

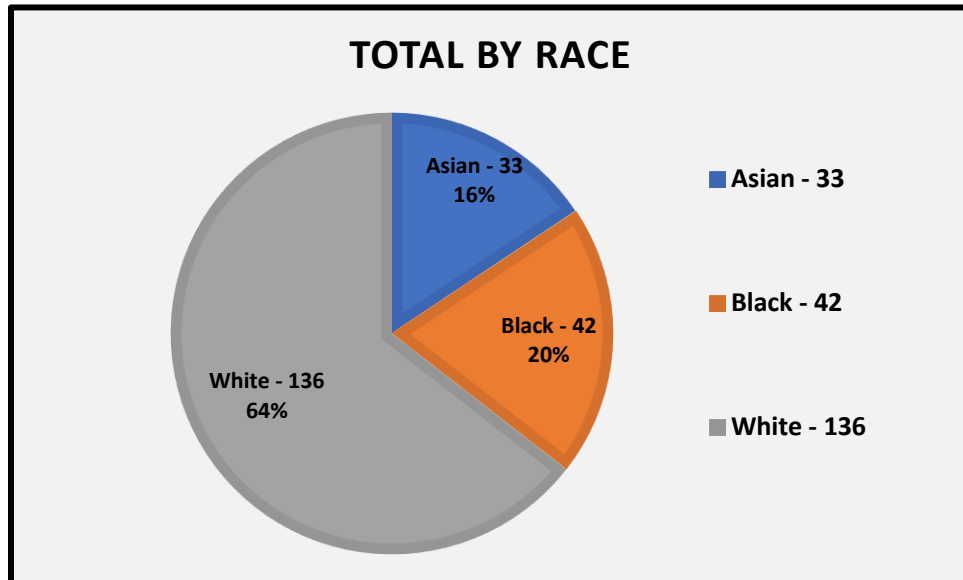

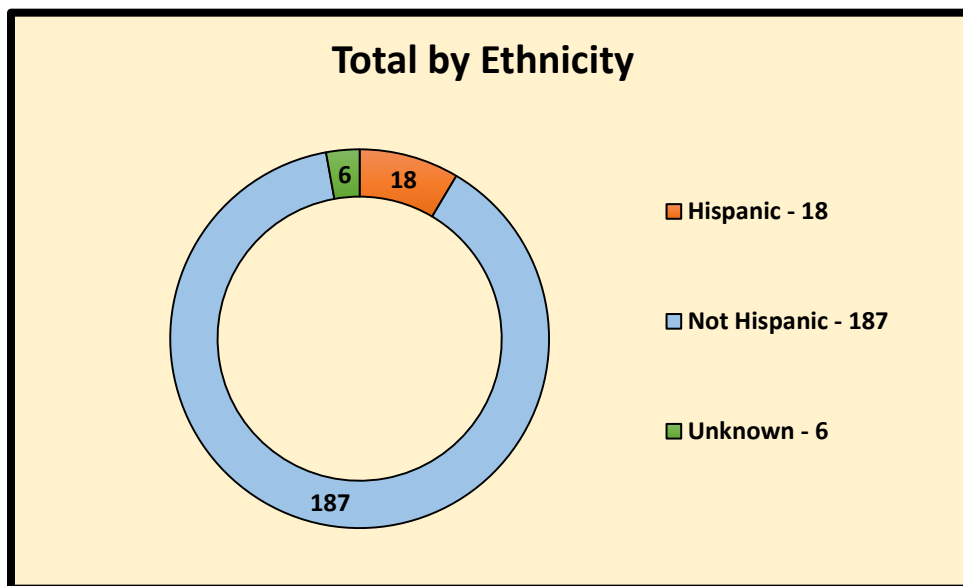

There were a total of 211 traffic stops from Apr. 1, 2025 – Apr. 30, 2025

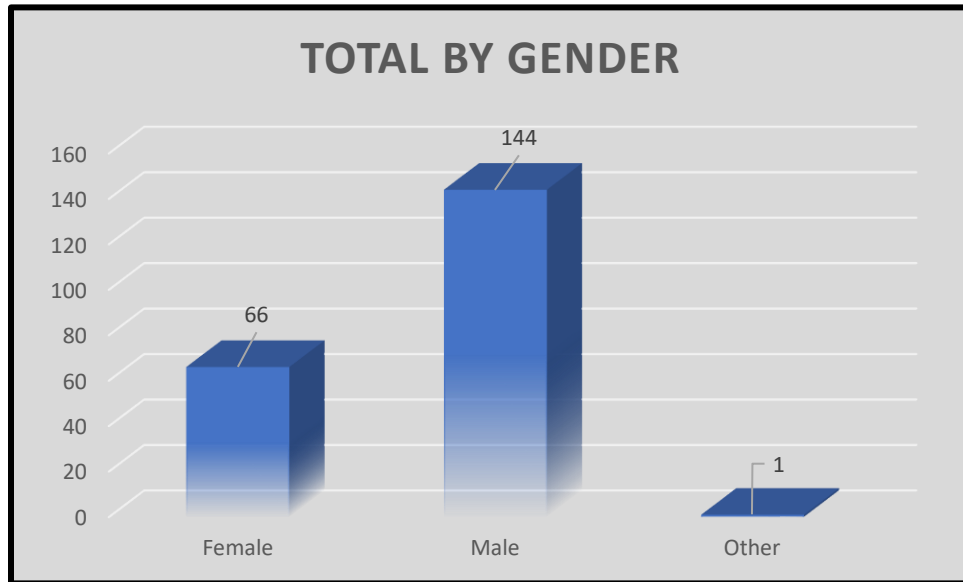

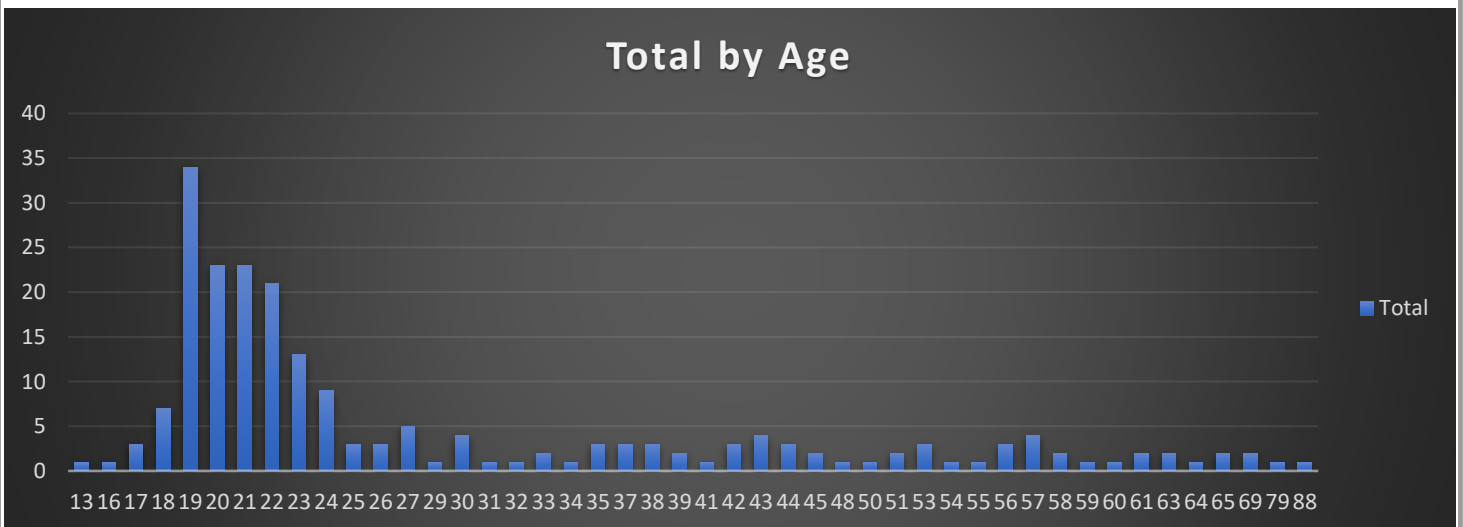

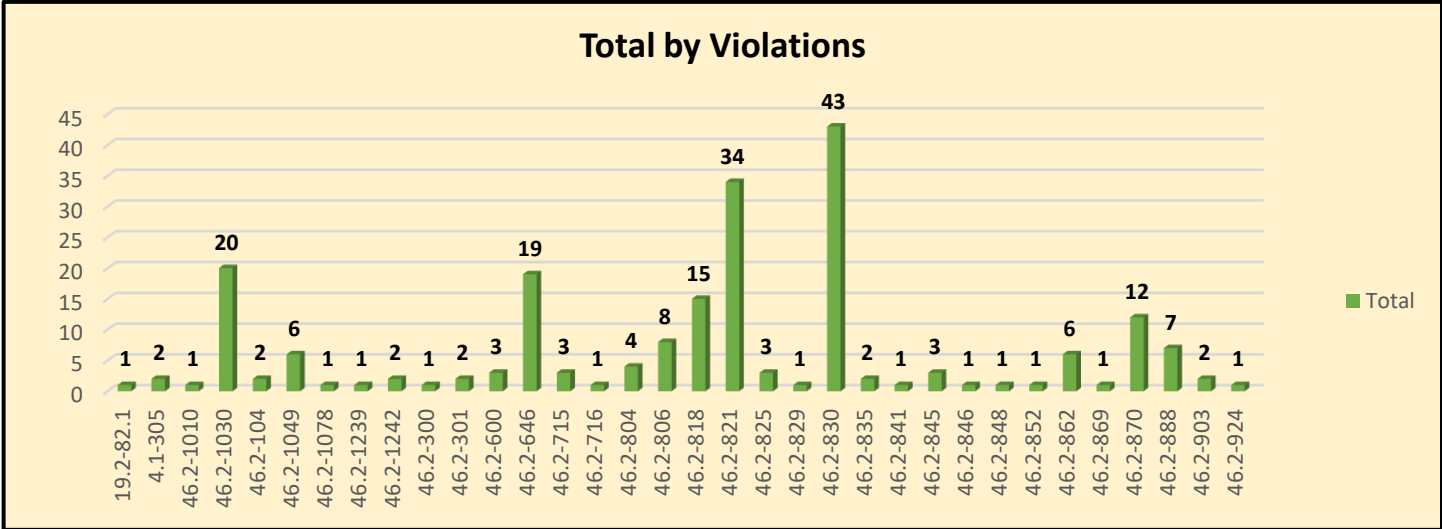


Of the 211 traffic stops, the following chart depicts the gender of drivers upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.

