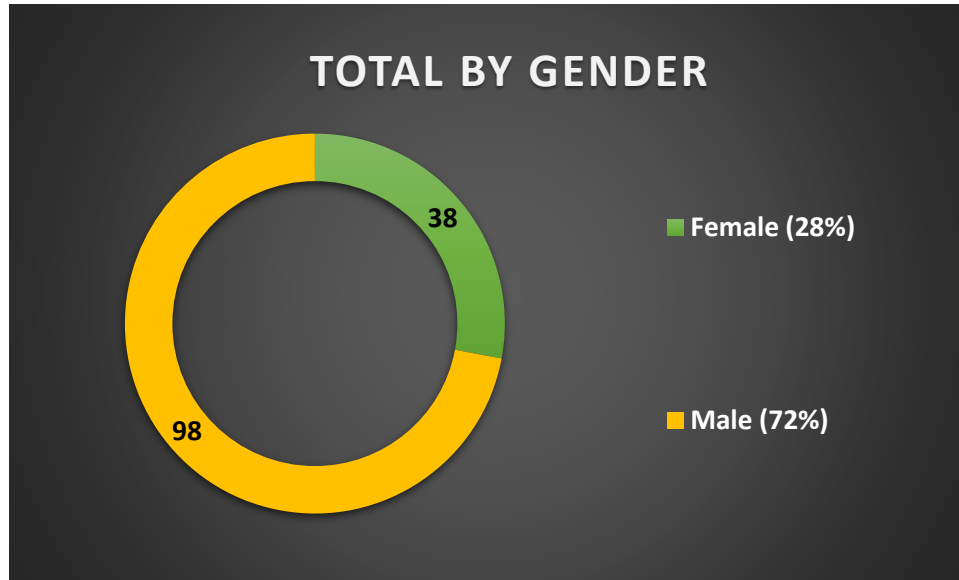

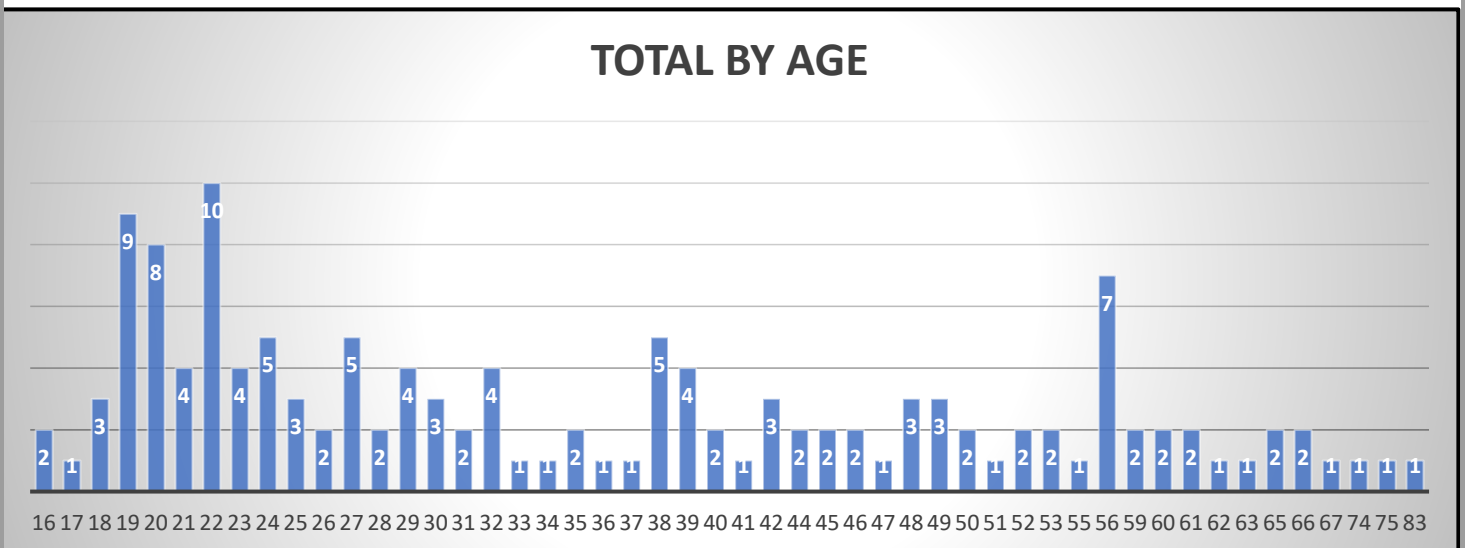

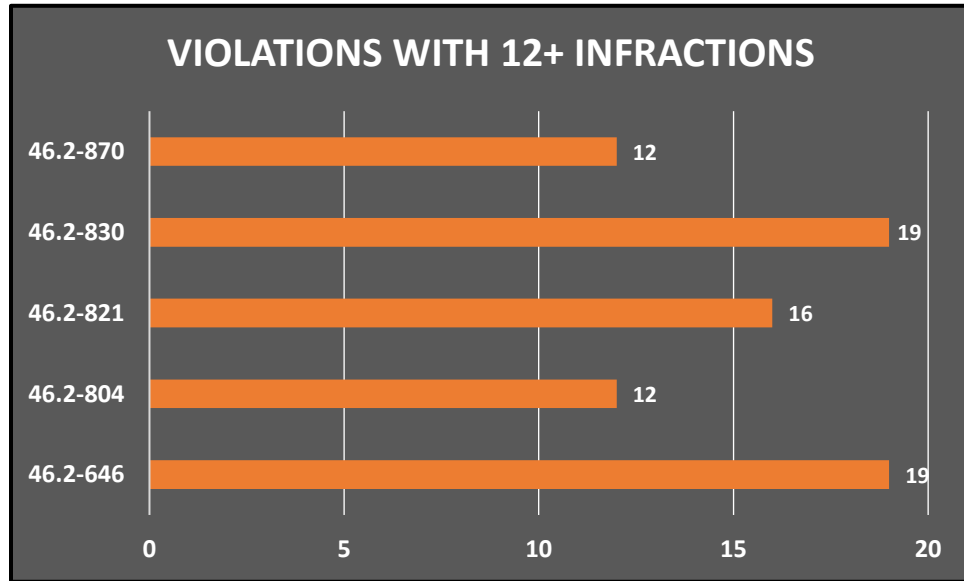

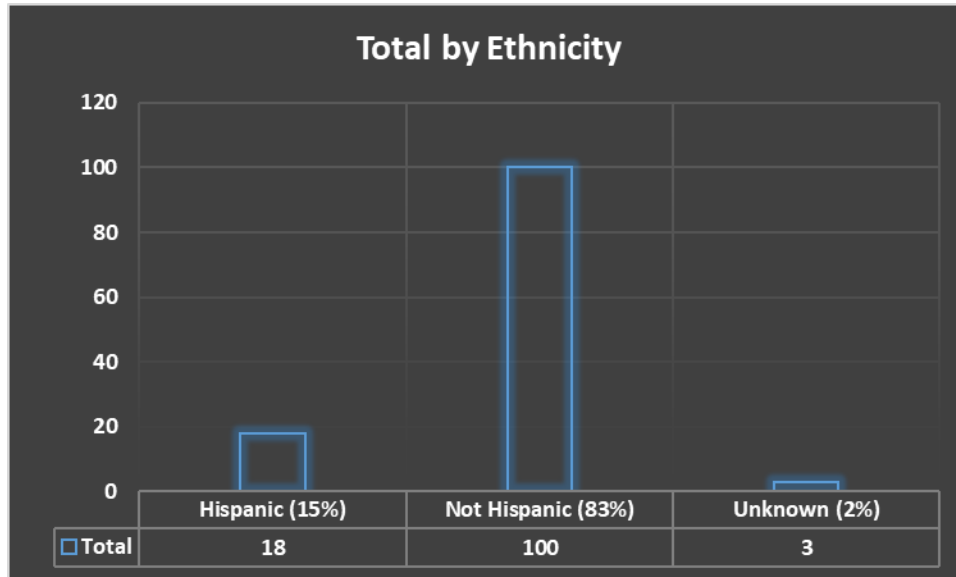

