

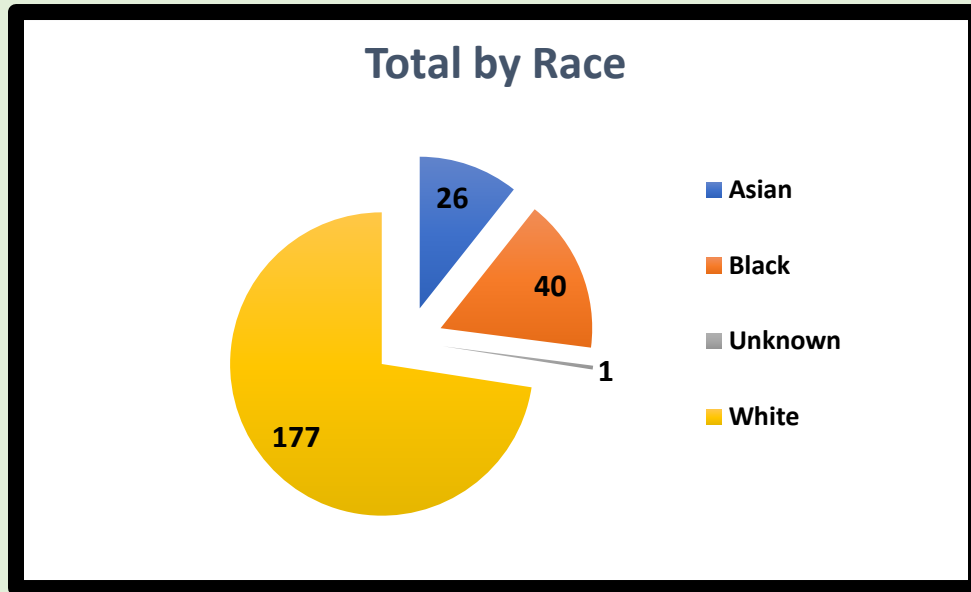

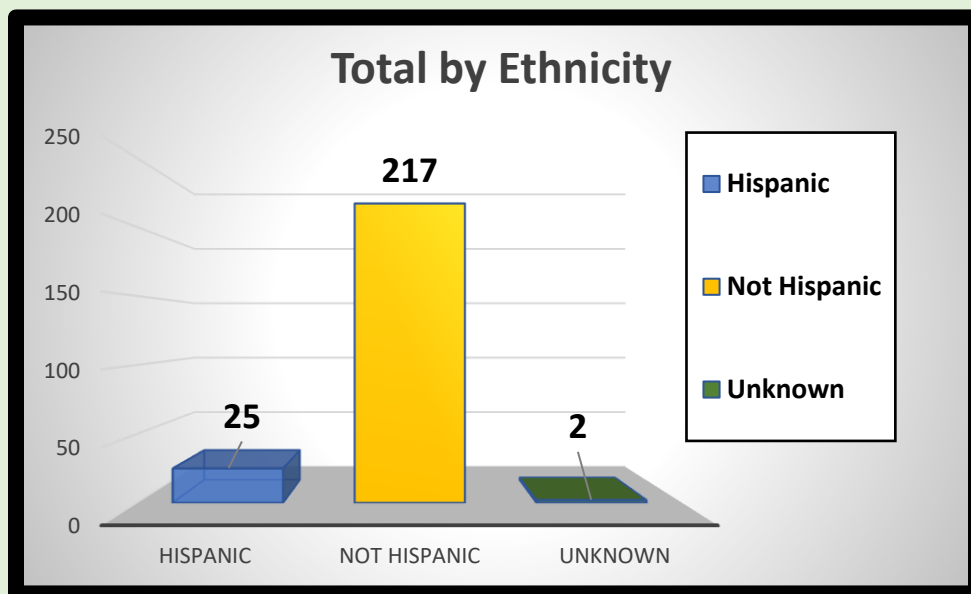
As per the mandate initiated on July 1, 2020 by Governor Northam, as well as the Virginia General Assembly, the information encapsulated in this report pertains to traffic stops initiated by sworn officers of the George Mason University Police Department. Data shows information regarding traffic stops from Jul. 1, 2025 – Jul. 31, 2025. The next data collection will cover the timeframe of Aug. 1, 2025 – Aug. 31, 2025.

There were a total of 244 traffic stops from Jul. 1, 2025 – Jul. 31, 2025.