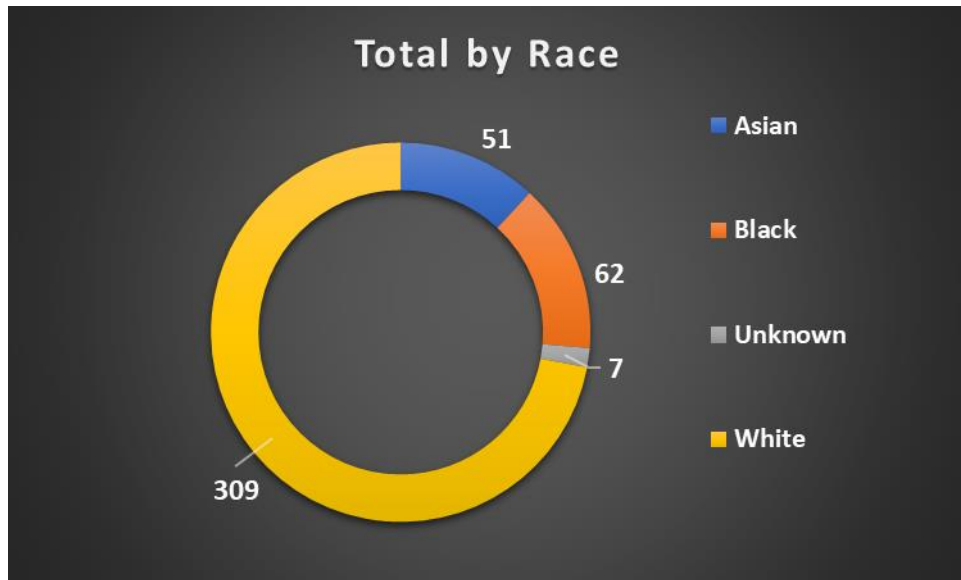

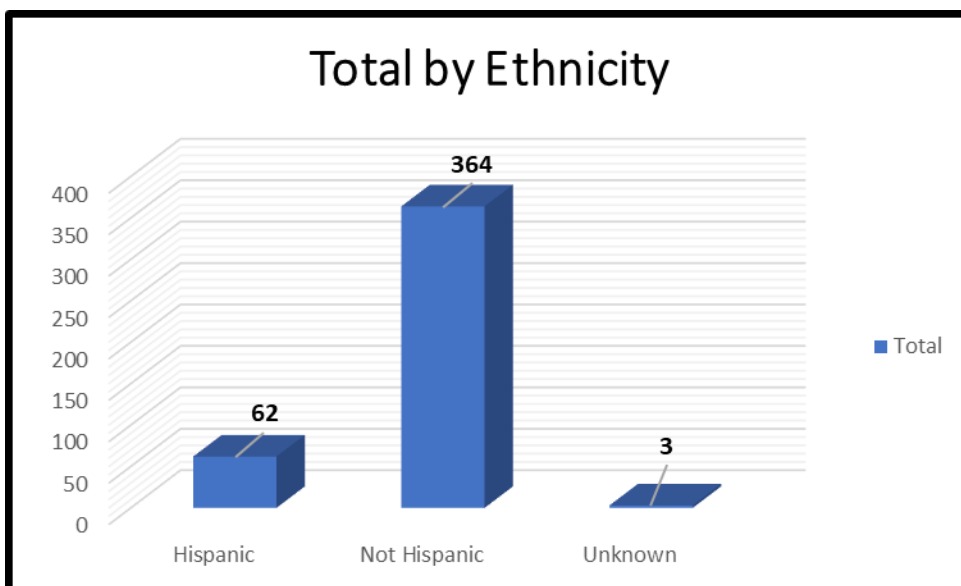

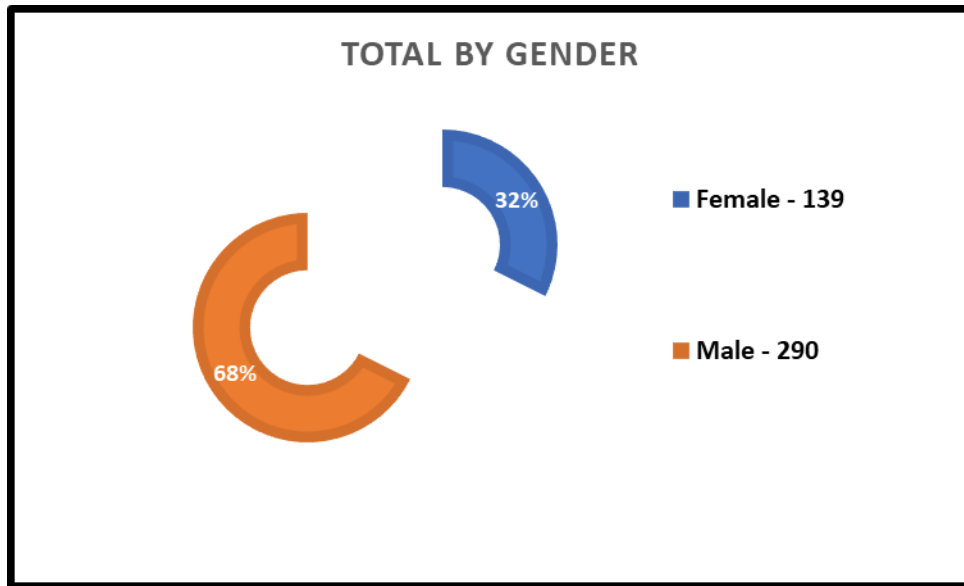

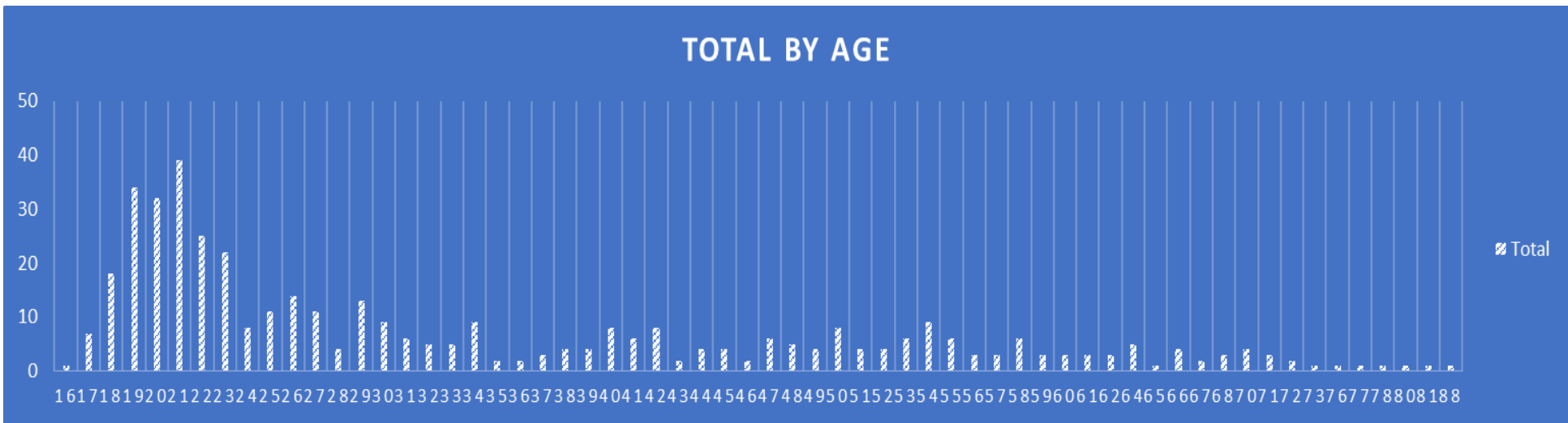
Of the 429 traffic stops, the following chart depicts the ethnicity of drivers upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.



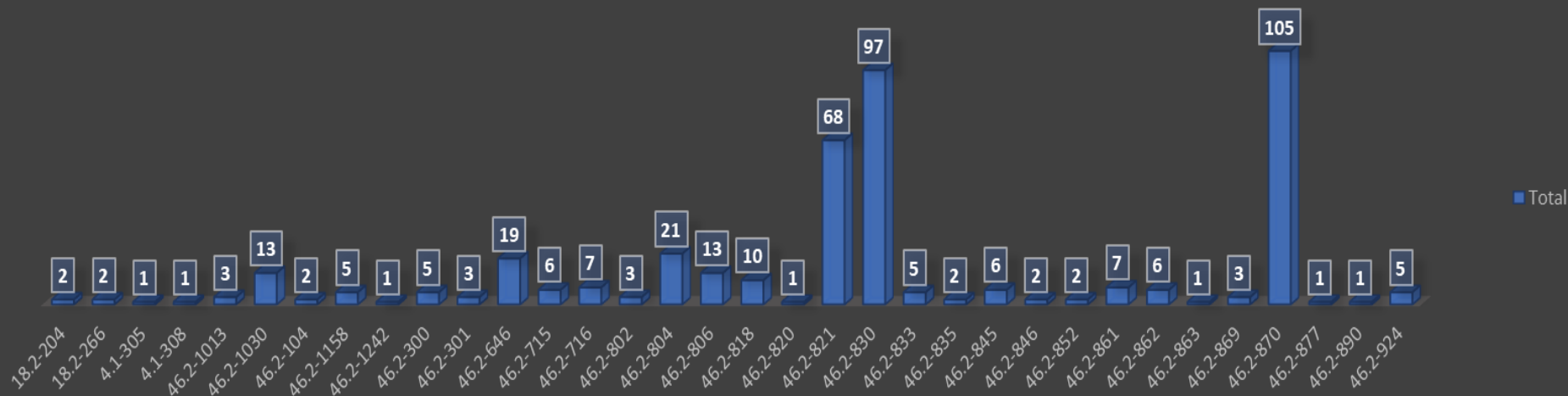
Of the 429 traffic stops, the following chart depicts the gender of drivers upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.