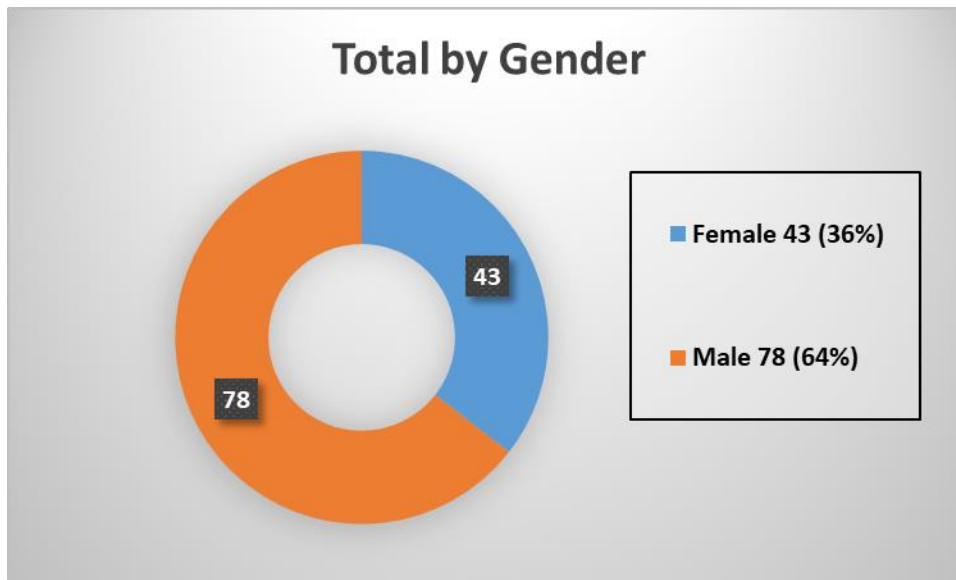

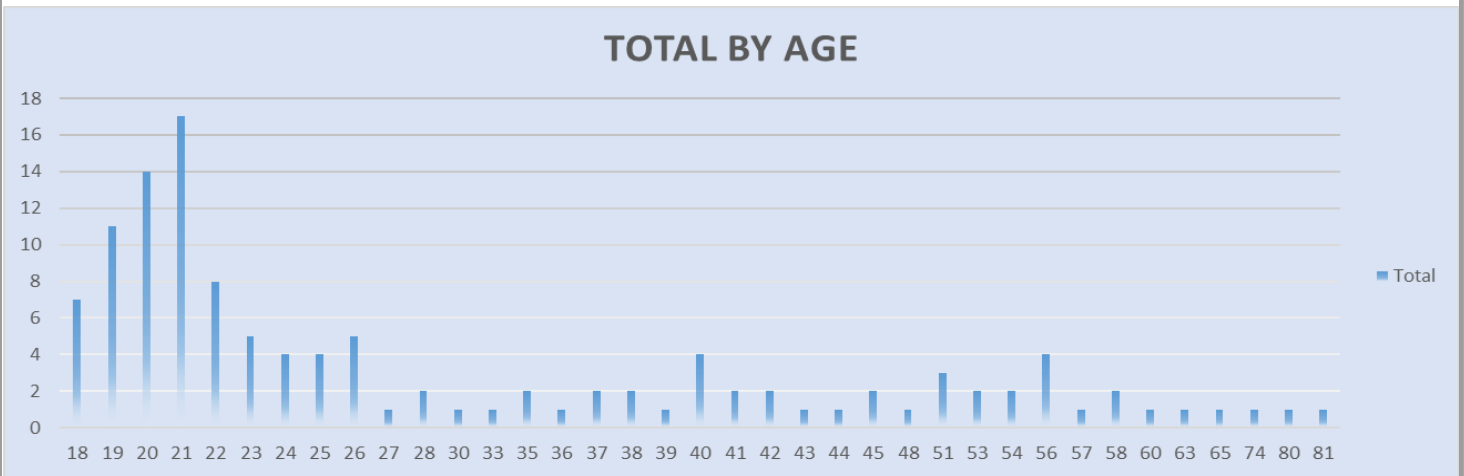

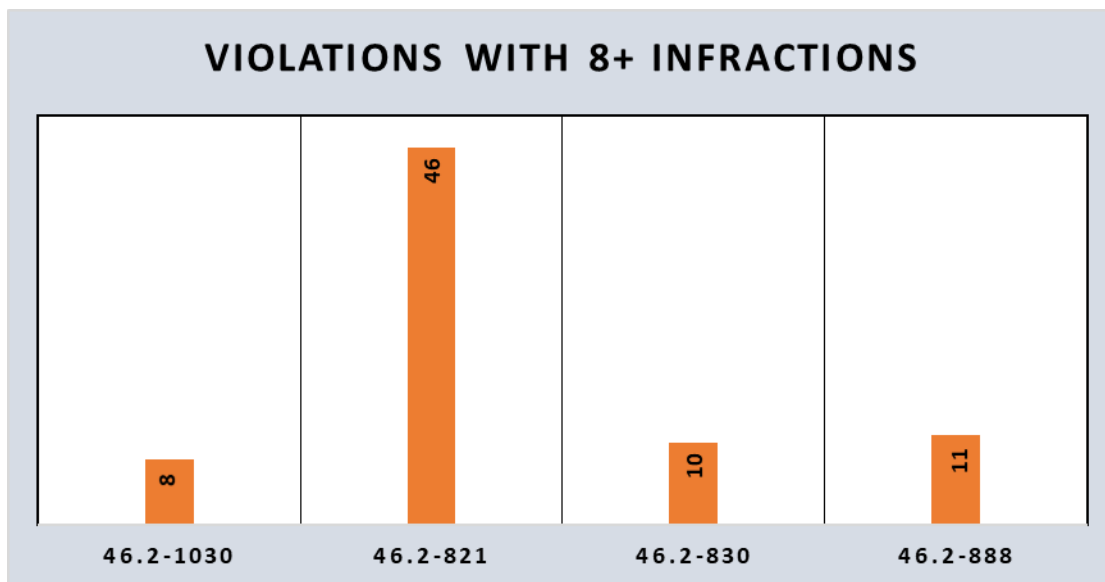