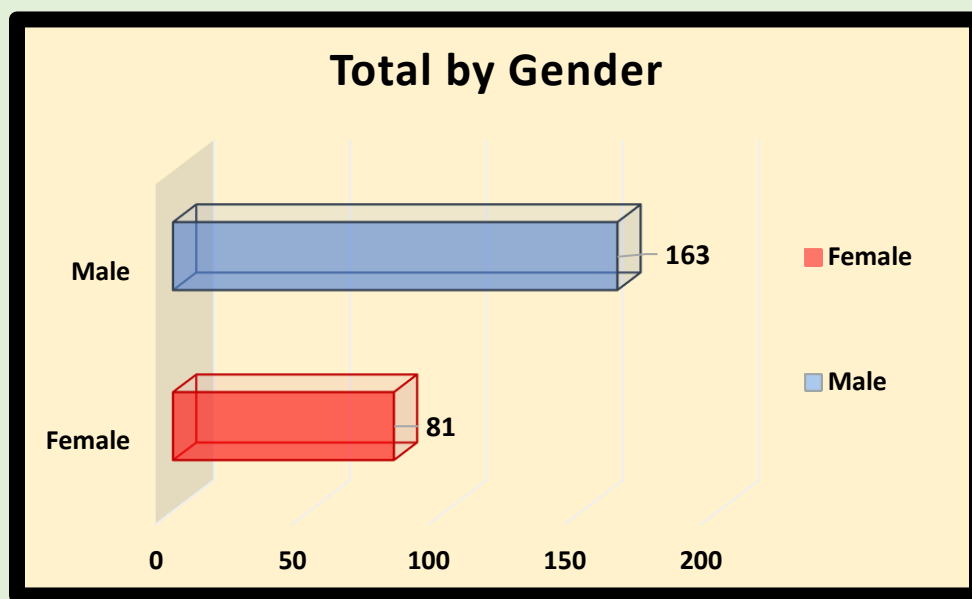
Of the 244 traffic stops, the following chart depicts the race of drivers upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.



Of the 244 traffic stops, the following chart depicts the ethnicity of drivers upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.

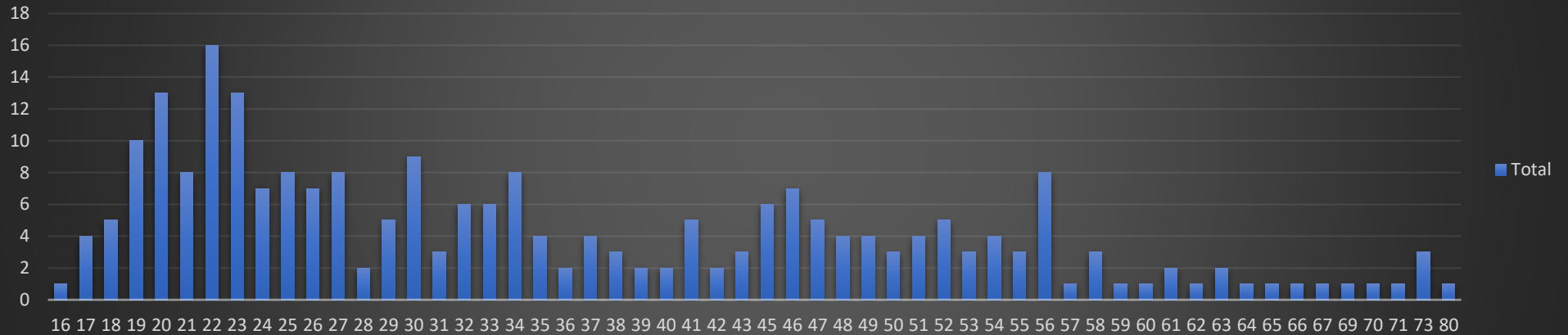


Of the 244 traffic stops, the following chart depicts the gender of drivers upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.

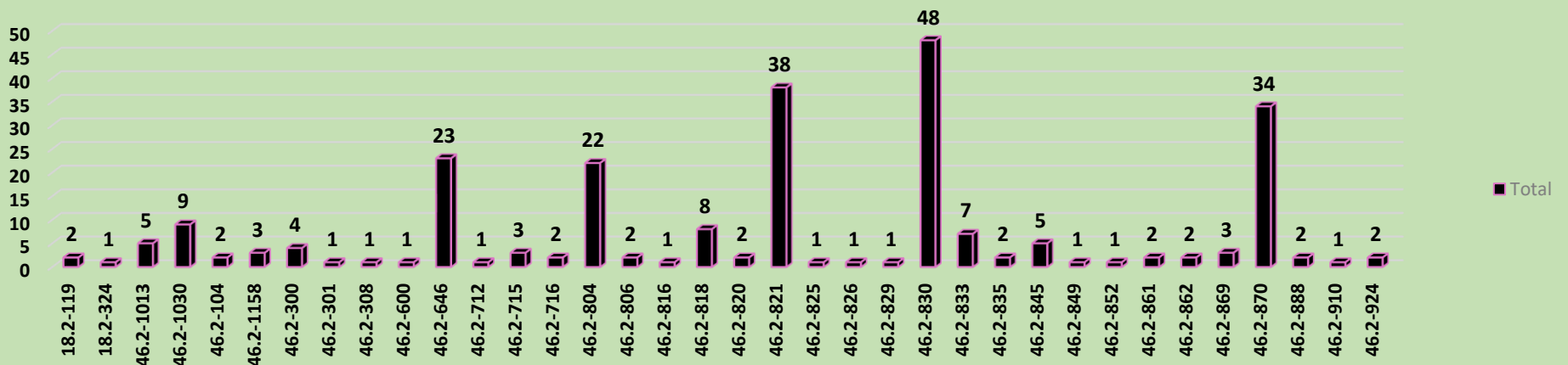


Of the 244 traffic stops, the following graphs depict the age of drivers and violations issued upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.