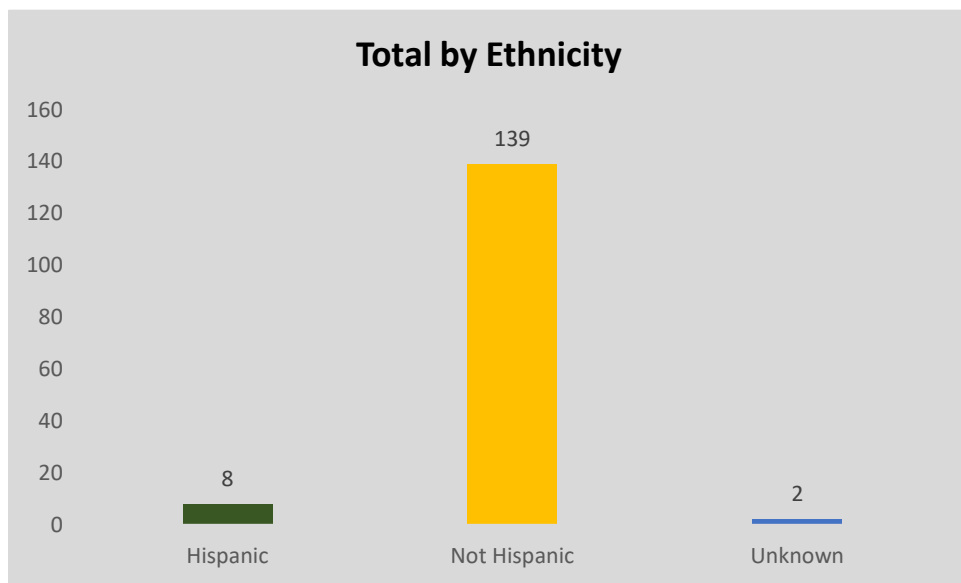

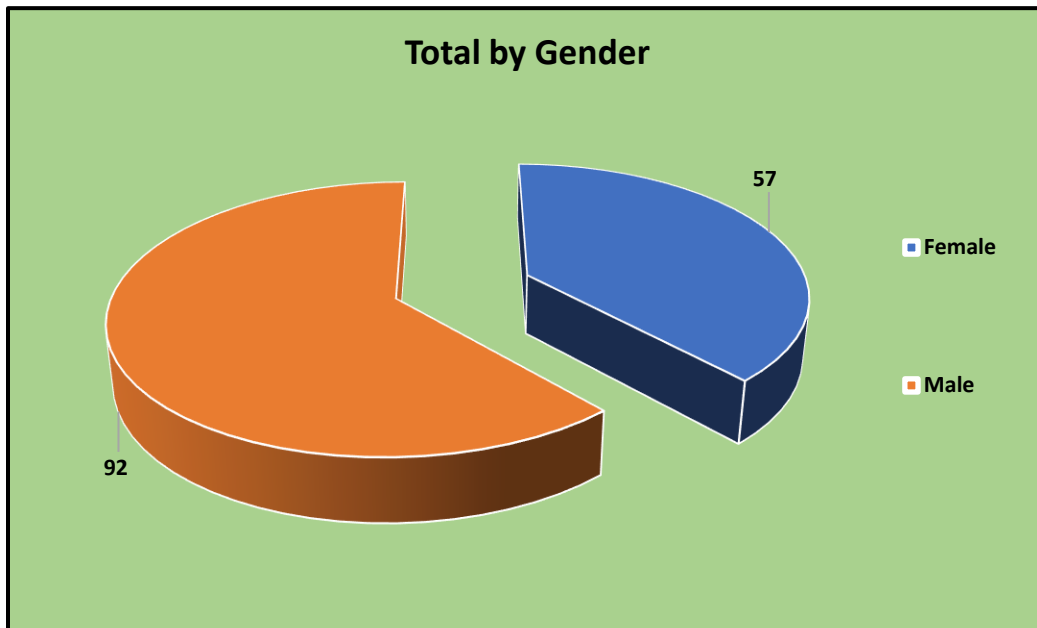

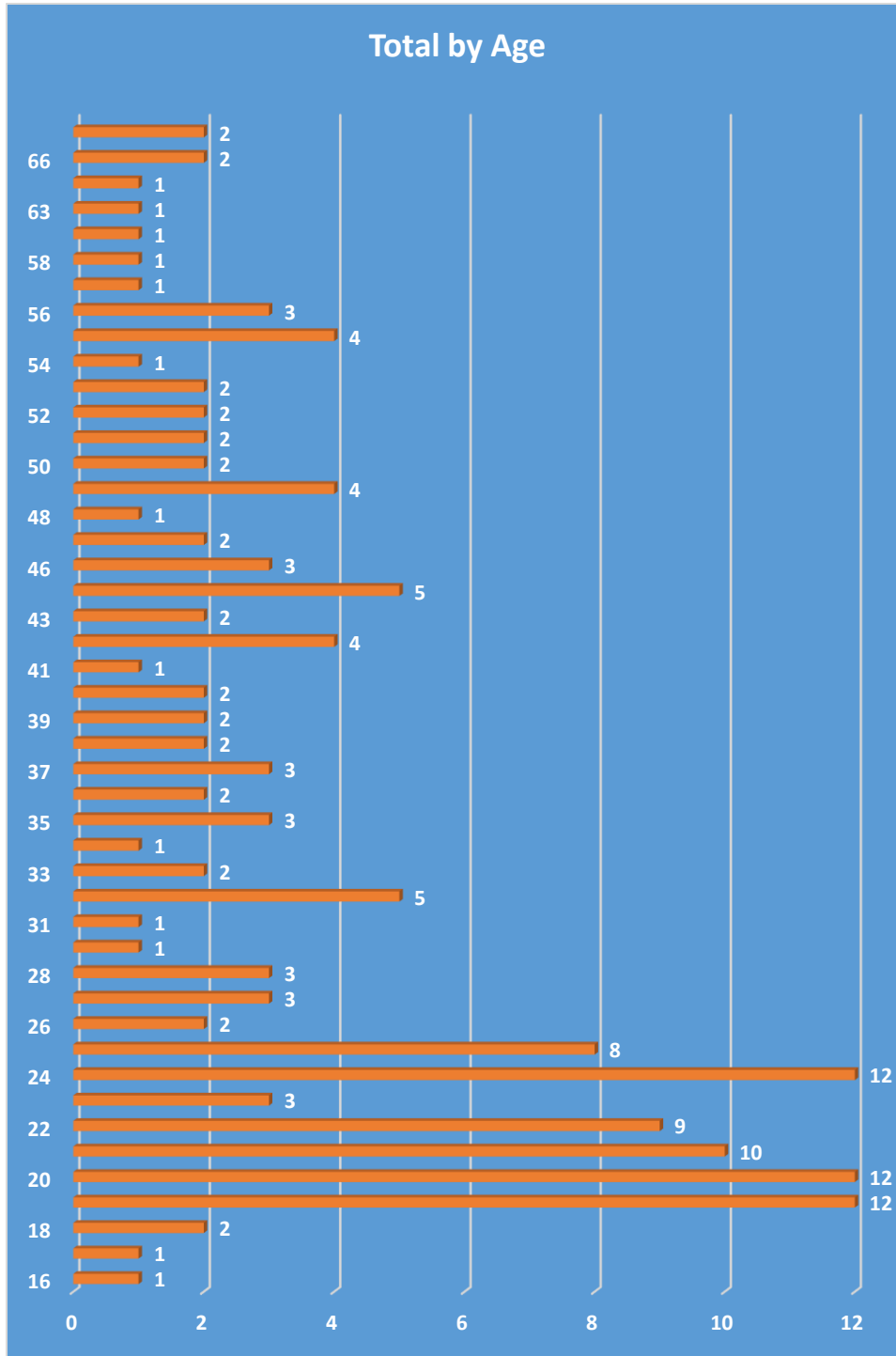

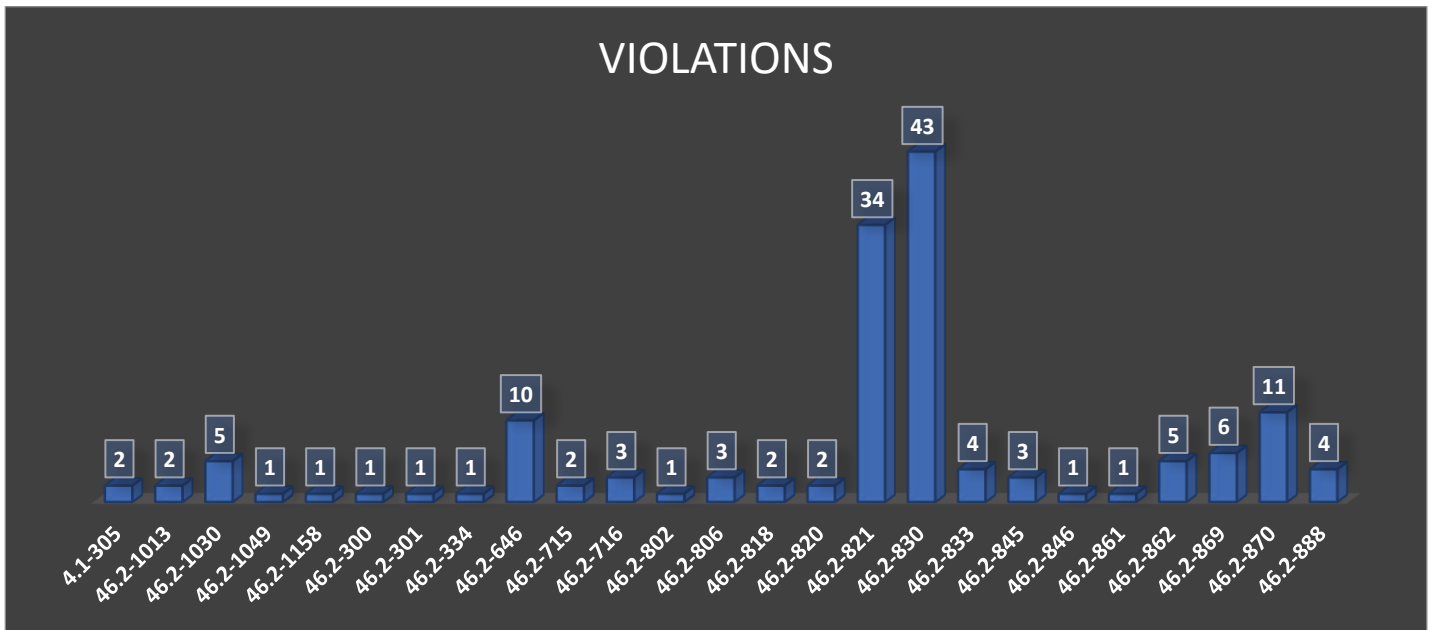

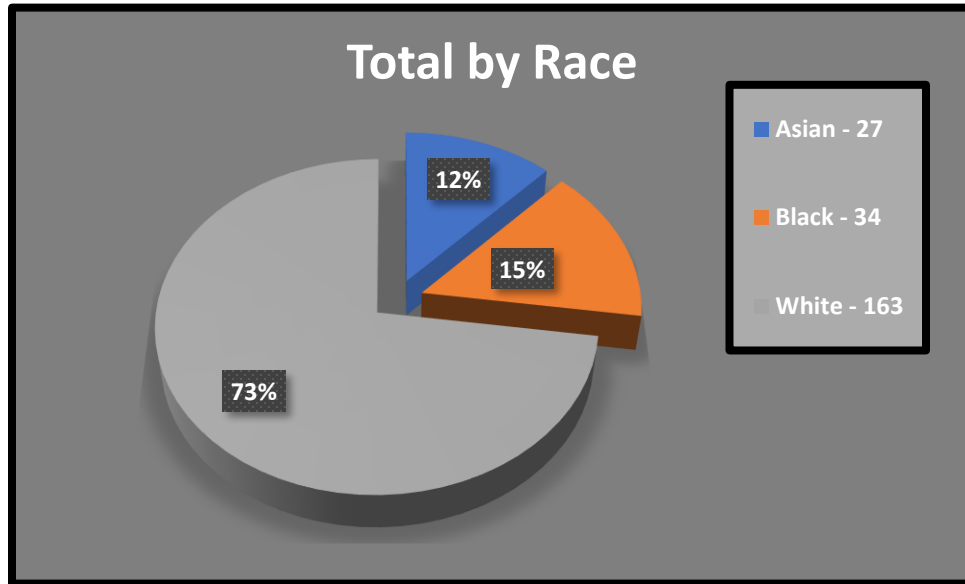

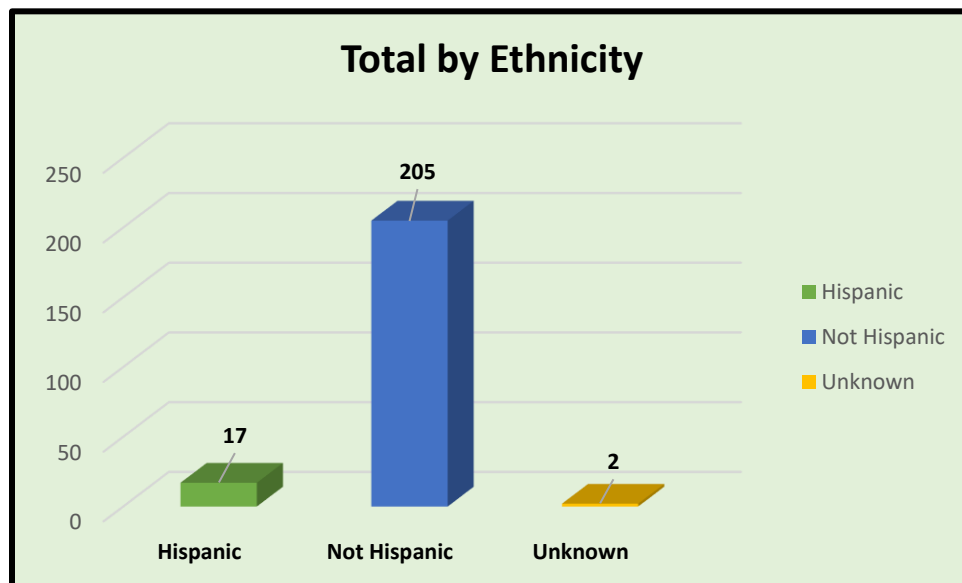

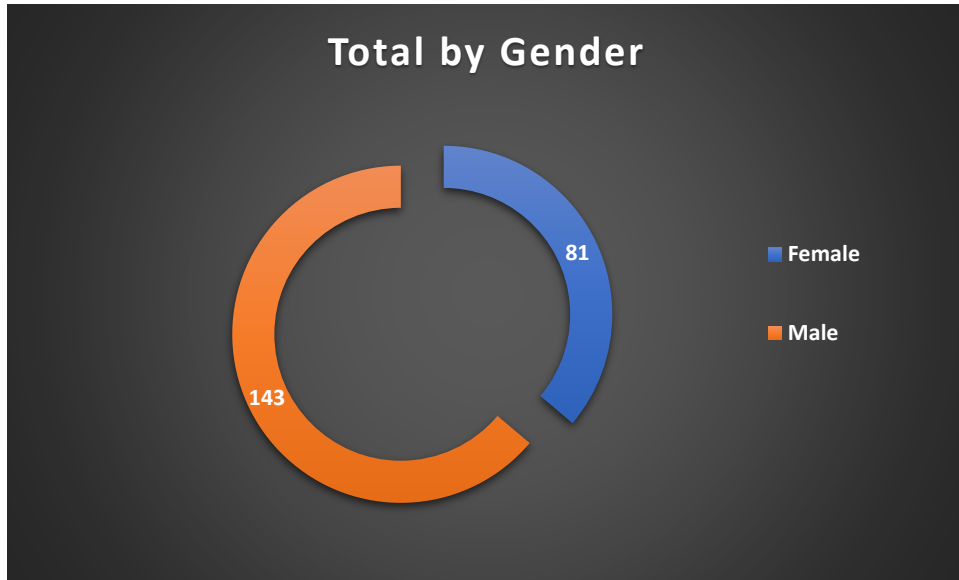

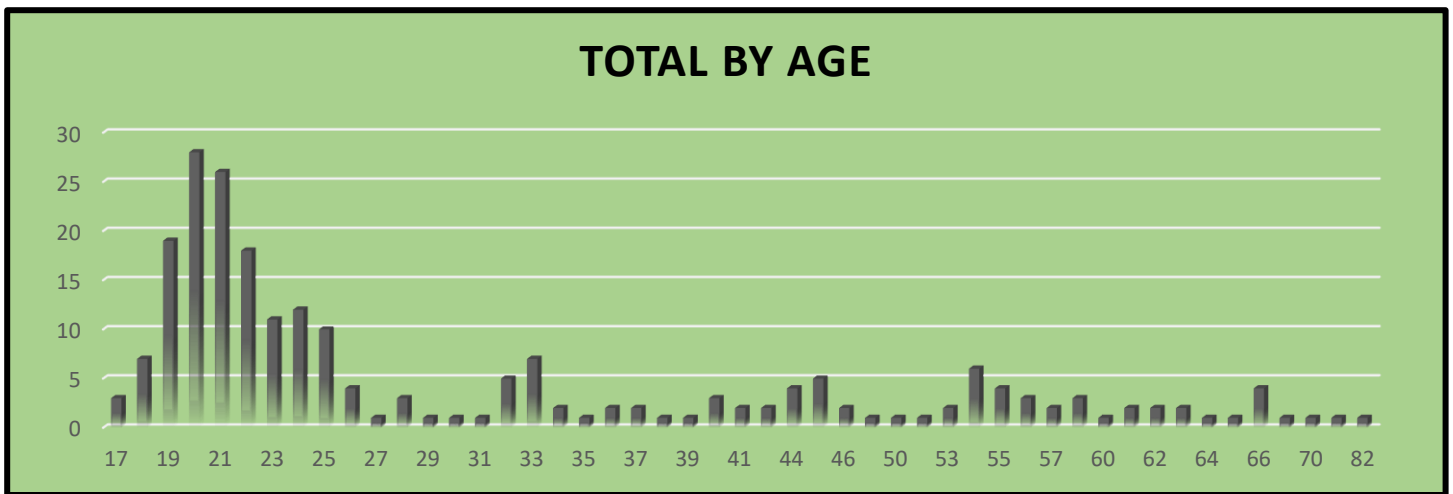

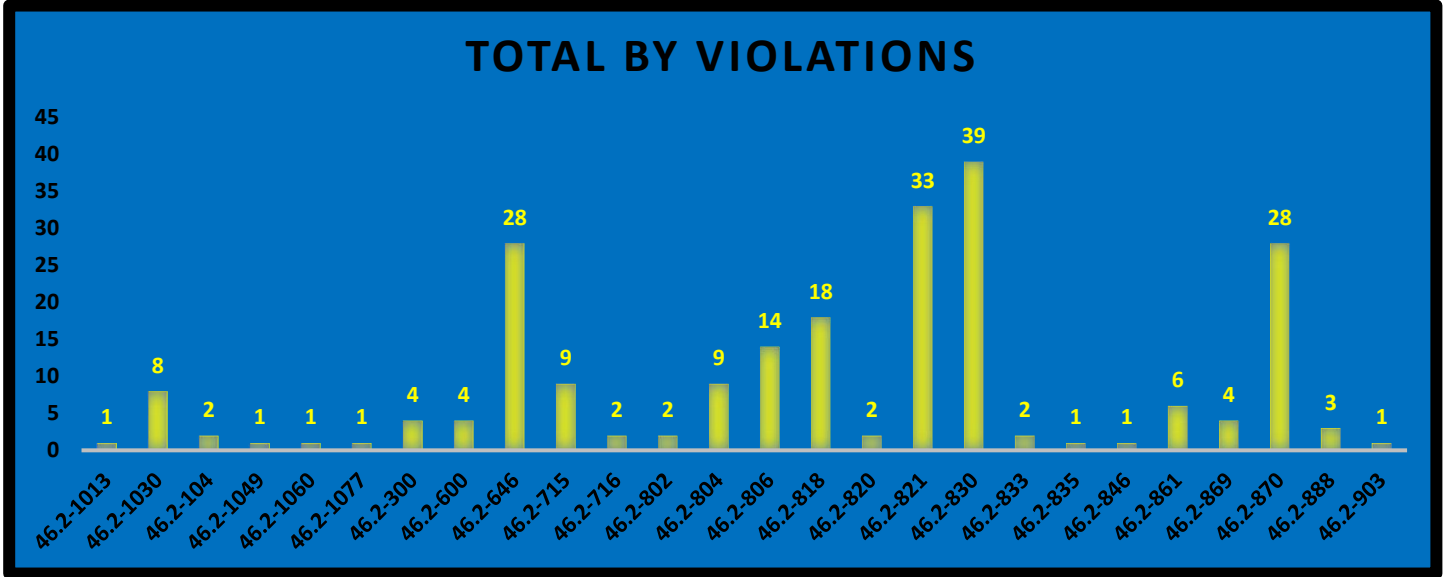


Of the 224 traffic stops, the following chart depicts the gender of drivers upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.