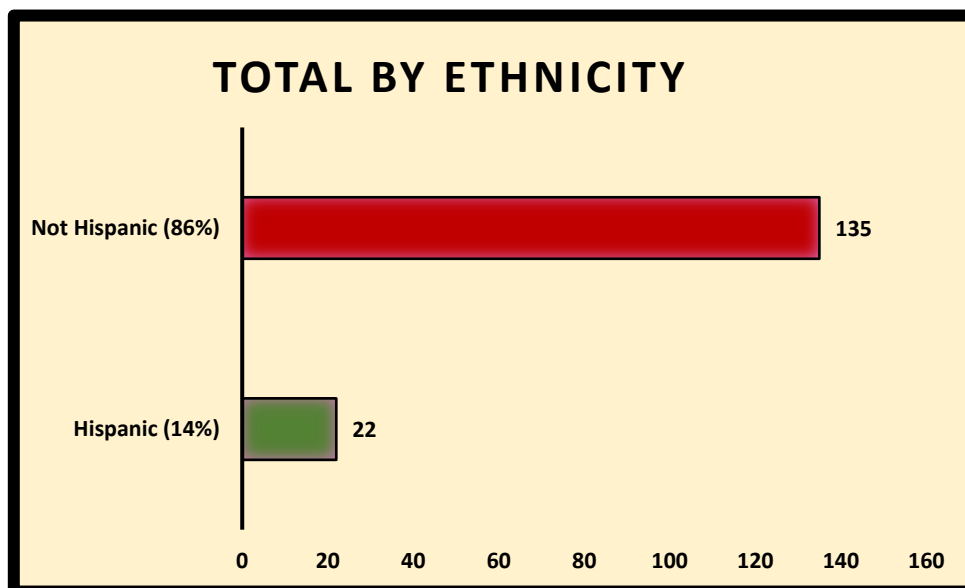

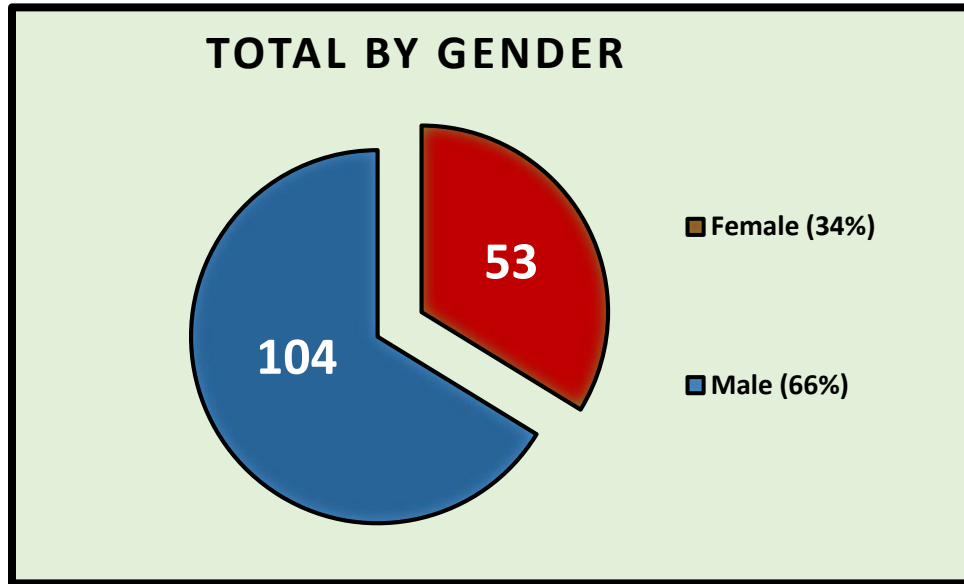

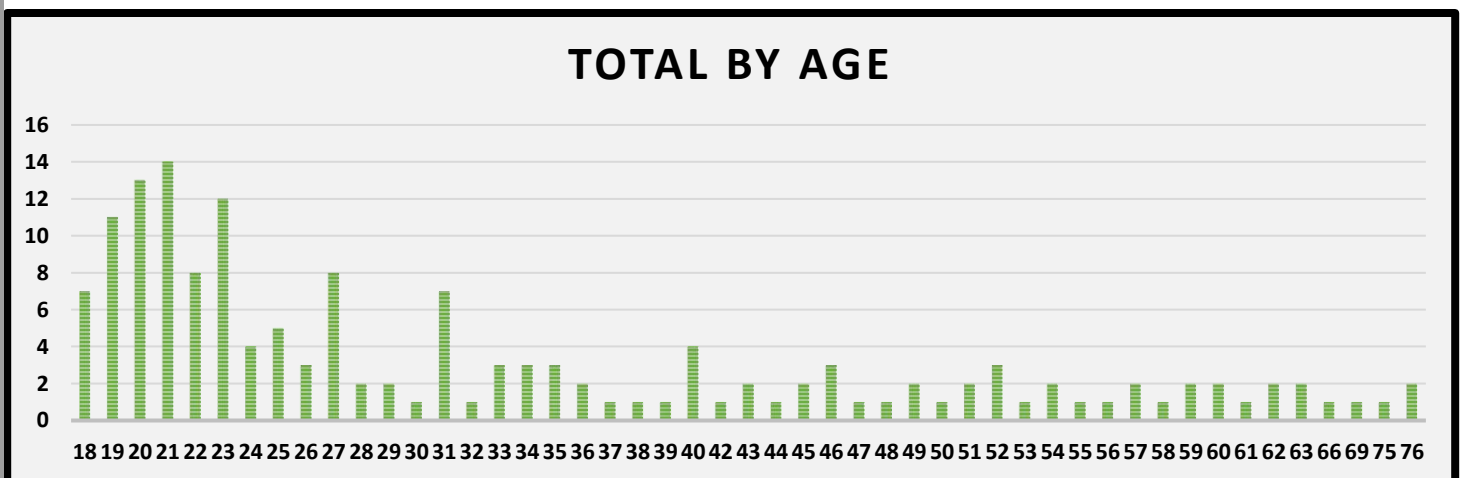

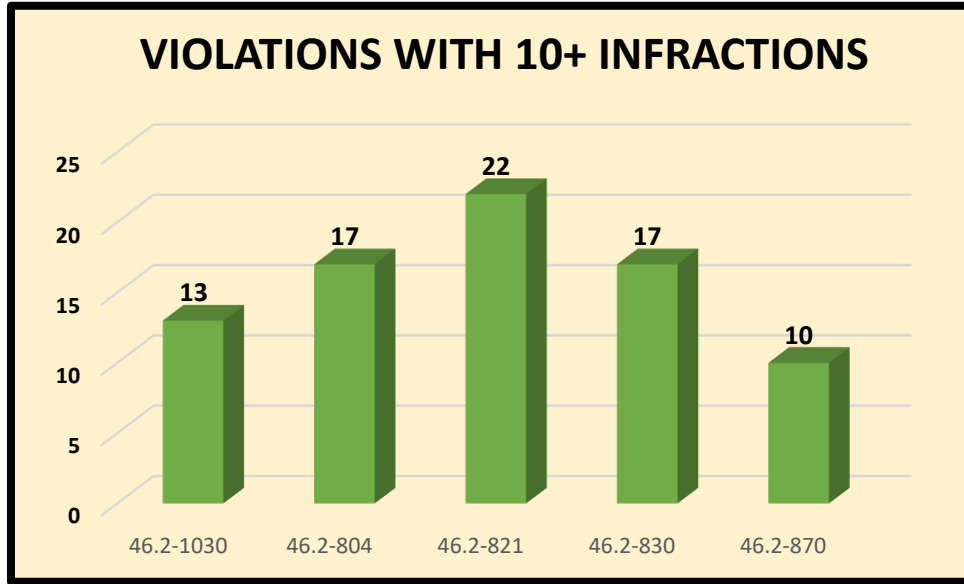