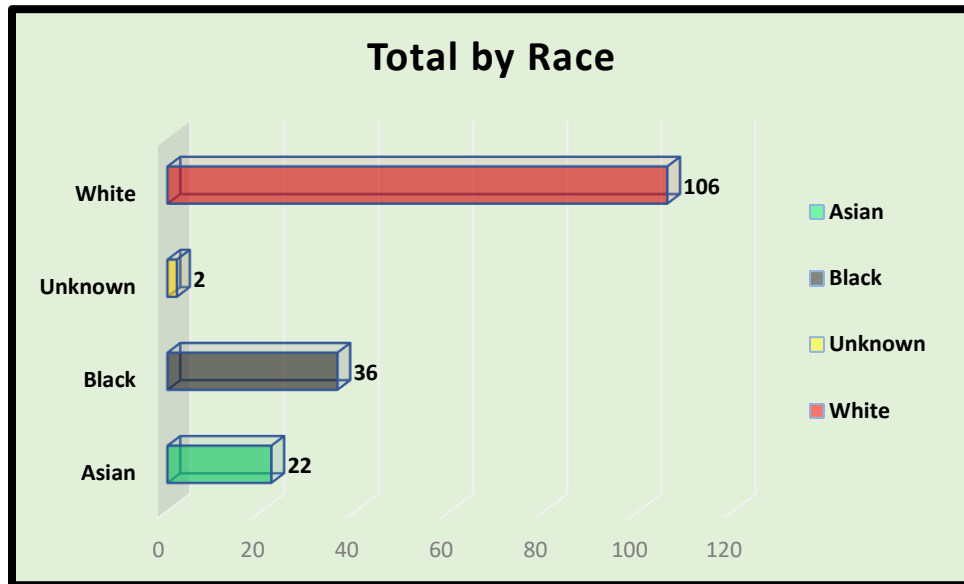

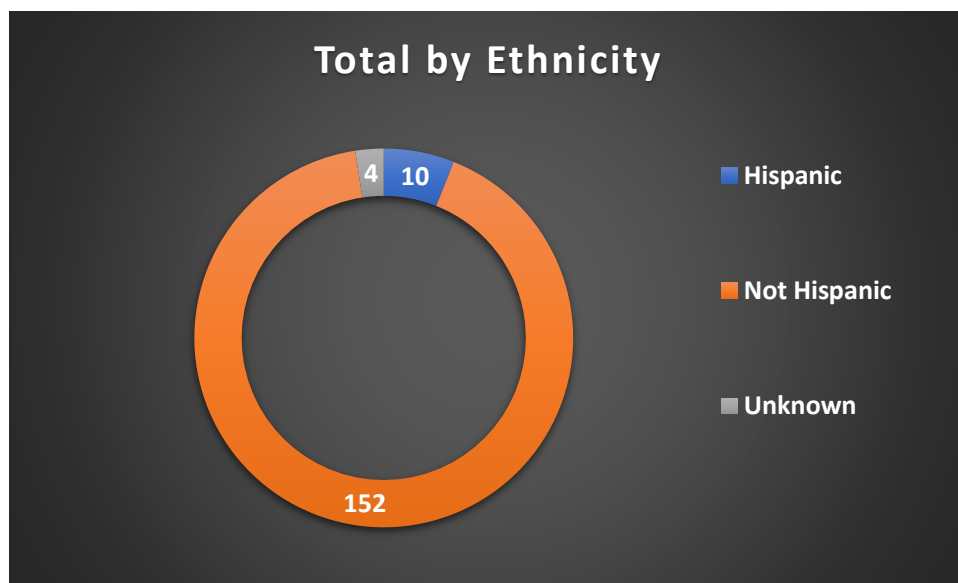

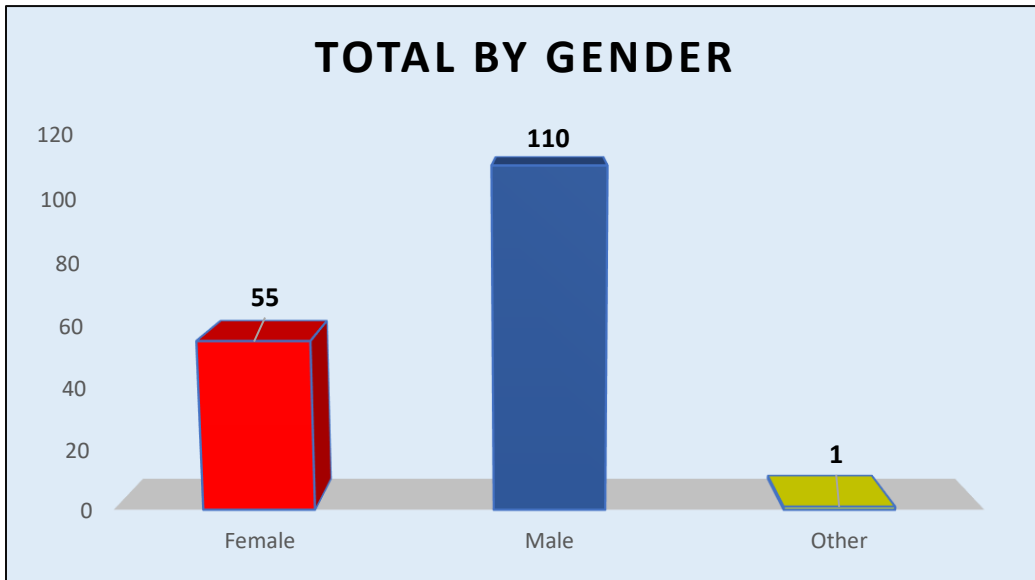

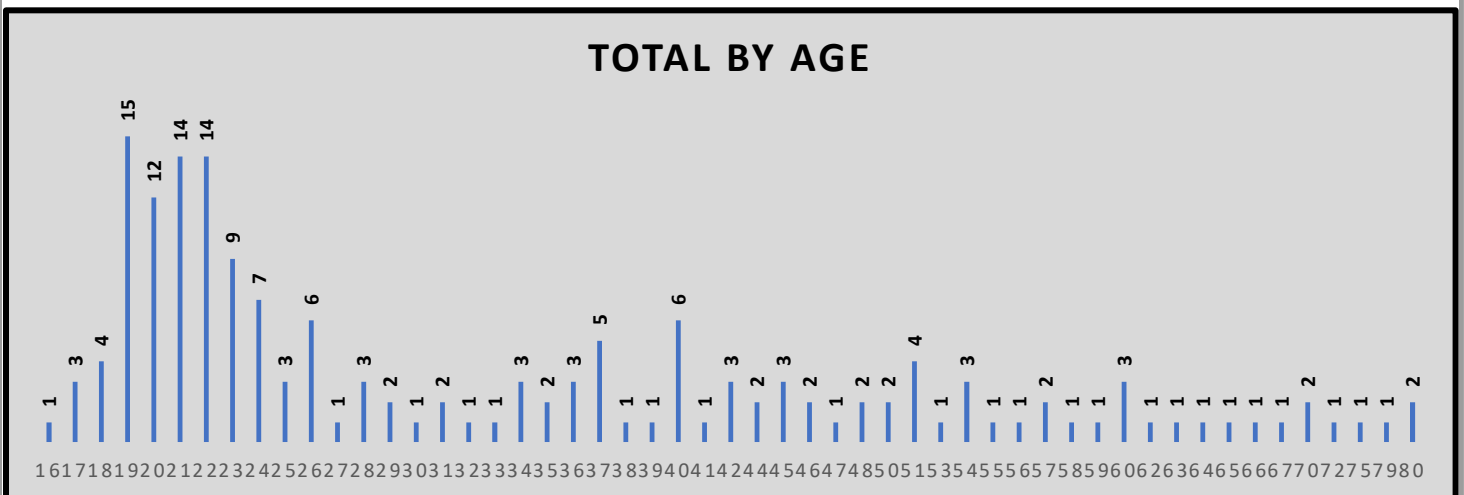

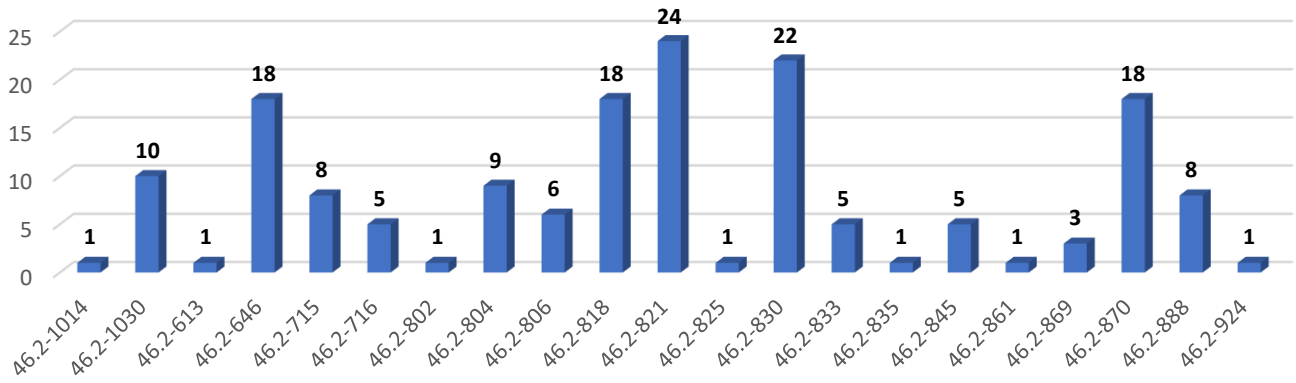

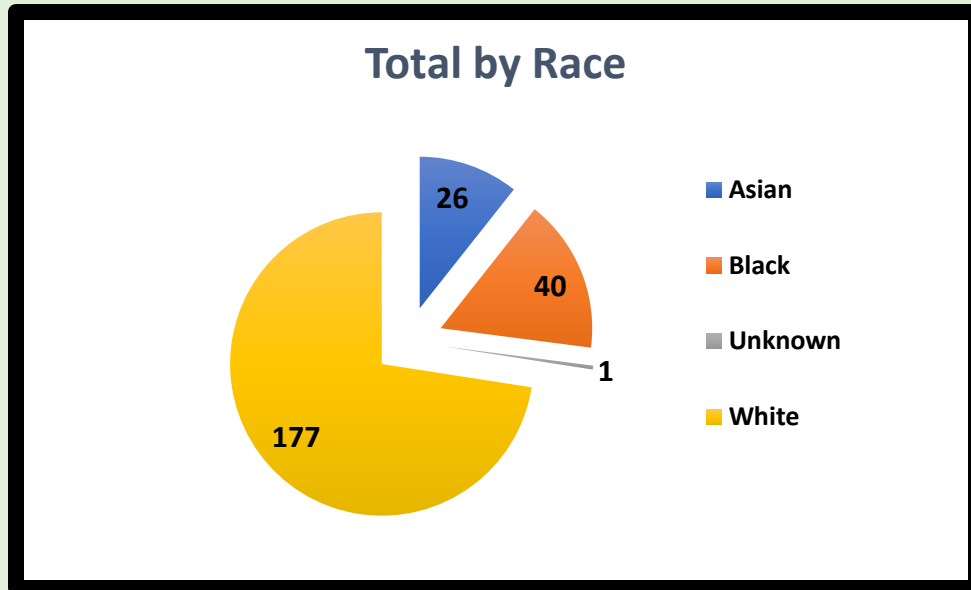

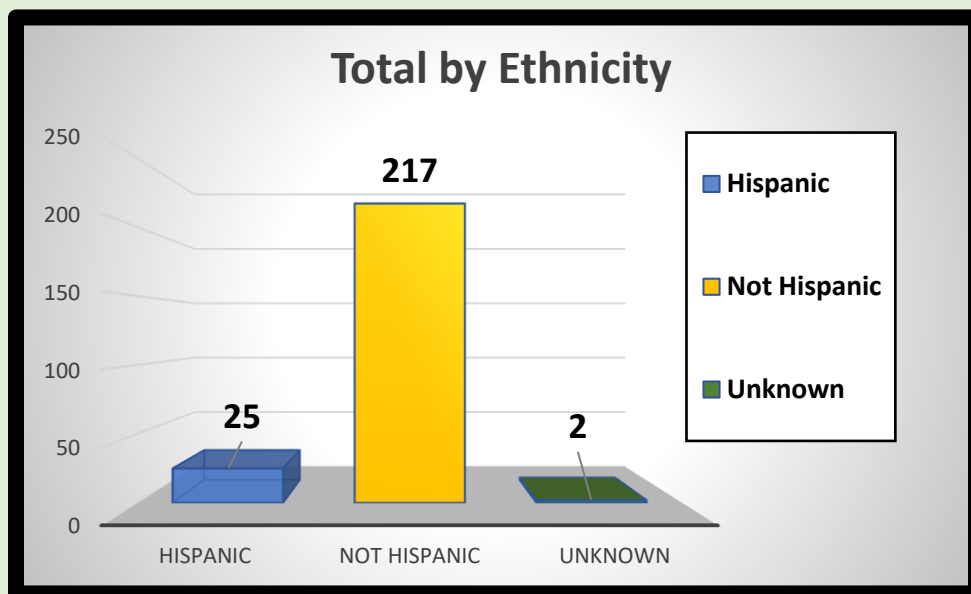

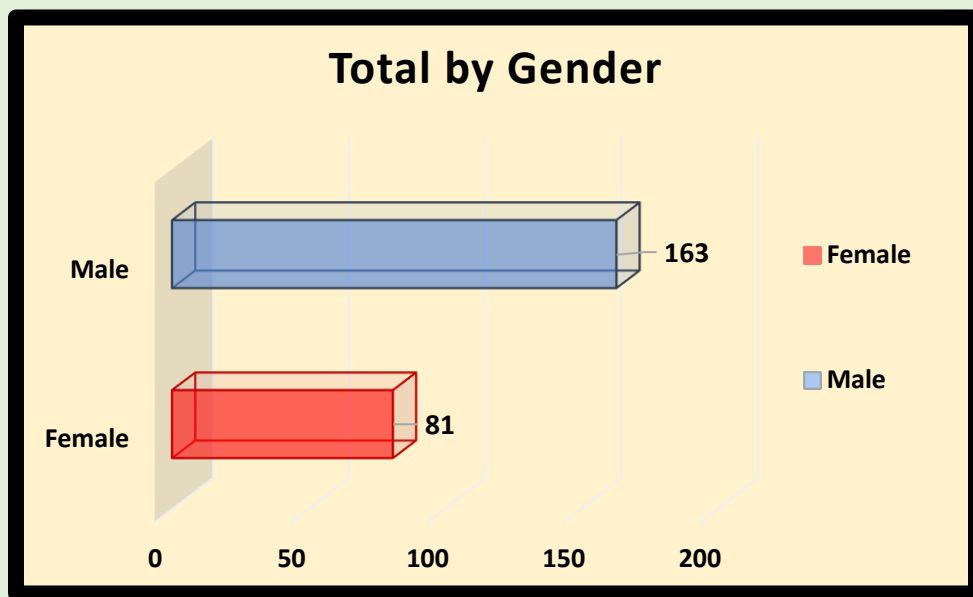

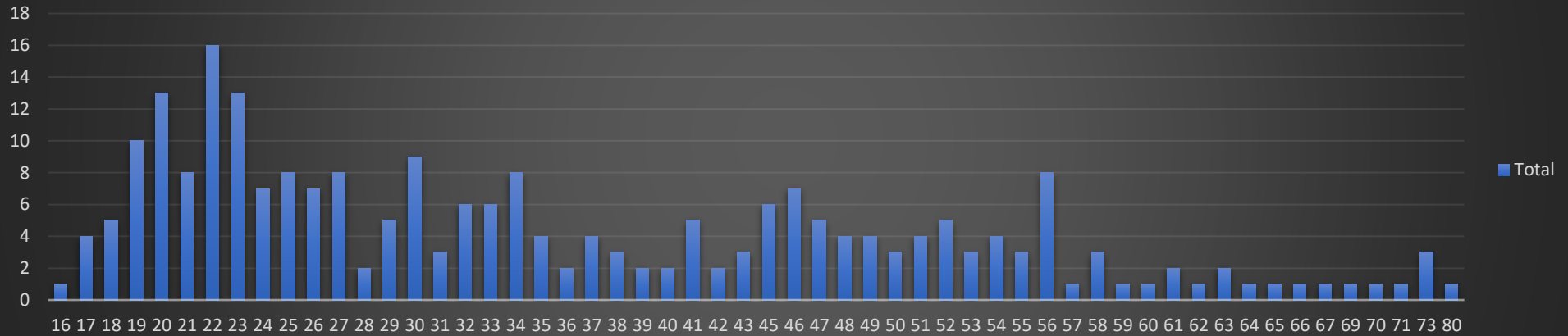

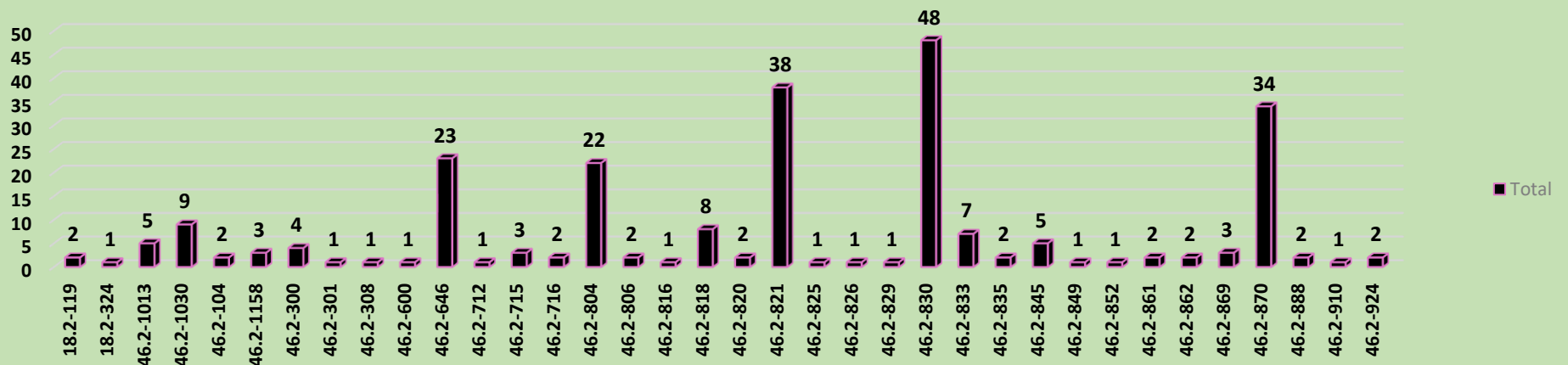


Of the 244 traffic stops, the following graphs depict the age of drivers and violations issued upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.

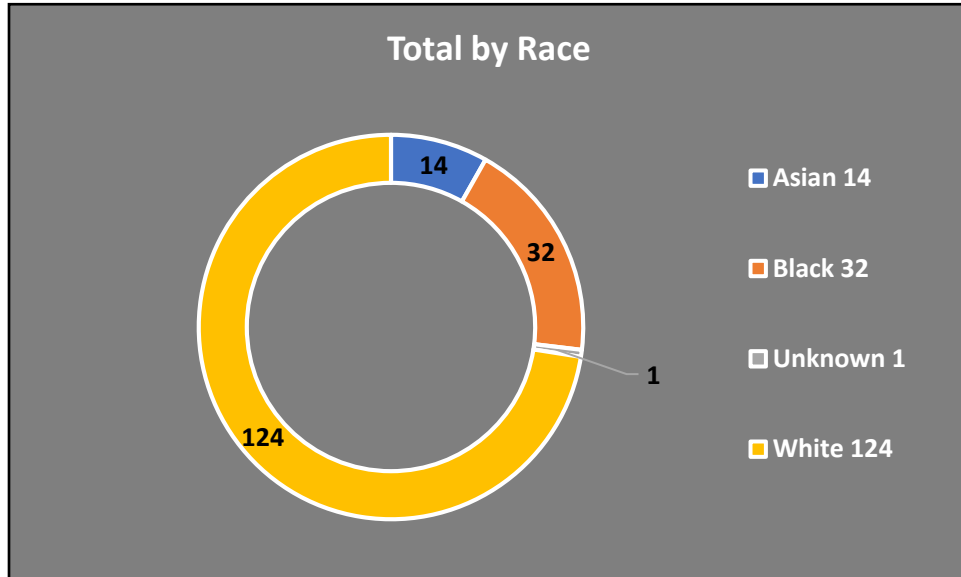

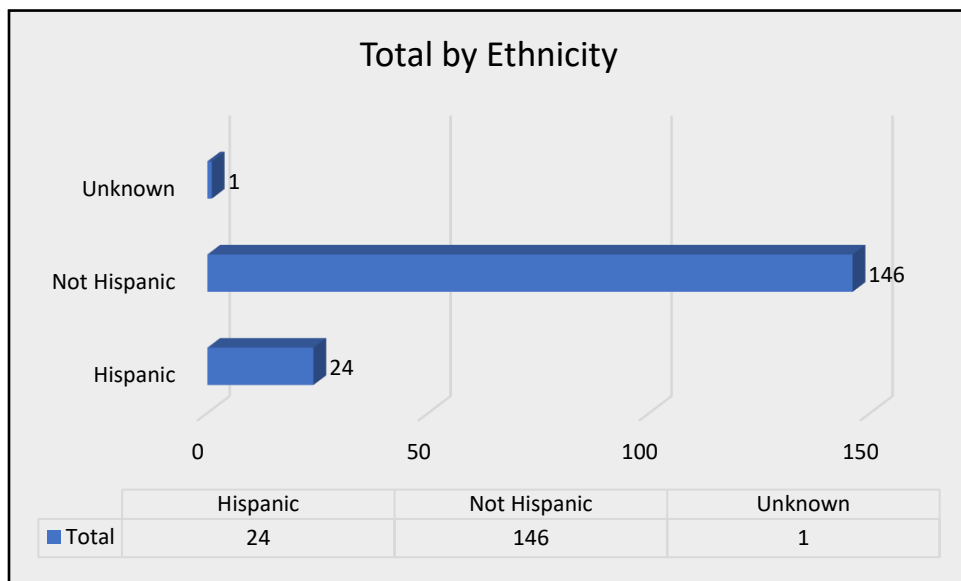

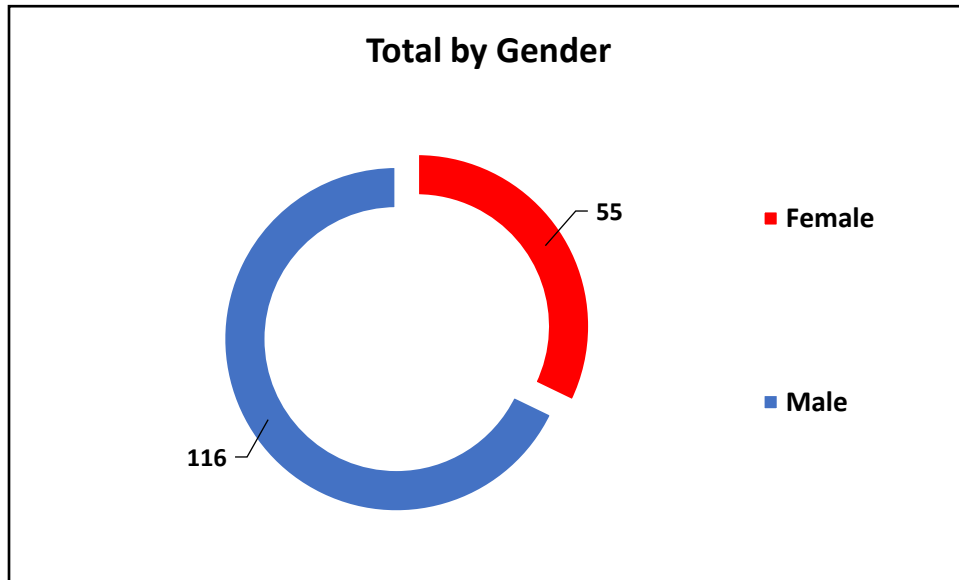

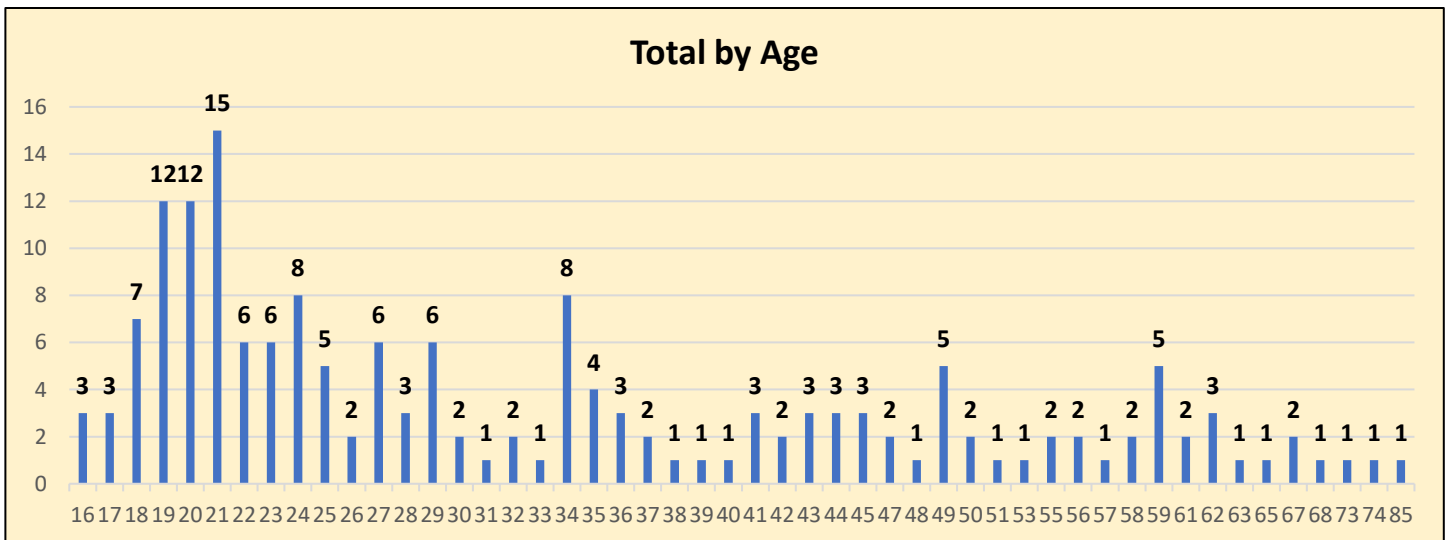

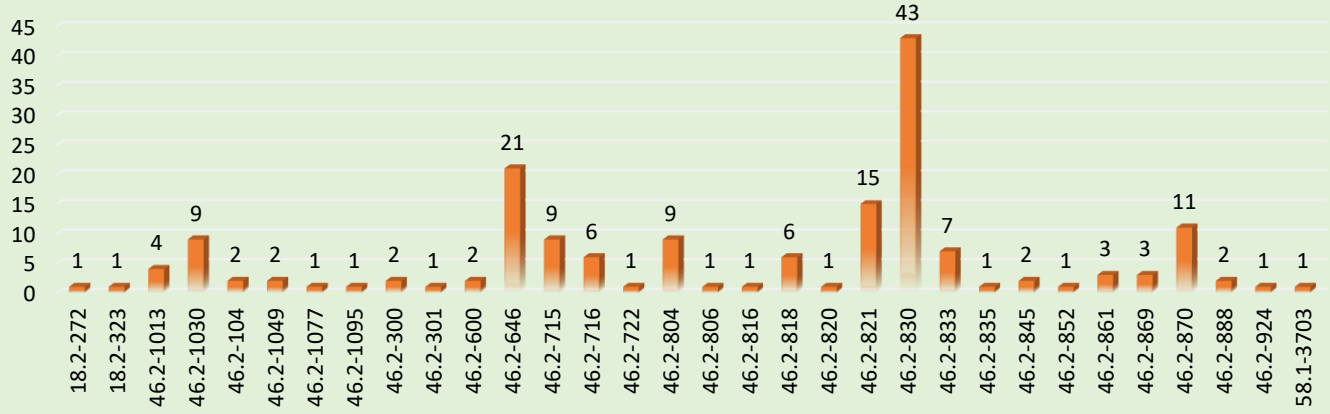

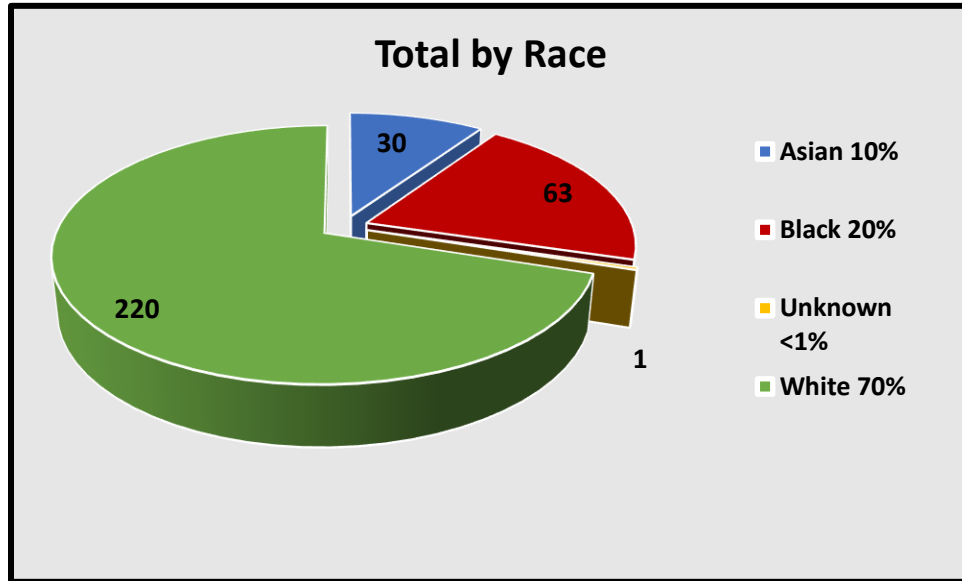

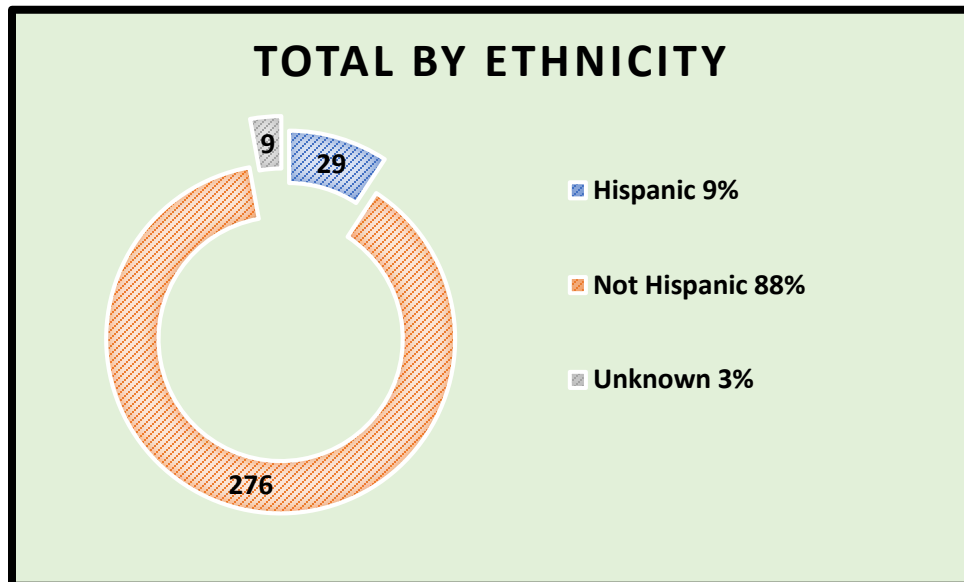

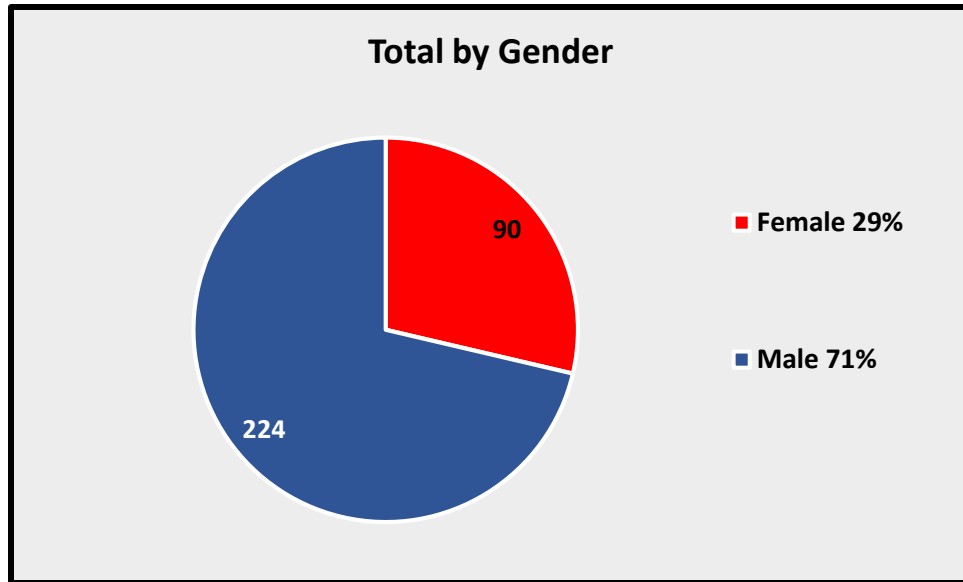

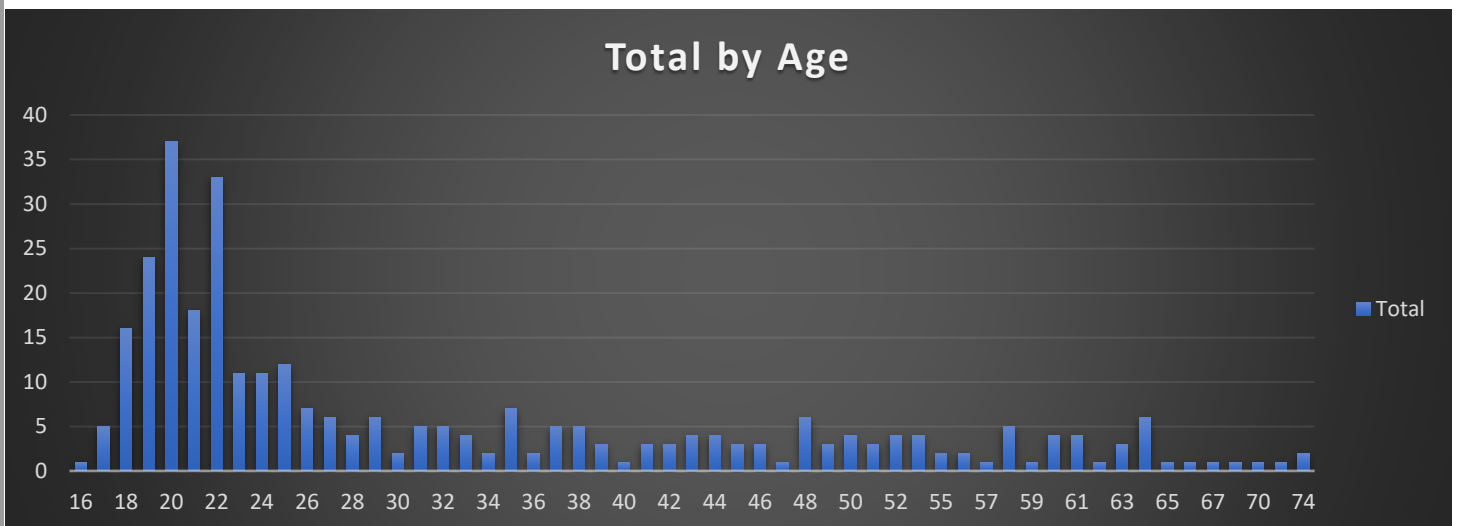

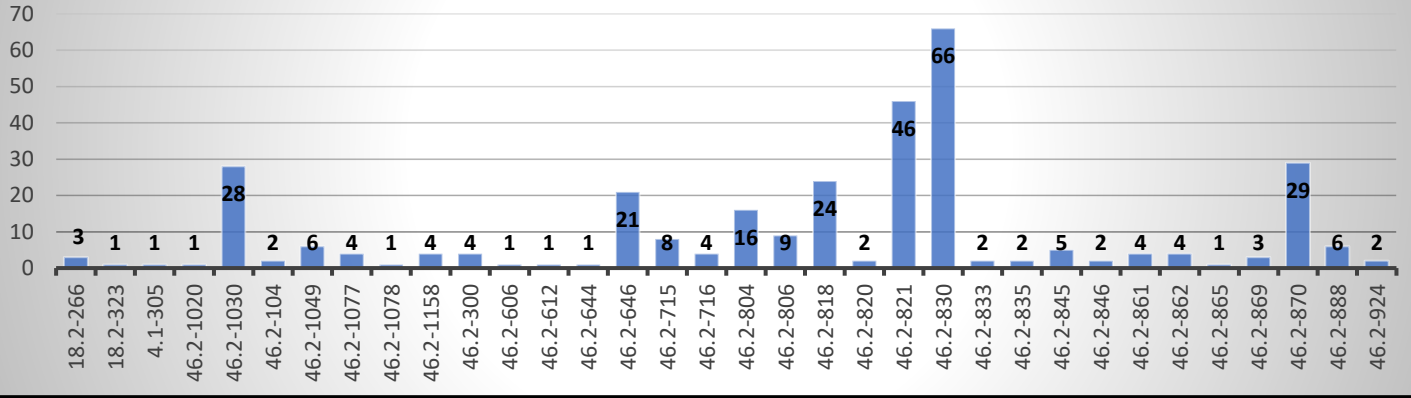
Of the 314 traffic stops, the following chart depicts the gender of drivers upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.