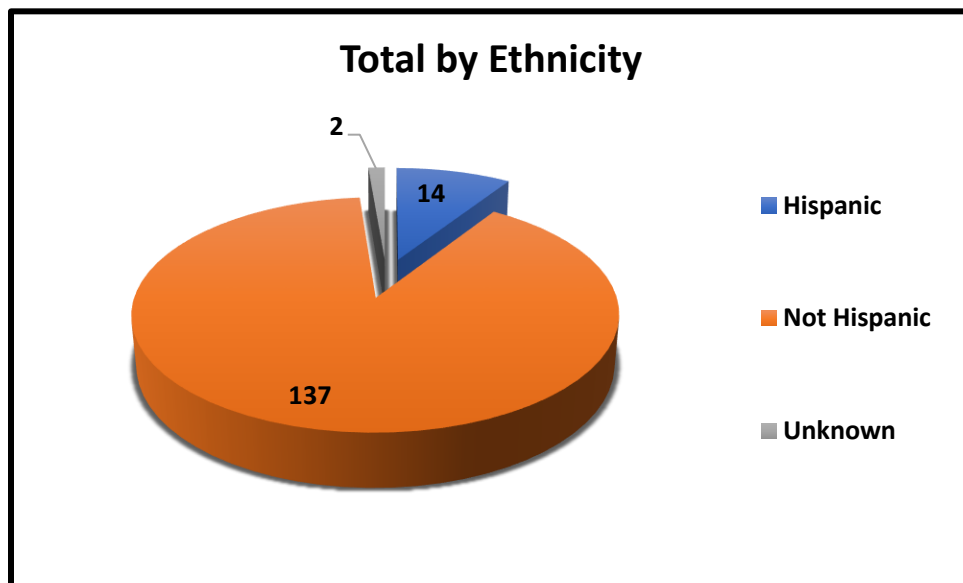

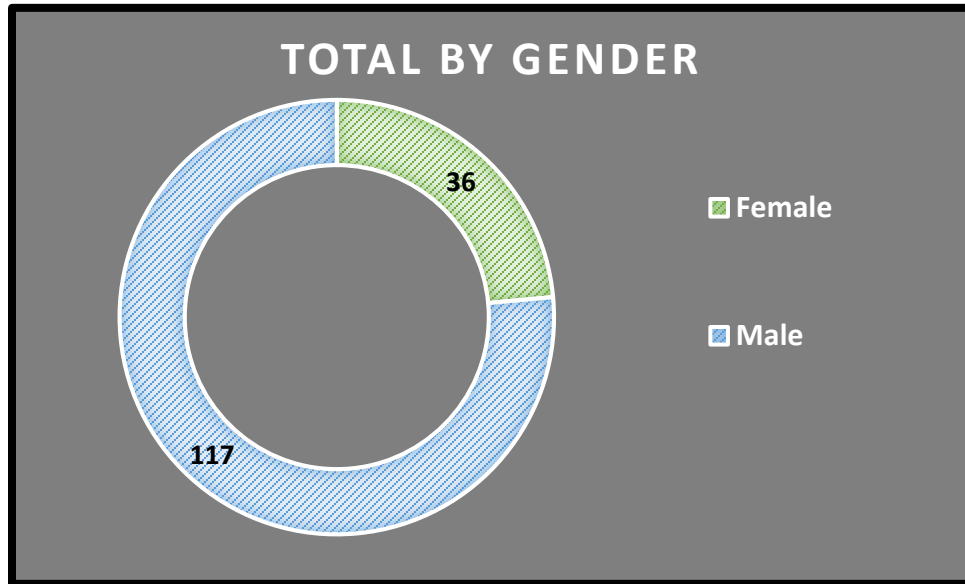

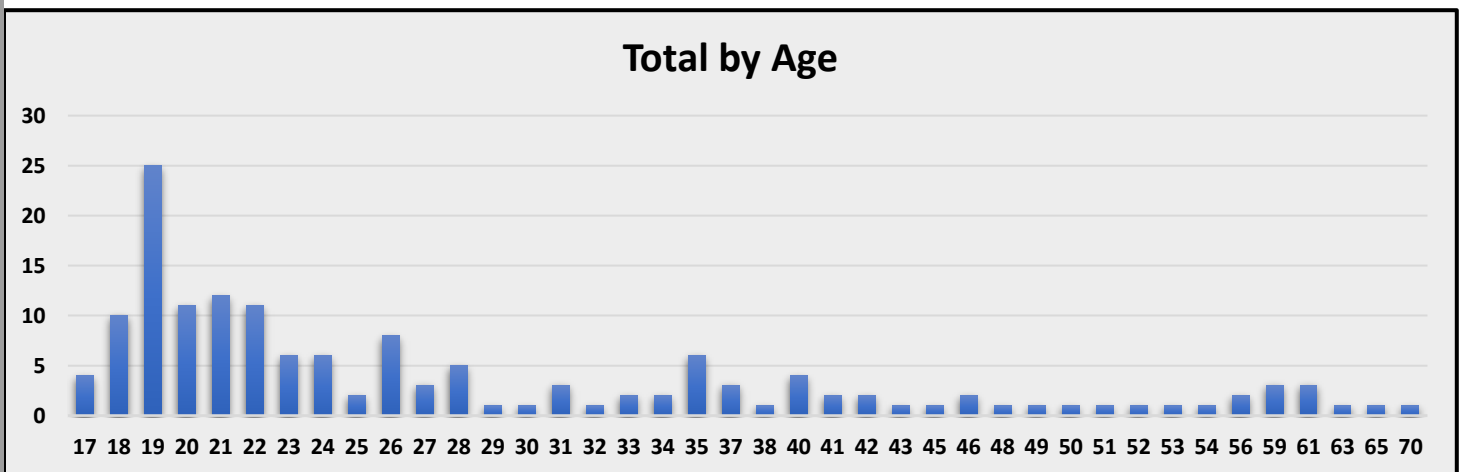