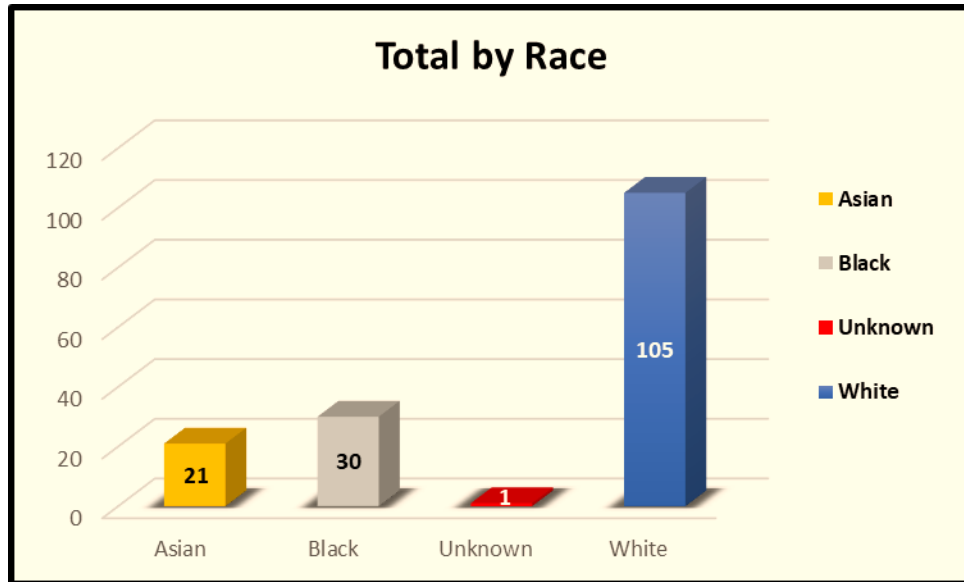

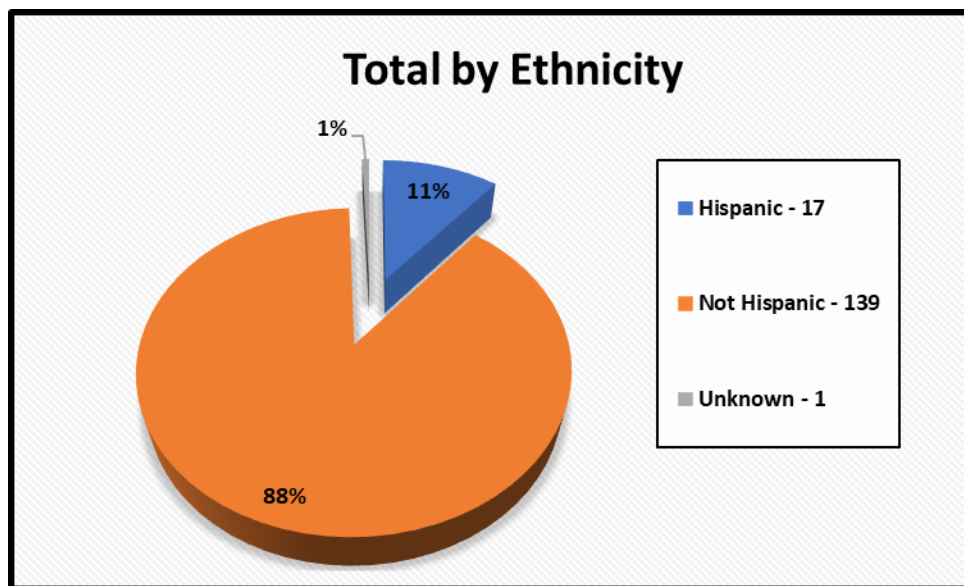

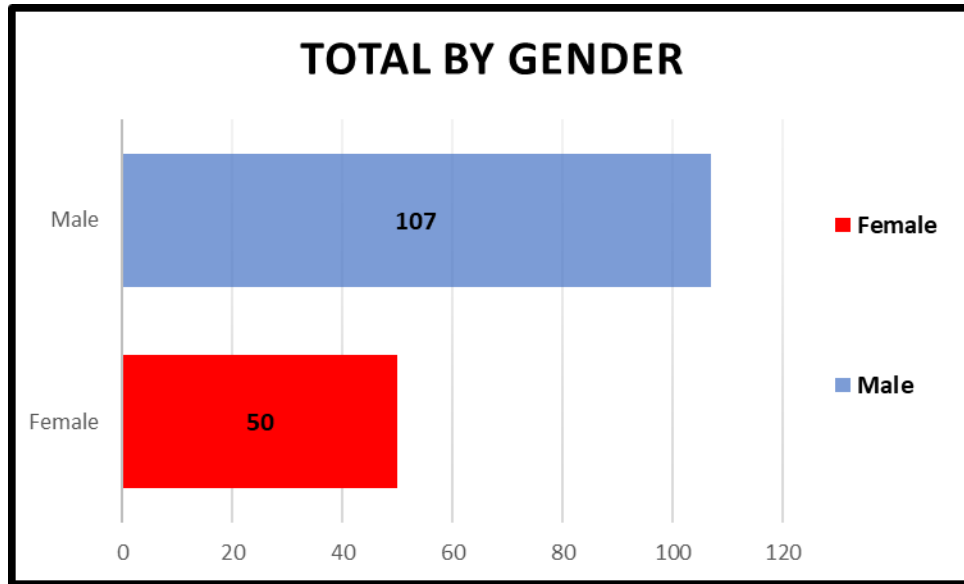

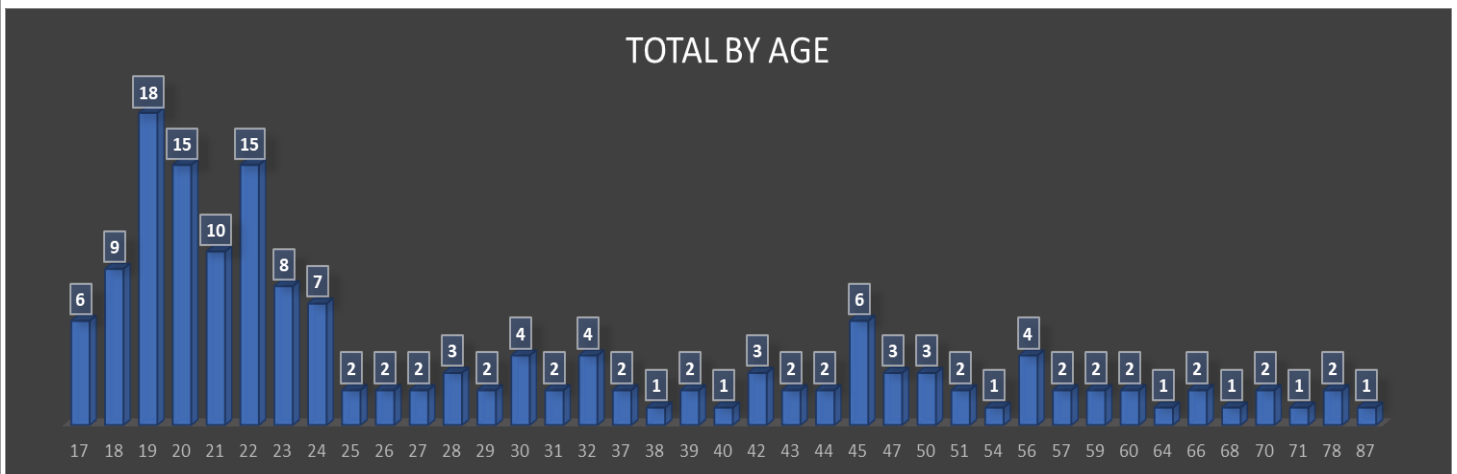

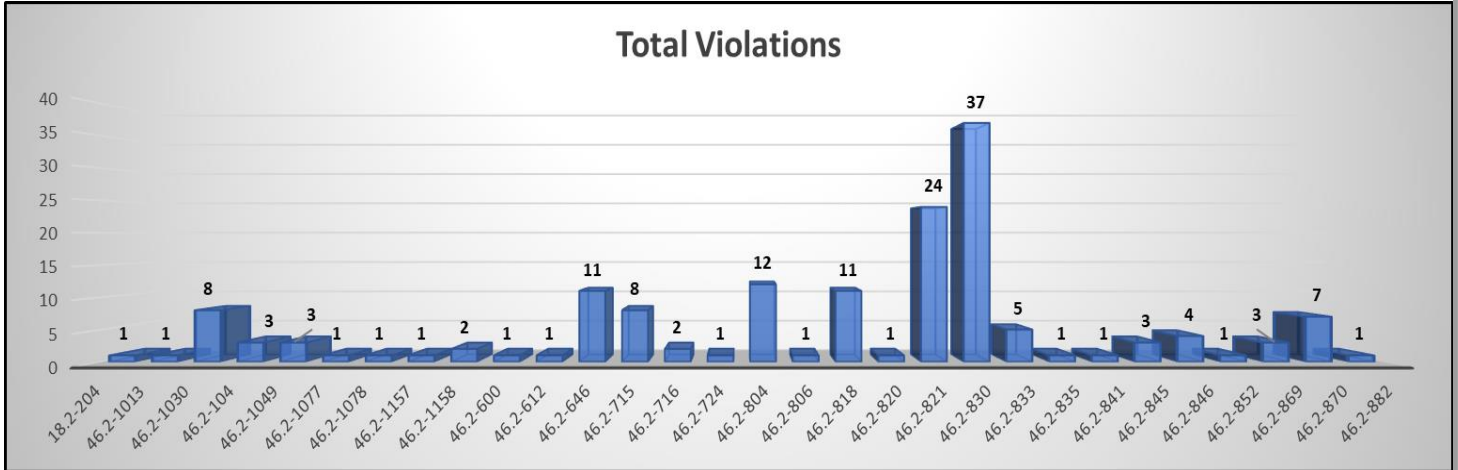

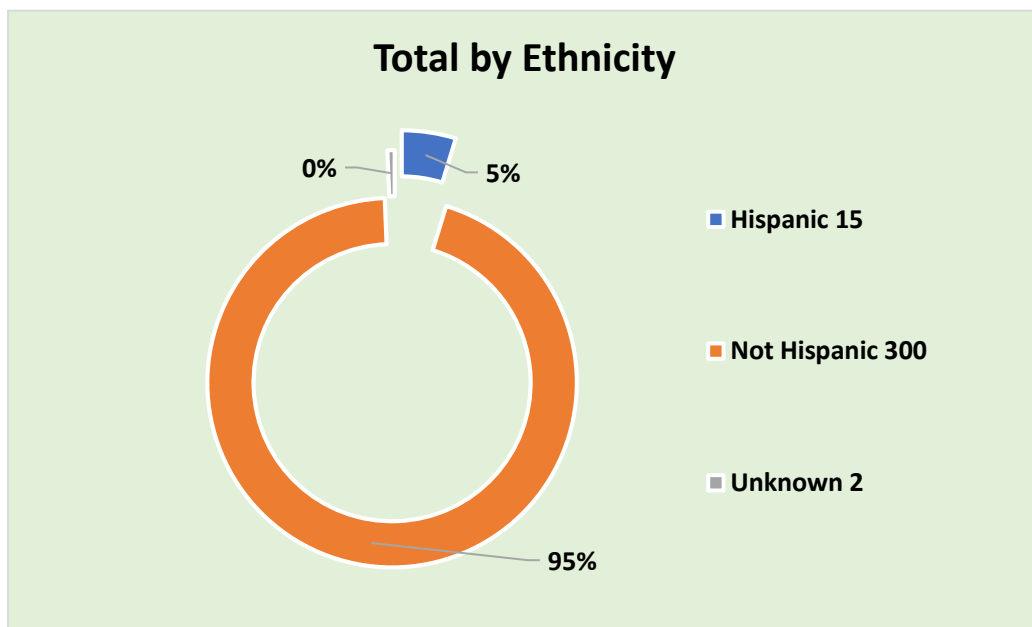

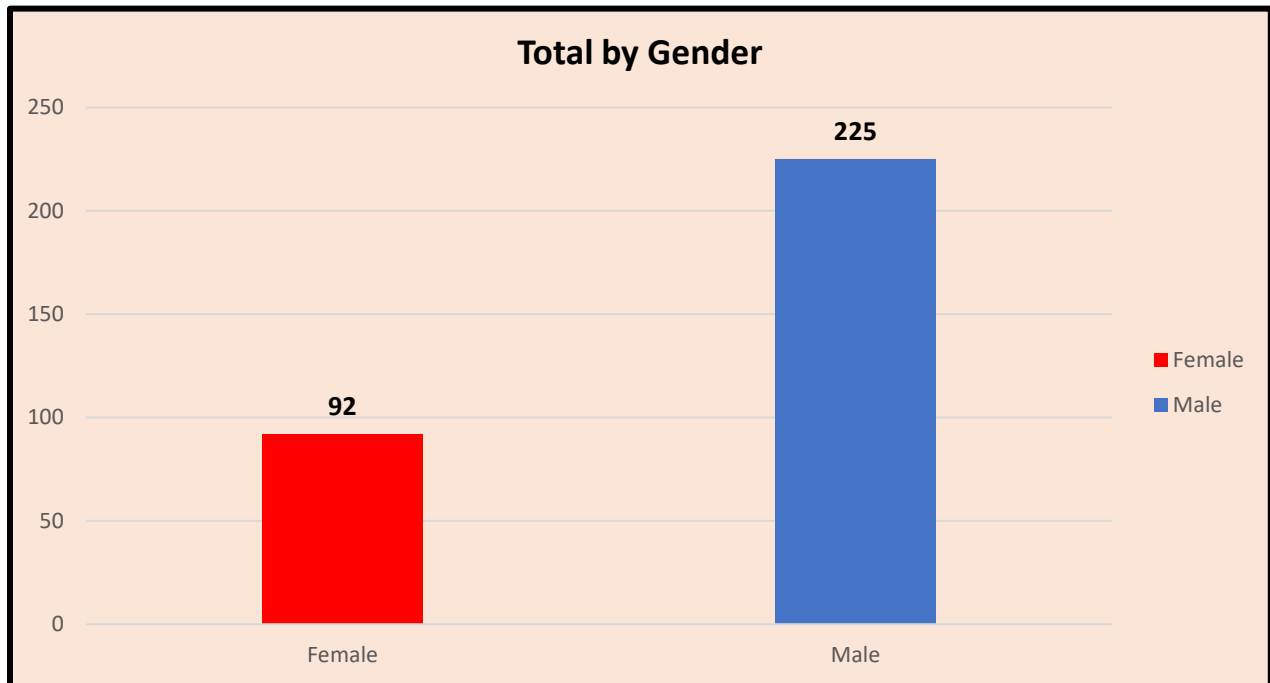

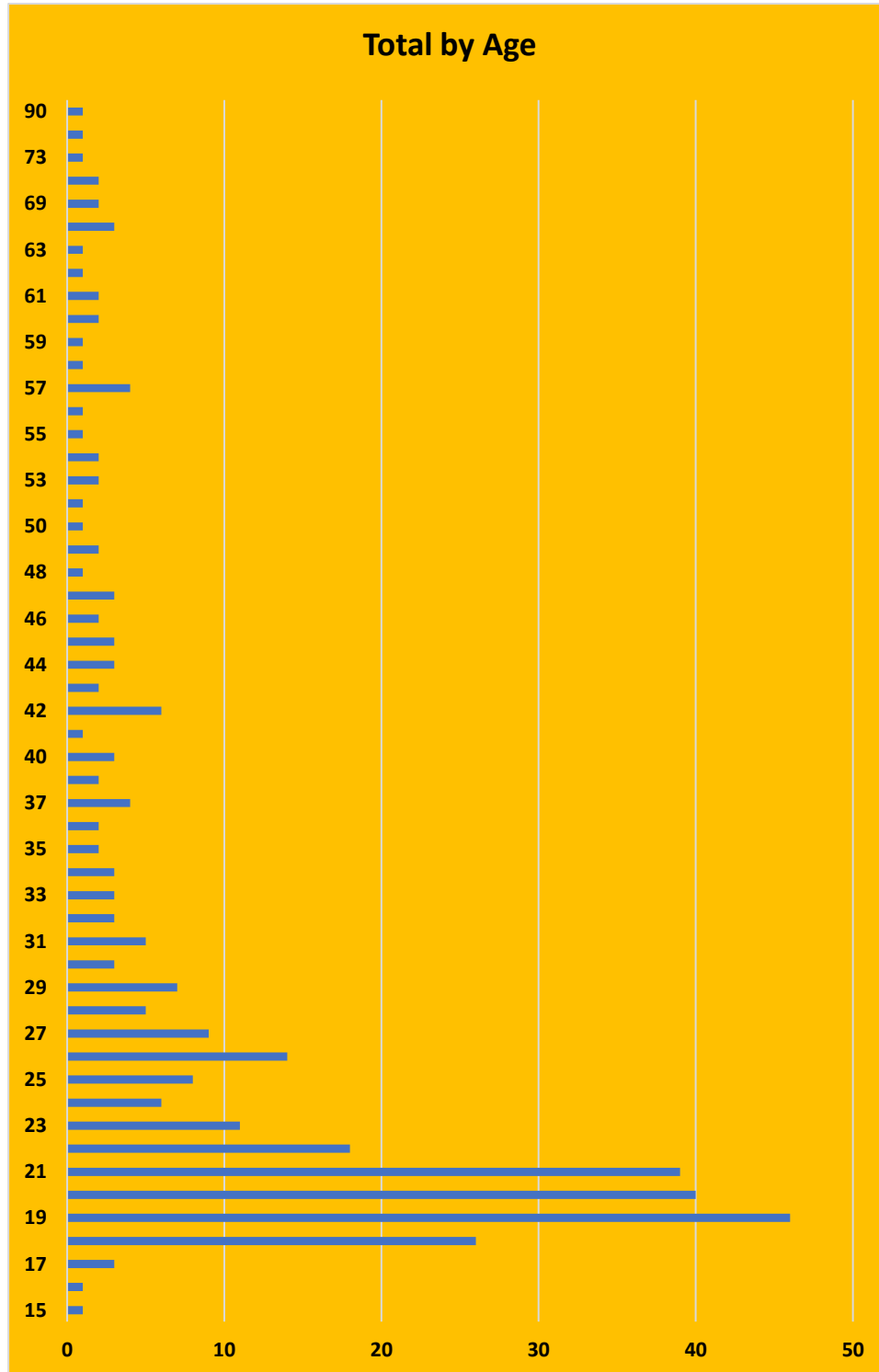

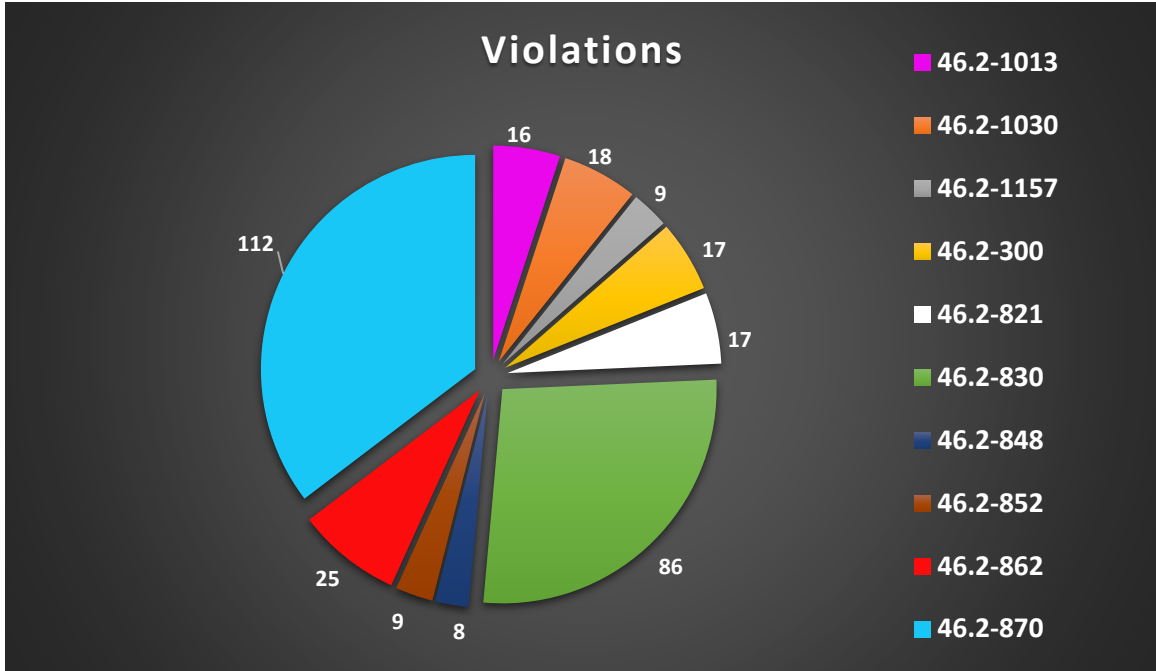