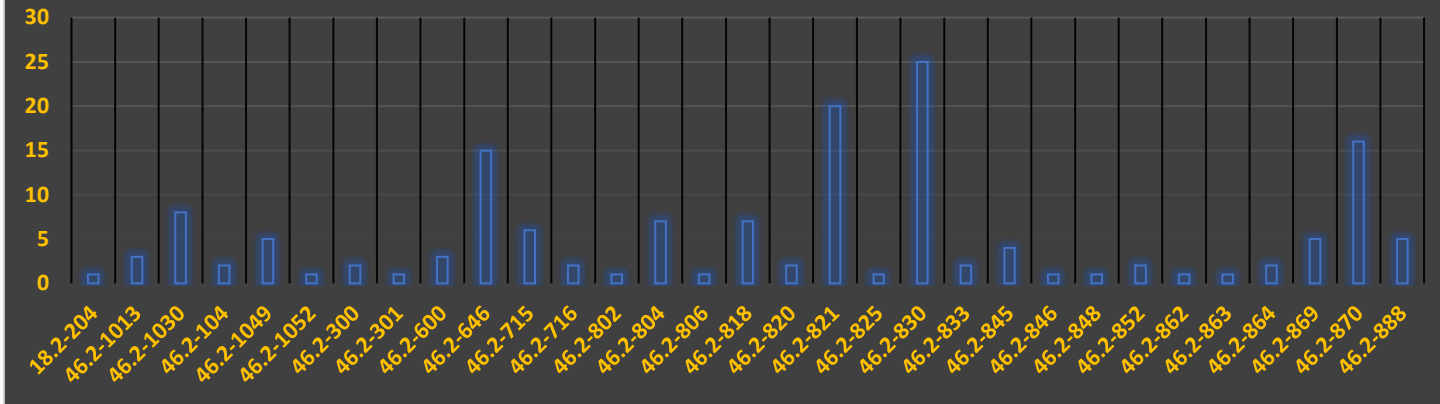

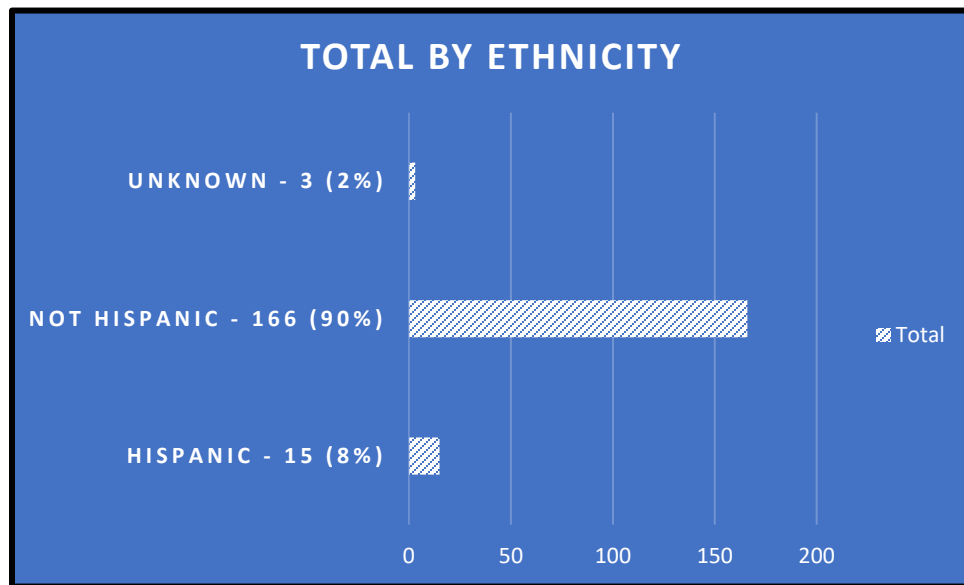

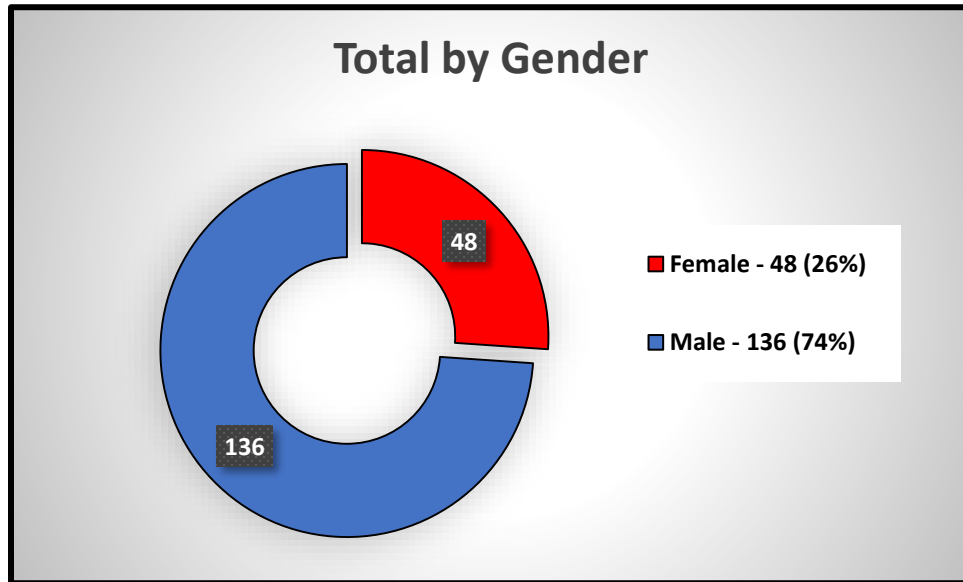

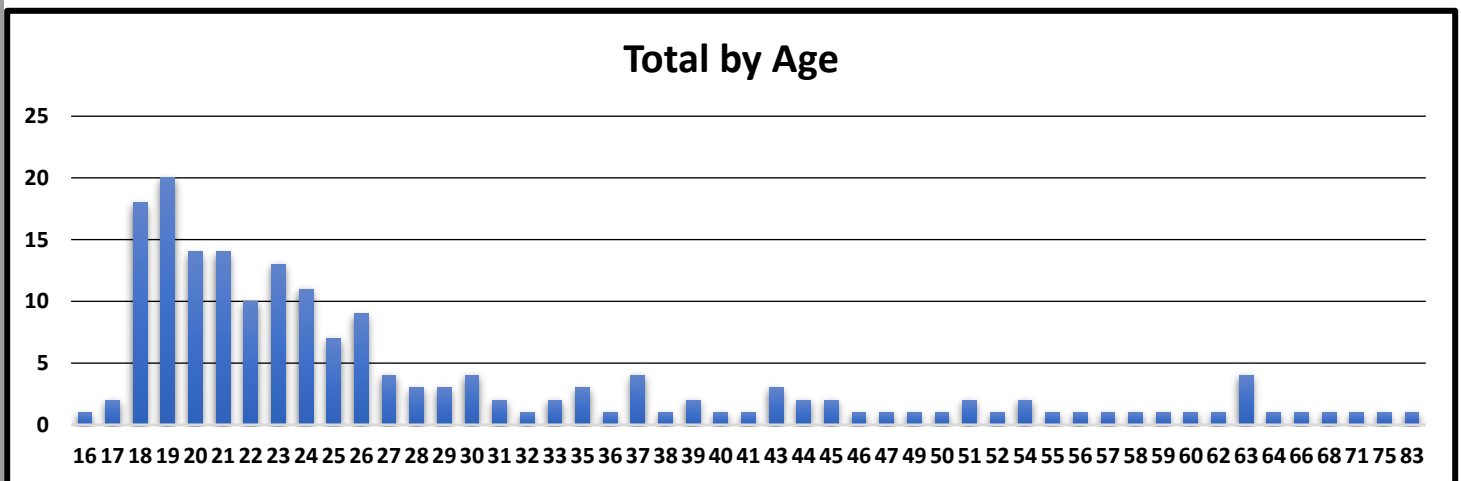
Of the 184 traffic stops, the following chart depicts the ethnicity of drivers upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.