Of the 317 traffic stops, the following chart depicts the gender of drivers upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.

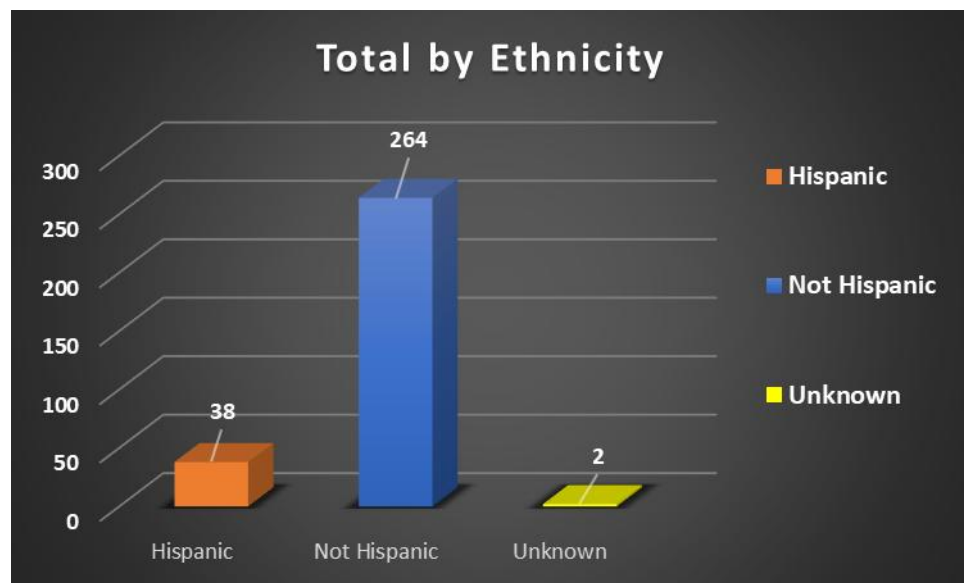

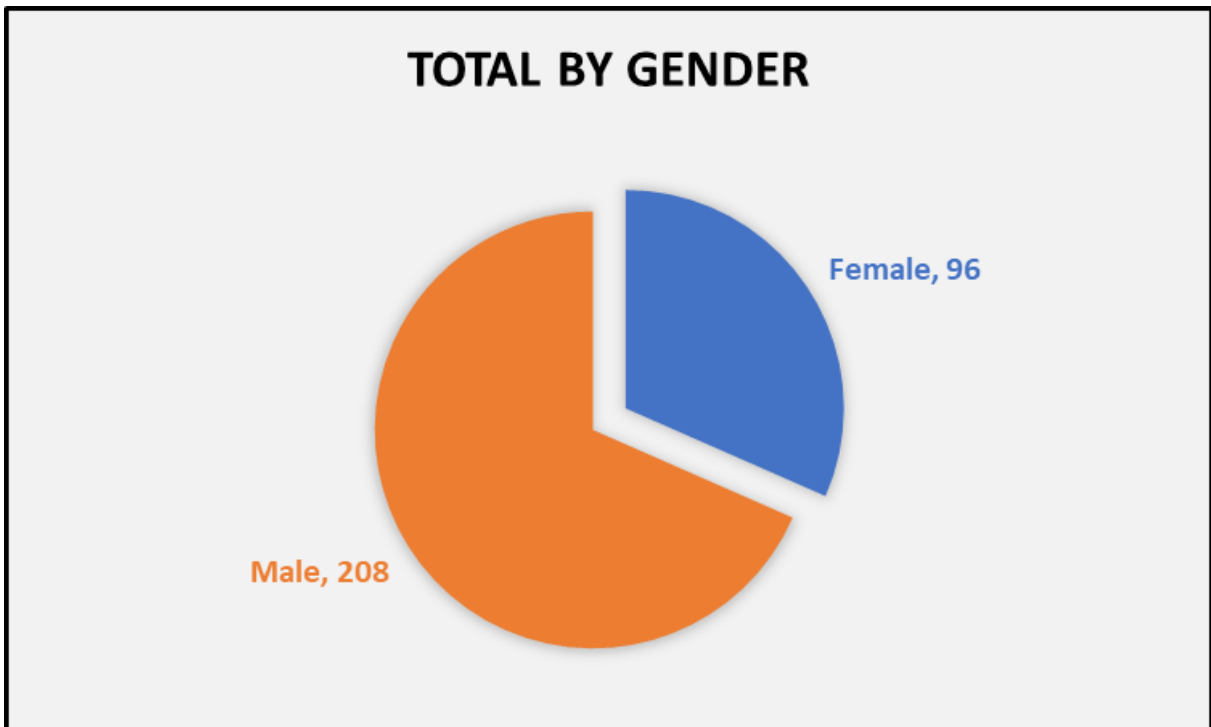

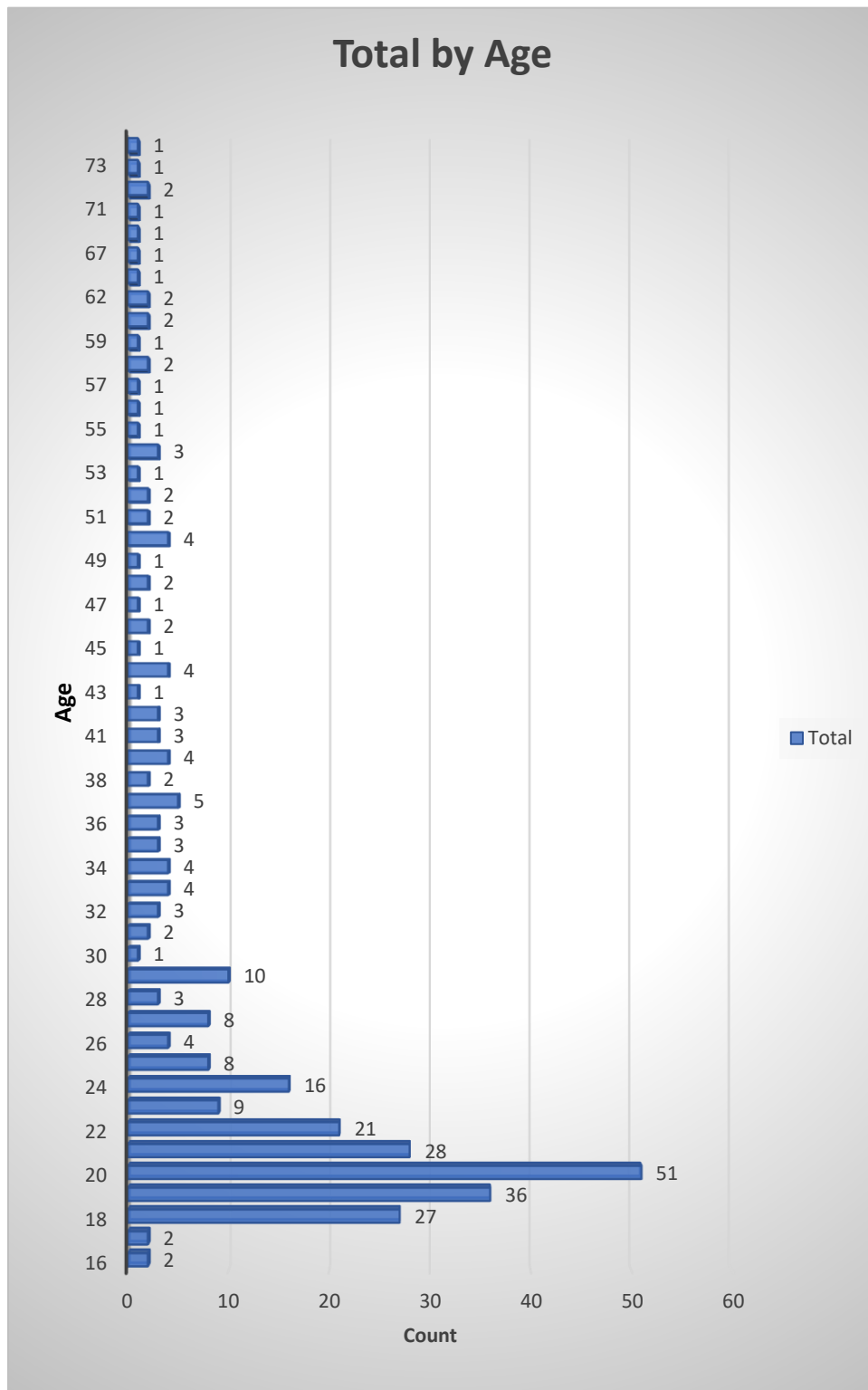
Of the 304 traffic stops, the following chart depicts the ethnicity of drivers upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.