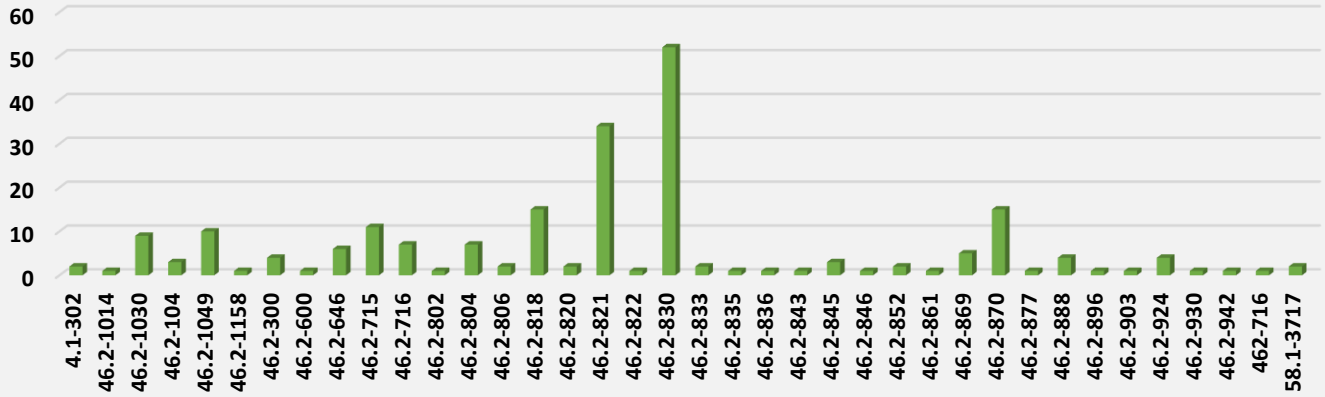

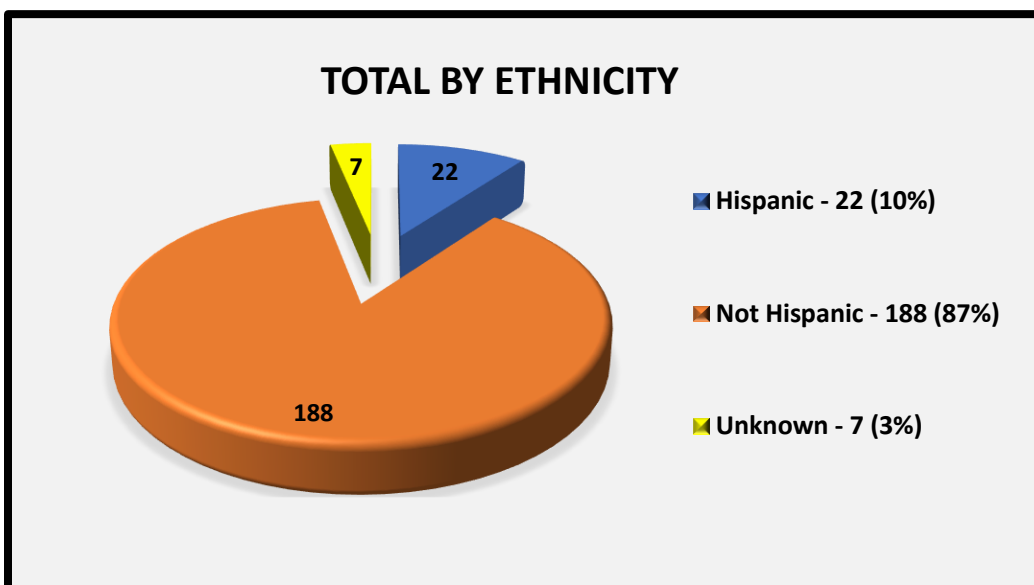