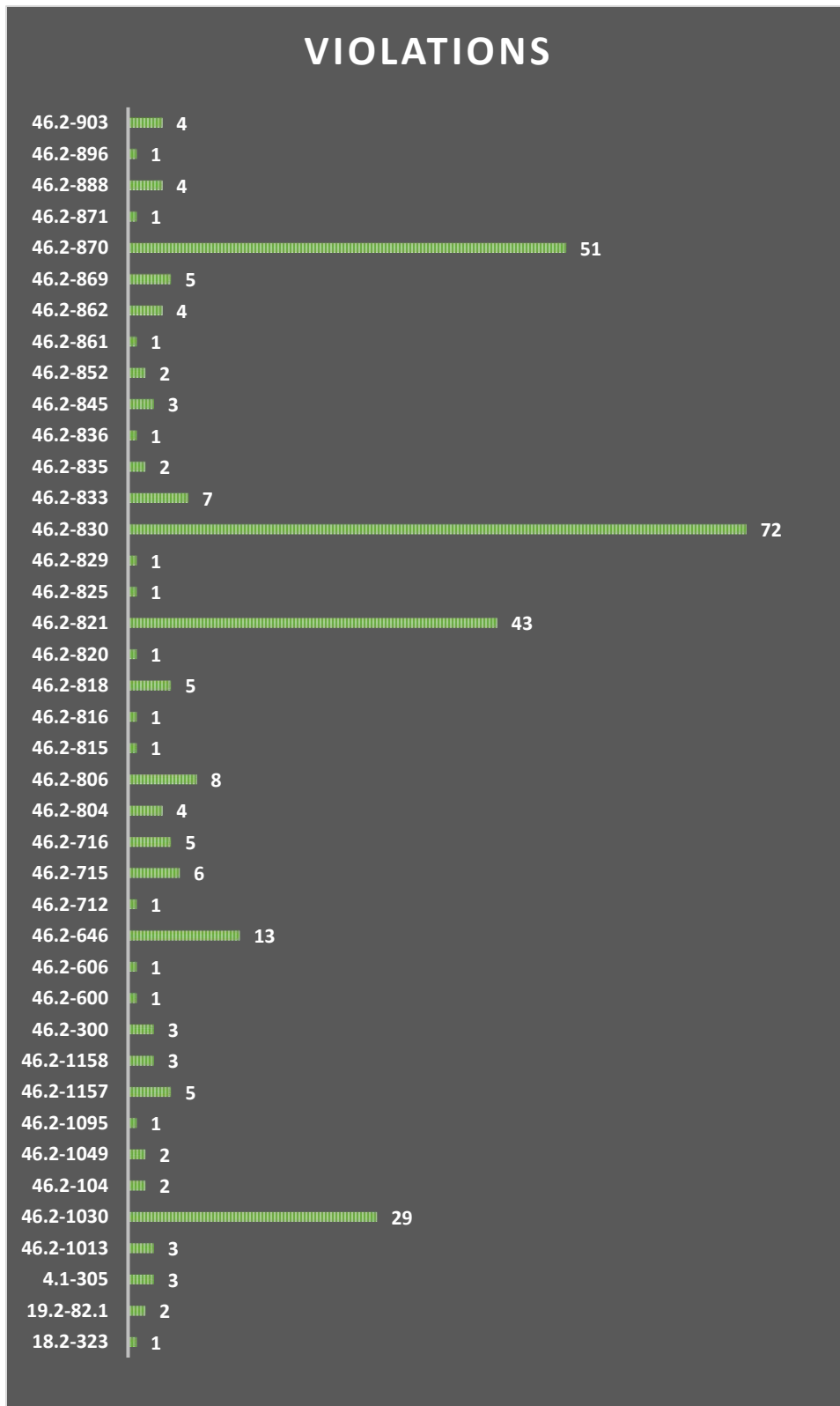


Of the 304 traffic stops, the following chart depicts the gender of drivers upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.

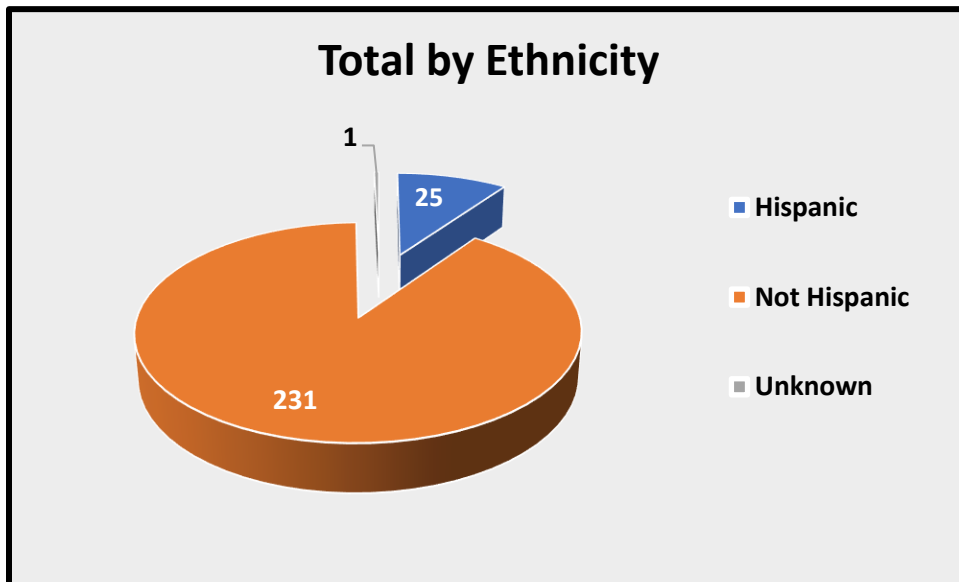

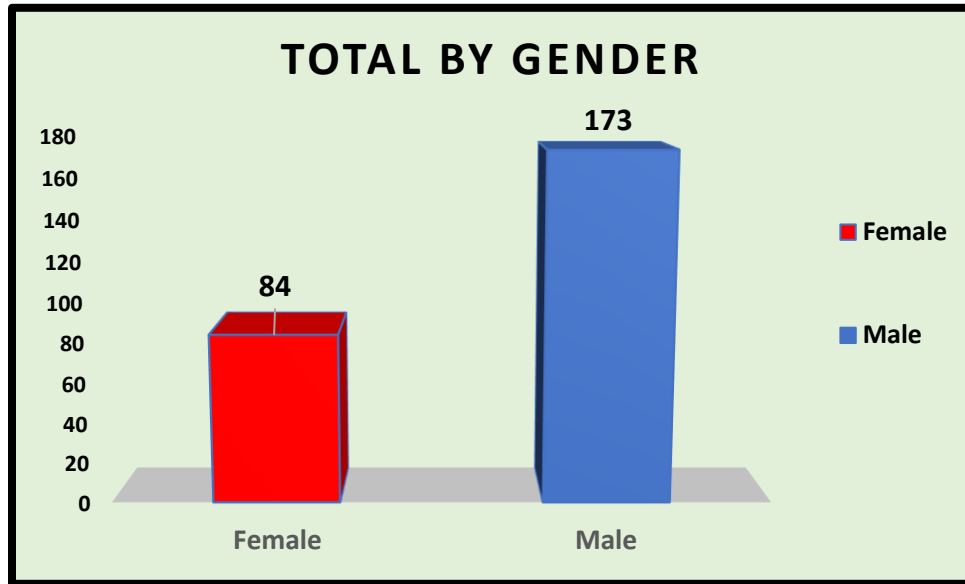

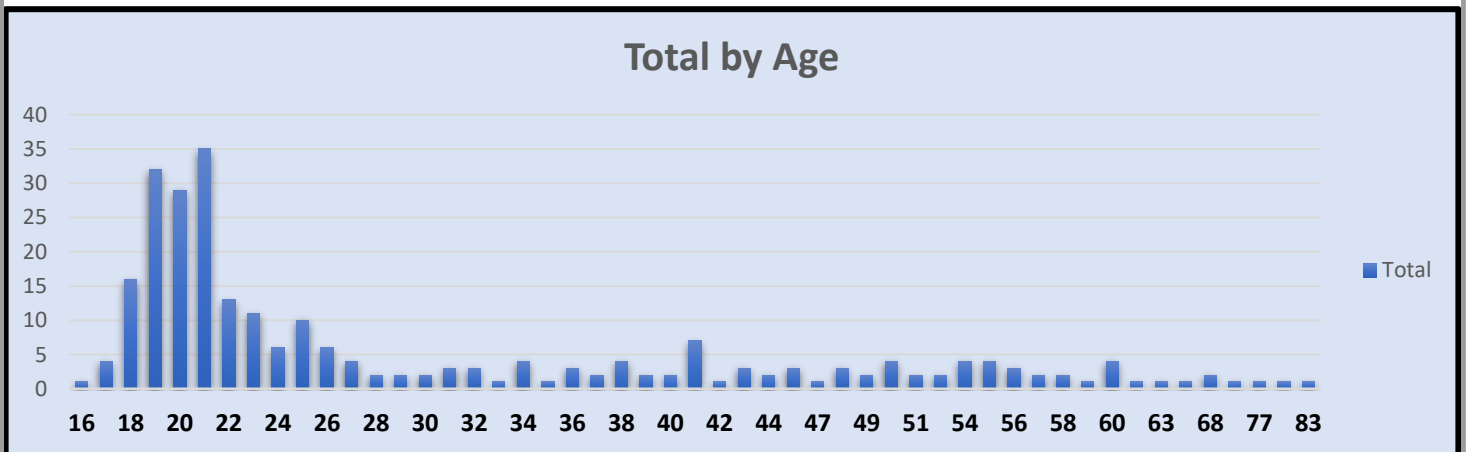
Of the 257 traffic stops, the following chart depicts the ethnicity of drivers upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.

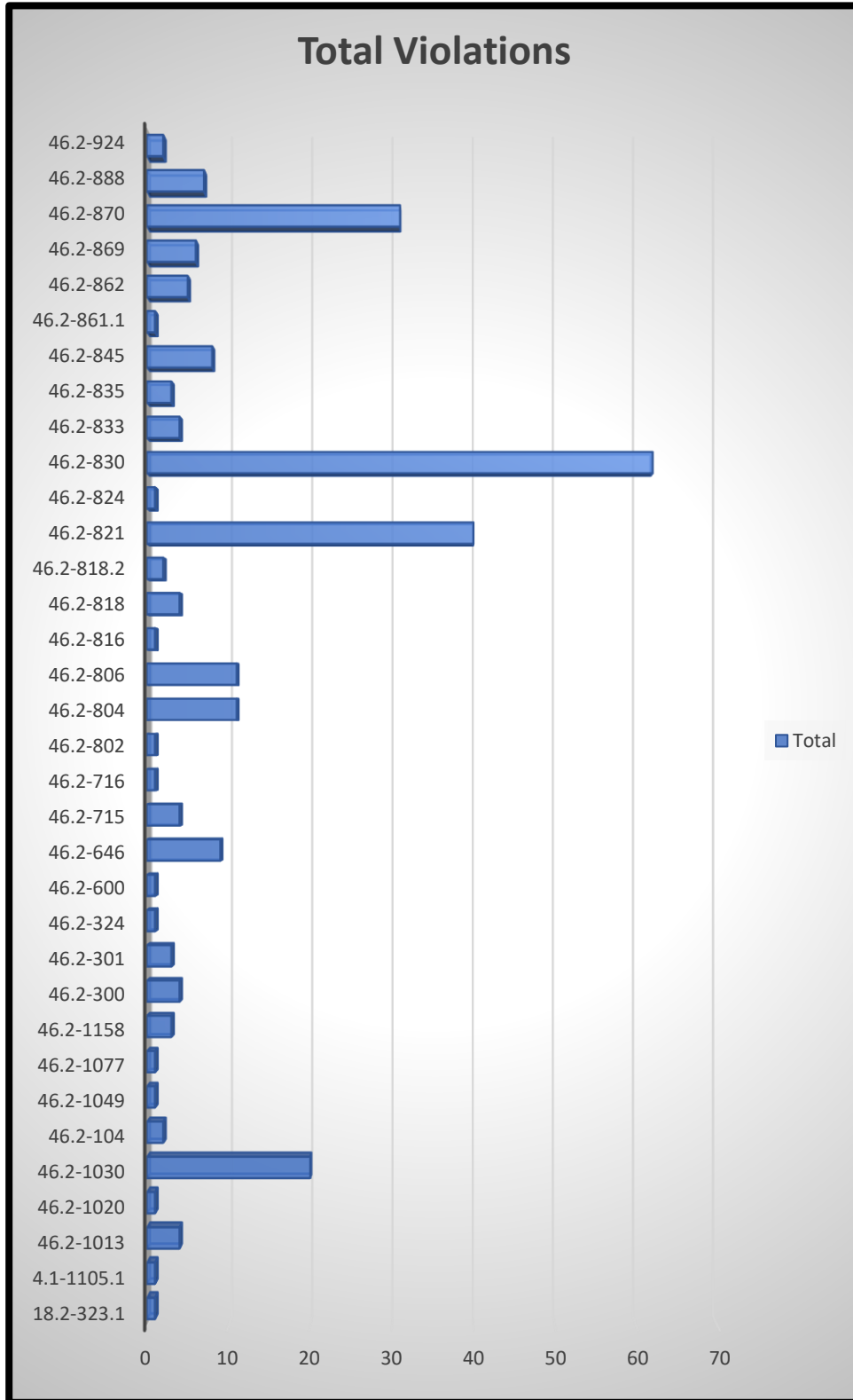


Of the 257 traffic stops, the following chart depicts the gender of drivers upon officers initiating a traffic stop and making contact.