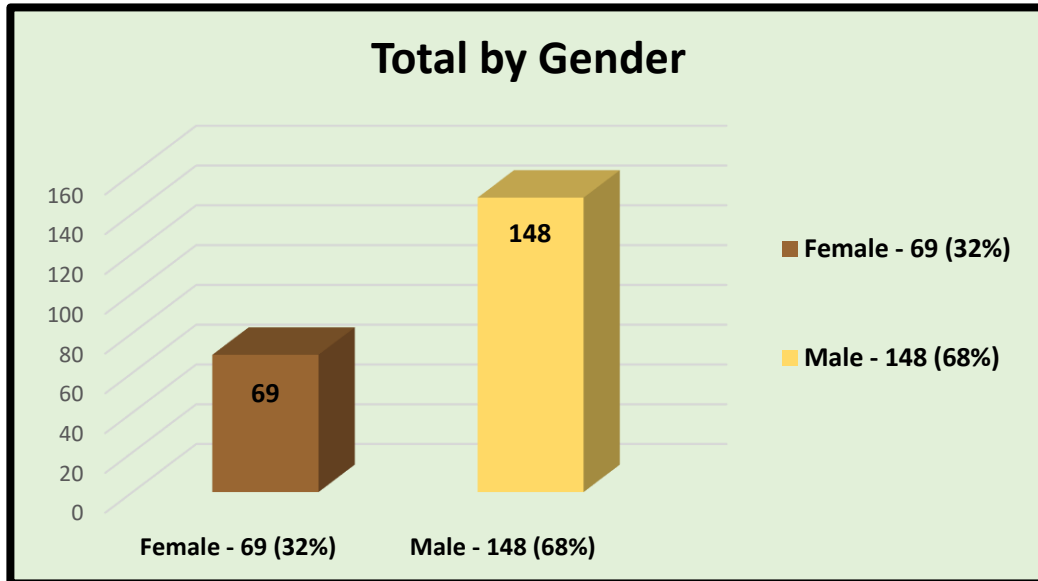

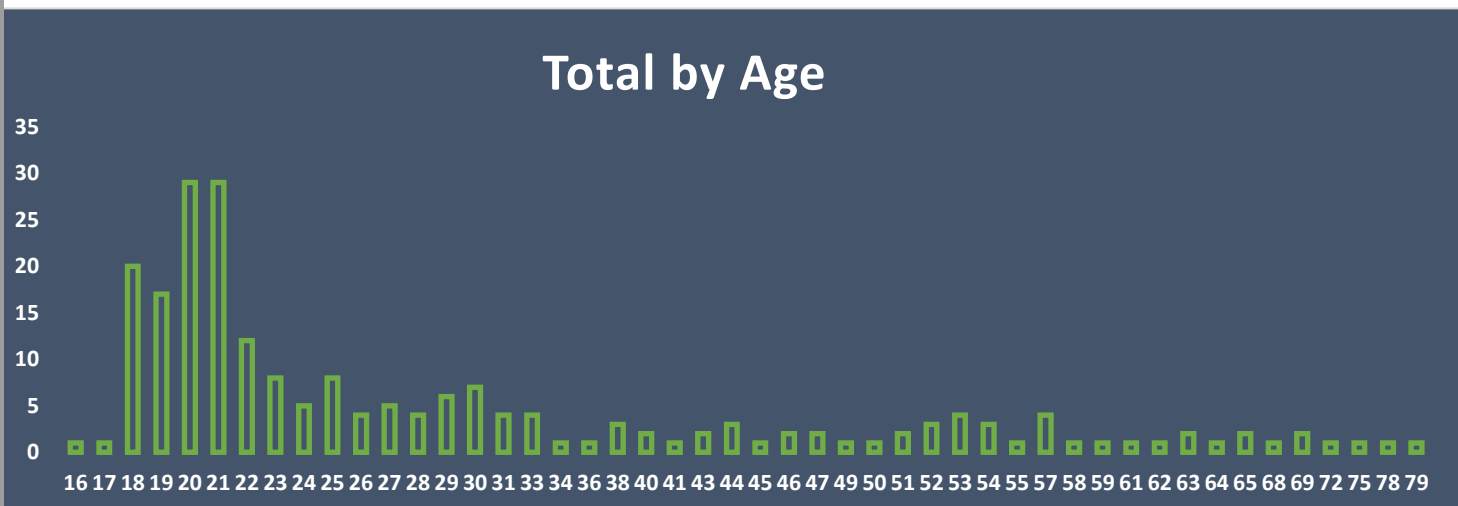

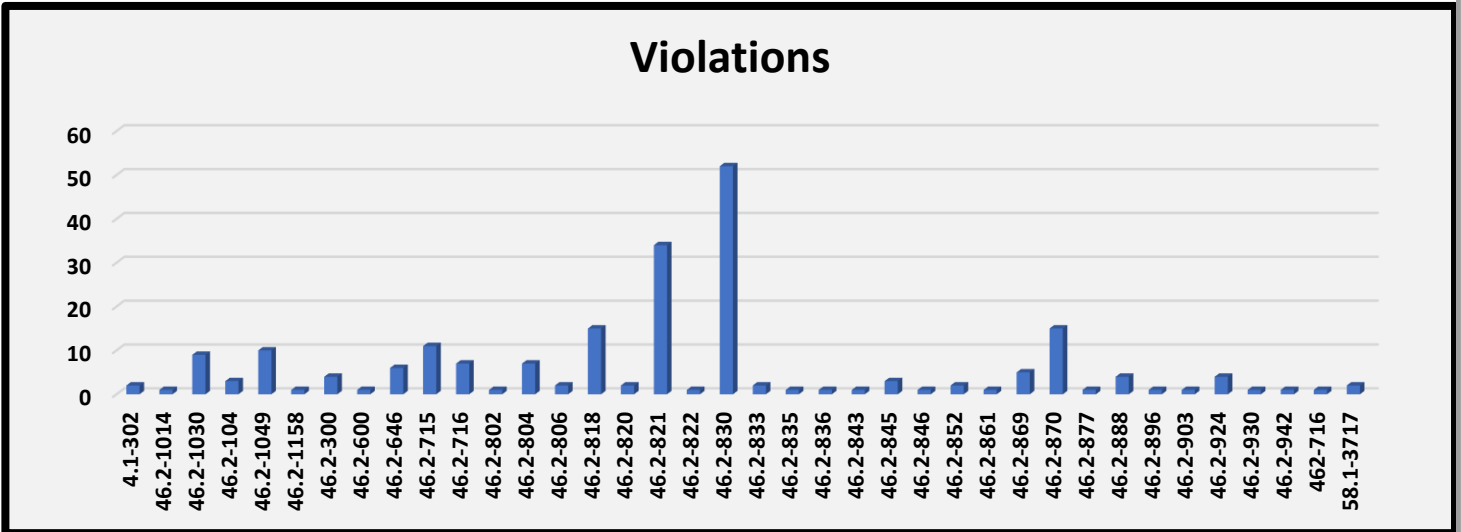
